A 20-RUN SUNDAY

Despite a 4-0 deficit after the top of the first, Round Rock battled back in the home half with a sacrifice fly from 1B Blaine Crim and a two-RBI single from RF Elier Hernandez to cut the deficit to 4-3. In the second inning, the Space Cowboys extended their lead to 5-3. After a scoreless third Sugar Land tacked on one run in the fourth. The E-Train took the lead in the fifth inning after putting 10 runs on the board with the help of a basesclearing double from C Sam Huff and two triples from Crim. Round Rock batted through the whole lineup and saw six hits, three walks, an error and a hit by pitch to take a 13-6 lead. In the sixth, 3B Justin Foscue blasted a two-run home run to cap off a four-run inning and make it a 17-6 game. A three-run seventh inning extended Round Rock's lead to 20-6. The Space Cowboys answered back by adding one run in the top of the eighth and two in the ninth, but could not overcome the doubledigit deficit as the Express secured a 20-9 victory.

MARVEL'S UP NEXT

Express RHP James Marvel is scheduled to take the mound on Tuesday against the Bees. In his last outing, Marvel allowed 10 hits, including the only home run he has allowed this year. The 10 hits were the most allowed by an E-Train pitcher this season. Through five starts, he has gone 21.1 innings and given up 16 earned runs while walking nine and striking out 11.

STARTING JUNE OFF HOT

Sunday's 20-9 final score followed Saturday's 16-4 win for the Express. The 36 total runs over two games marks the second-most runs scored in a two-game span in franchise history. Round Rock totaled 37 in Las Vegas between June 5-6, 2019. The 20 runs marks just the fourth time in club history the team has scored 20 or more runs in a game. The Express are now outscoring their opponents 335-308 on the year.

DINGER WENDZEL

SS Davis Wendzel leads the Pacific Coast League in home runs since August 1, 2022 with 22 bombs. He launched his 11th home run of the season on Sunday and his second home run in as many games. In his last 28 games, Wendzel is slashing .320/.426/.680 with 10 doubles, nine home runs, 25 RBI, 23 runs scored and 18 walks.

ANOTHER BIG INNING

The 10-run fifth inning for the E-Train in Sunday's win over Sugar Land is the second-most runs for Round Rock in a single inning this season after the club recorded an 11-run first inning on Saturday. It was the 20th inning that saw four or more runs this season. The club added a second big inning on the night with a four-run sixth frame.

CRIM CRUSHES TWO TRIPLES

Express 1B Blaine Crim notched two triples in the fifth inning, which snapped a 0-for-14 streak that spanned nearly six games. Crim finished Sunday 4-for-5 with one double, two triples and three RBI. Before his two triples on Sunday, the infielder had hit just three triples since making his professional debut in 2019.

ROSTER MOVES

The Texas Rangers reactivated RHP Spencer Howard from the 7-Day Injured List on Monday. Tuesday saw LHP Josh Dye placed on Round Rock's 7-Day Injured List while OF J.P. Martinez rejoined the team after spending time on the Injured List with a groin injury. Before his injury, Martinez had hit .350 (28-80) with 15 stolen bases in 22 games with the Express.

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2023 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's Pacific Coast League debut. Davis spent the previous two years as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the

In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.
