Leading Off

Tonight, Reading and Binghamton continue this week's series with game five. Binghamton holds the 3-1 series edge.

Reading fell to Binghamton 3-2 last night as R-Phils pitching allowed just one hit, but issued eight walks in the defeat. Griff McGarry started and allowed two-earned over five innings. After falling down 3-0 and a rain delay, Reading worked back with home runs from Ethan Wilson and Pedro Martinez to make it 3-2, but Binghamton's bullpen locked it down to secure the one-run victory.

Reading Manager Al Pedrique sits just seven wins shy of 1,000 in his Major/Minor League managerial career. Pedrique's win totals with each organization have been: Royals (102), Astros (158), Diamondbacks (225), Yankees (394), Miami (75) and Phillies (39).

Last night was the first time Reading pitching tossed a one-hitter since they did it on Apr. 25, 2019 against New Hampshire. Mauricio Llovera started for Reading, and he was followed by JD Hammer and Garrett Cleavinger in the 2019 game. The one-hit allowed was also a season-low in hits around for Reading in 2023.

Remember Me for Centuries

Carlos De La Cruz was the first player in the Eastern League to register 100 hits on the season. His 106 hits rank first in the league, with 98 from Johan Rojas being the second most. Jonathan Rodrigguez from Akron is the next closest with 93 hits on the season. De La Cruz also has the following league ranks: AVG (10th), HR (3rd), RBI (T10th), SLG (7th), OPS (9th), 2B (5th), XBH (3rd), TB (1st), R (3rd).

Tyler Phillips, Brett Schulze and Braden Zarbnisky earned promotions to triple-A Lehigh Valley prior to Wednesday night's game. Phillips has had a solid season after missing all of 2022 with Tommy John Surgery, while Schulze and Zarbnisky have proven to be strong out of the bullpen in a variety of situations. Reading also added Tommy McCollum from Jersey Shore, who had a strong year with the high-A club prior to his promotion.

Around the Organization

The Phillies beat the Pirates 2-1 last night, thanks to a Kyle Schwarber two-run homer. Lehigh Valley fell twice last night to Syracuse as the team's also completed Thursday night's suspended game. Jersey Shore beat Aberdeen 8-1, thanks to seven-strong innings from Matt Osterberg. Clearwater had a scheduled off-day at Jupiter.

Ponies Rumbling into Town

Binghamton enters today with a 10-14 record in the second half and 45-48 overall record in 2023. Binghamton split a six-game series last week at home against Erie, posting wins on Wednesday, Thursday and Sunday. After this week, the Rumble Ponies return home for a six-game series against New Hampshire. Brandon McIlwain leads the team offensively with a .261 average and 46 RBI entering today. Binghamton ranks last in the Eastern League with a .224 average and is 10th with a 4.40 ERA. Luke Ritter is currently with triple-A Syracuse after a strong start with Binghamton.

Righty Christian Scott gets the start tonight for Binghamton, his first against the R-Phils. He was called up to Binghamton from high-A Brookyln on June 12. With the Ponies, Scott is 3-3 with a 2.90 ERA over seven starts (40.1 IP, 28 H, 7 BB, 46 SO). He last threw four-shutout innings at Erie on July 23. Scott's gone more than six innings five times in seven starts, with two seven-inning outings. He made six starts with Brookyln and went 1-0 with a 2.28 ERA, and also appeared in a game for single-A St. Lucie. Scott split 2022 between St. Lucie and Brooklyn, going 3-3 with 4.45 ERA over 18 games and nine starts. Scott was selected inm the fifth-round in 2021 by the Mets out of Florida. He attended Calvary Christian Academy in Fort Lauderdale.
