YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the Baysox, 6-2. Bowie starter Cade Povich took a perfect game into the seventh until Wade Meckler led off the inning with a single. Povich finished the night working seven scoreless innings with 13 strikeouts, tied for the most by an Eastern League pitcher this season. Coby Mayo started the scoring with a solo homer in the first. Billy Cook drove an RBI single in the fourth to open a 2-0 lead. Mayo extended the Bowie lead to 3-0 in the fifth with an RBI double and TT Bowens hit a solo homer in the sixth to push the lead to 4-0. The Baysox added two runs in the seventh to pull ahead, 6-0. The Flying Squirrels broke the shutout in the eighth with an RBI single by Brandon Martorano and an RBI single by Simon Whiteman

TDDAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the fifth game of a six-day, seven-game series against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. Today is the 9th of 24 head-to-head games this year. The Flying Squirrels went 4-1 at Prince George's Stadium from April 25-29. The Sunday finale of that series was rained out. The Baysox will come to The Diamond for six-game sets from July 4-9 and August 8-13.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS were 14-7 through their first 21 games but are 13-26 since May 3. For the year, Richmond starters have thrown 214.1 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 300.2 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.32 ERA, which is the second-lowest in Double-A and is tied for the fifth-lowest of the 120 teams in the minors.

THE BAYSUX are in last place in the Southwest Division but have won seven-of-10, including five-of-six last week in Erie. Baseball America's top-30 Orioles prospects list features six Bowie players, including INF Coby Mayo (No. 9), LHP Cade Povich (No. 10), RHP Chayce McDermott (No. 15), INF Cesar Prireto (No. 16), RHP Justin Armbruester (No. 22) and OF John Rhodes (No. 26). MLB. com's top-30 Orioles prospects list features six Bowie players, including Mayo (No. 8), Povich (No. 11), Prieto (No. 16), McDermott (No. 17), Rhodes (No. 19) and Armbruester (No. 30).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Carson Seymour takes the mound for his eighth Double-A start, his second against the Baysox and his 13th overall appearance of the year. He has pitched his last six outings out of the bullpen, working four innings in each of the last four. He last pitched on Sunday afternoon in the series finale against the Curve and allowed one run over four frames. He last faced the Baysox on April 25 at Prince George's Stadium and allowed two runs in three innings. Seymour has posted the lowest HR/9 IP (0.20) and ranks 10th in ERA (3.35) in the Eastern League (min. 45 IP). A native of Poway, Calif., Seymour was selected by the New York Mets in the sixth round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Kansas State University. After making four appearances in 2021, he began the 2022 season with Low-A St. Lucie, where he went 4-0 with a 1.19 ERA in seven outings (four starts). He was promoted to High-A Brooklyn on May 23 for 11 outings before being traded to the Giants on August 2 as part of the deal that sent Darin Ruf to the Mets. Seymour closed the year with High-A Eugene, going 2-3 with a 3.99 ERA in six starts. Seymour is rated by Baseball America as the No. 12 Giants prospect and No. 17 by MLB.com. FOR BOWIE: Right-hander Garrett Stallings makes his seventh start and 12th appearance of the year for the Baysox. He last pitched on Saturday at Erie and threw five scoreless innings in a win. It was his fourth five-inning, scoreless outing in his last six starts dating back to May 12. Stallings took the mound out of the bullpen against the Flying Squirrels on April 29 at Prince George's Stadium and allowed five runs over three innings in a loss. Stallings is a native of Chespeake, Va., and attended Grassfield High School before heading to the University of Tennessee. He was selected by the Angels in the fifth round of the 2019 MLB Draft and traded to the Orioles on December 2, 2020 along with RHP Jean Pinto for SS Jose Iglesias. He first reached Double-A with Bowie in 2021. Last year, he made 26 appearances (22 starts) and went 6-10 with a 6.28 ERA.

I LOVE LUCI: On Saturday night, Marco Luciano hit a grand slam and a two-run homer in the Flying Squirrels' 11-2 win. It was the fourth multi-homer game of his career. He went deep again with a two-run homer on Sunday afternoon and added a 432-foot, opposite-field two-run shot on Wednesday at Bowie. Since he began his season with his Double-A debut on May 3, his nine home runs are tied for the fifth-most in the Eastern League. He leads all Richmond hitters in home runs for the year. Luciano's riding a five-game hit streak was snapped on Thursday, but over his last six games, he is batting .476 (10-for-21) with four homers, one double, five walks and 10 RBIs.

ALRIGHT, ALDRETE: Carter Aldrete homered in each of the first two games in this week's series at Bowie. On Tuesday, he hit a solo shot in the third inning. In the first game of Wednesday's doubleheader, he clubbed a solo homer in the fourth. Since his promotion to Double-A on July 23, 2022, Aldrete has the most home runs (14), RBIs (52), hits (82), doubles (19) and extra-base hits (33) of any Flying Squirrels player. His eight homers this year are tied for second-most on the team.

WELCOME BACK, WADE: Wade Meckler was reinstated from the injured list on Saturday after missing 12 games. In his four games back from the IL, he has reached base seven times (three hits and four walks). In his first game back, he reached base three times with two walks and a two-run double. For the year, Meckler leads all minor league hitters (min. 120 PA) in batting average (.402) and ranks 13th in OBP (.462). He has picked up 11 hits and seven walks in his nine Double-A games since being promoted from High-A Eugene on May 17.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, Tyler Fitzgerald is tied for third in triples (3). Evan Gates is tied for ninth in saves (4). Kai-Wei Teng is third in strikeouts (68), tied for eighth in BAA (.225) and 10th in WHIP (1.23). Wil Jensen is tied for second in wins (5)

WHERE THE BAYSOX RANK: Among the Eastern League leaders, Cesar Prieto is first in batting average (.358), seventh in OBP (.403), first in hits (78), 10th in OPS (.875) and seventh in total bases (103). Coby Mayo is ninth in batting average (.291), third in OBP (.412), seventh in SLG (.544), fifth in OPS (.956), tied for sixth in hits (60), first in doubles (21), tied for ninth in walks (36), second in extra-base hits (32) and fourth in total bases (112). John Rhodes is tied for third in triples (3). Garrett Stallings is seventh in WHIP (1.17).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have nine players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including Marco Luciano (No. 1), Vaun Brown (No. 6), Carson Whisenhunt (No. 8), Mason Black (No. 9), Carson Seymour (No. 12), Landen Roupp (No. 13), Ryan Murphy (No. 20), Wade Meckler (No. 23) and Randy Rodriguez (No. 30). Luciano is also rated as the No. 63 prospect on Baseball America's Top 100. In Baseball America's "Best Tools" list, Luciano is rated as the best power hitter, Brown is rated as the best hitter for average and best athlete, Meckler is rated as having the best strike-zone discipline, Roupp is rated as having the best curveball and José Cruz is rated as having the best changeup. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list includes 10 Richmond players, including Luciano (No. 2, No. 18 overall), Brown (No. 5), Whisenhunt (No. 8), Black (No. 10), Roupp (No. 13), Seymour (No. 17), Rodriguez (No. 25), Murphy (No. 26), Cruz (No. 29) and Meckler (No. 30).

WELCOME TO THE SHOW: Two former Flying Squirrels players have made their MLB debuts for the San Francisco Giants this week. On Tuesday, Keaton Winn pitched in St. Louis and allowed one run over four innings in the Giants' 11-3 win, becoming the first Giants player in franchise history to pick up a save in his debut. Last season, Winn joined the Flying Squirrels in mid-August and went 2-3 with a 4.15 ERA in six starts to close the regular season. On Wednesday, Luis Matos made his major league debut against the Cardinals and went 1-for-3. He was on the Flying Squirrels' Opening Day roster this year and .304 with three homers in 31 games before being promoted to Triple-A Sacramento on May 17. On the year, six former Flying Squirrels have made their MLB debuts, all with the Giants, including Tristan Beck (2021-22 Flying Squirrels), Casey Schmitt (2022), Patrick Bailey (2023) and Ryan Walker (2021-22). On Wednesday, Matos became the 90th Flying Squirrels alum to reach the big leagues.
