Tonight's Game: The Nashville Sounds and Indianapolis Indians play the third of a six-game set tonight at First Horizon Park. The two clubs have split the first two games of the series. Tonight, right-hander Thomas Jankins starts for Nashville against right-hander Beau Sulser for Indianapolis.

Thomas Jankins: 25-year-old Thomas Jankins makes his seventh appearance (fifth start) for Nashville. He has gone 0-2 with an 11.57 ERA (24 ER/18.2 IP). Jankins last pitched on June 6 at Charlotte in his second straight relief appearance. In 2019, Jankins went 11-5 with a 4.19 ERA in 25 games (23 starts) with Triple-A San Antonio and Double-A Biloxi. He finished tied for fifth in the Pacific Coast League for wins (10), logged 10 quality starts and four starts of 6+ IP and one or less runs allowed. The Massachusetts native was named a Southern League All-Star in 2018 after he went 10-9 with a 4.42 ERA with Double-A Biloxi. The Brewers drafted Jankins in the 13th round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft.

Beau Sulser: 27-year-old Beau Sulser starts for the Indians tonight. The right-hander is 2-2 with a 5.18 ERA in 6 starts with Indianapolis in 2021. He has worked 24.1 innings and has allowed 19 runs (14 earned) on 36 hits and 6 walks to go along with 28 strikeouts. Opposing batters are hitting .330 against him. He last worked on June 4 against Columbus and got a no decision. Sulser allowed 2 runs on 6 hits in 4.1 innings. He walked 1 and struck out 7. The Pirates drafted the California native in the 10th round of the 2017 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of Dartmouth.

2021 Standings: The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the Triple-A East Southeast Division standings in 2021: First: 16, Second: 5, Third: 1, Fourth: 13, Fifth: 2, Sixth: 0, Seventh: 0.

June Arms Race: As Nashville's winning streak took off in late May, the pitching has continued to have success in the month of June. Despite the 4-4 June record, Nashville pitchers have recorded a league-best 3.22 ERA (24 ER/67.0 IP). They have combined for 79 strikeouts, a 1.04 WHIP and are holding opposing hitters to a .174 batting average in June. The WHIP and batting average against are the best marks in the Triple-A East in June.

Crooked Numbers: The Sounds had 3 multi-run innings last night, scoring 2 in the first, 4 in the second and 3 in the fourth. Nashville has scored 4 runs in an inning on 7 different occasions this season.

Shut The Door: The Nashville pitching staff allowed just 2 hits in the win last night, the fewest this season since May 23 vs. Gwinnett (1).

Turn Around for Wilson: Weston Wilson has reached base safely in 11 consecutive games (5/27-present), batting .314 (11-for-35) with 8 runs, 4 doubles, 4 home runs, 5 RBI and 11 BB during the streak. Prior to beginning the streak, Wilson was batting .174 (4-for-23).

Honors for Ashby: Aaron Ashby was named Triple-A East Pitcher of the Week for his play from 5/31-6/6. He joins Tyrone Taylor as Sounds players to win a weekly league honor. The left-hander's lone start was 6/4 at Charlotte, he struck out a season-high 11 batters and allowed 1 unearned run on 2 hits in 7.0 IP. Ashby was tagged with a tough-luck loss in Nashville's 1-0 setback. Ashby is among Triple-A East League leaders in batting average against (2nd, .168) and strikeouts (2nd, 42).

Hiura We Go: Keston Hiura was optioned from Milwaukee to Nashville on 6/7 after being recalled on 5/24. Since being recalled, Hiura hit .069 (2-for-29) with 16 K in 11 games with Milwaukee. Hiura has hit safely in 9 of his 11 games with the Sounds, batting .425 (17-for-40) with 9 runs, 6 doubles, 3 home runs, 8 RBI and 5 BB.

Sounds at a Glance: The Sounds have won 19 of their last 25 games and 22 of their last 29. At 10-4, Nashville has the third-best home record in the Triple-A East, trailing only Omaha (15-3) and Indianapolis (9-3). The Sounds snapped a 4-game losing streak last night.

Grass Is Always Greener: Sounds infielder Zach Green is among Triple-A East League leaders in home runs (T-1st, 9) and RBI (2nd, 27).

How Sweet It Is: Manager Rick Sweet is at the helm for the Sounds in 2021, as he was in 2014 when he led the club to a 77-67 record. Sweet has managed for all or parts of 30 seasons in the minor leagues and has compiled a managerial record of 2,049-1,930. The 2,049 wins are 11th-most all-time among all minor league managers. 10th on the list is Lefty O'Doul who won 2,094 games from 1935-57.

The Milwaukee Era: A new era of Nashville Sounds baseball began on February 12, 2021 when the club announced its affiliation with the Milwaukee Brewers. The affiliation with Milwaukee came after the Sounds signed a 10-year Professional Development License (PDL) with Major League Baseball as part of the 20-team Triple-A East League. Within the Triple-A East League, the Sounds are a member of the seven-team Southeast Division.

THIS DATE IN HISTORY

On this date in 2018, the Sounds lost a heartbreaker to Tacoma. They tied the game at 2-2 in the 9th before ultimately falling to the Rainiers, 5-4, in 10 innings.
