**MYERS MOUND DAY:** Tobias Myers will get the start for Nashville on Friday night against the Indians. Myers is still looking for his first Triple-A win of the year. The right-hander started the season with the Sounds on rehab before pitching in six games (5 GS) with the Brewers where he went 1-1 with a 4.95 ERA. Despite allowing just eight runs (5 ER) through his first four starts with Nashville, the Brewers' 2024 Most Valuable Pitcher is 0-2 with Nashville allowing all eight runs in those two losses. His last outing was last Friday night when he worked five innings against Scranton/Wilkes-Barre and had a season-high six strikeouts and 94 pitches (68 strikes).

**DON'T CRY BECAUSE IT'S OVER:** After an 0-for-3 day at the plate, Anthony Seigler saw his 16-game hitting streak come to an end. It was the third-longest streak by a Nashville player over the last three-plus seasons. Estuary Ruiz was the last player to have a 17-game hitting streak for Nashville when he did it from August 10-28, 2022. Seigler posted five multi-hit games during his 16-game streak that began on May 2nd, including his single-game career-high four hits that he had in Wednesday night's win. Seigler did extend his on-base streak to 23 games with a walk on Thursday night. His 23-straight games reaching base is tied for the third-longest active streak in the International League and the sixth-longest by a Nashville player since 2023. Abraham Toro had a 37-game on-base streak that lasted from July 9 - September 24, 2023.

**HAMMER AND NEL:** Raynel Delgado had his 11th multi-hit game of the season, tying Jared Oliva for the most on the team in 2025. Seven of those 11 multi-hit games have come in the month of May for Delgado who is hitting .320 (24-for-75) with four doubles, a triple, 14 RBI, and seven runs scored in his 22 games played this month.

**SO NICE HE DID IT TWICE:** Eddie Rosario has posted back-to-back multi-hit games after going his first seven games with the Sounds without one. Rosario ended Thursday's game 2-for-4 with a double and the only run scored. Through his first nine games with the Sounds, Rosario is hitting .303 (10-for-33) with three doubles, a home run, six RBI, six walks, and eight runs scored. In his 23 total Triple-A games this season including the first 14 with Oklahoma City, Rosario is hitting .326 and has six multi-hit games.

**RISPY BUSINESS:** Following their 1-for-8 with RISP in Thursday's loss, the Sounds are hitting .247 as a team and rank 15th in the International League. Memphis leads the league hitting with RISP, hitting .296 and have 49 XBH with RISP compared to the Sounds 29.

**ELVIS IN THE BUILDING:** RHP Elvis Peguero earned his second save of the season and struck out all three Indianapolis batters he faced in the bottom of the ninth inning on Wednesday night. The right-hander has now pitched seven straight games with Nashville without allowing an earned run dating back to April 24th. Over the span he has allowed three hits in 8.0 IP with nine strikeouts. Eight of the nine appearances he has for the Sounds this season have come without an earned run charged to him. His three strikeouts are tied for the most he has had in a game with Nashville so far this year. He also struck out three over 2.0 IP back on April 24th when his no earned runs streak began.

**BOBBY THREE BONES:** Bobby Dalbec finished Wednesday's game 3-for-5 with a home run, double, single, and four RBI. Like Seigler, he finished a leg shy of the cycle, needing a triple to complete the feat. The three hits and four RBI are both season-highs for Dalbec since joining the Sounds. He had one three-hit game with Triple-A Charlotte on April 16th earlier this season against Nashville and also had two three RBI games with the Knights and one three-RBI game with the Sounds in his first series after signing a minor-league contract with the Brewers. Through his first 14 games with Nashville, Dalbec is hitting .237 with two doubles, two home runs, and 11 RBI. He had his season-high five-game hitting streak come to an end on Thursday.

**HITS ON DECK:** Wednesday night was Nashville's third double-digit hit output in their last four games. The 14 hits are tied for the third-most they have had in a game this season and the 17th game this year with 10+ hits. Nashville is 13-4 with reaching 10+ hits in a game and now 5-6 when their opponent also has 10+ hits after Indianapolis also had 10 on Wednesday.
