On the Field: The Lugnuts (10-1 in their last 11 home games!) go for a third straight victory over the Chiefs in a six-game series, the penultimate homestand of the season. These are the only meetings of the year between the two teams, not to mention the first meetings between Lansing and Peoria in 808 days (but no heartbreak) dating back to 2024.

Yesterday: Nuts 4, Chiefs 3. After **Sammy Hernandez** tied the game with a home run in the top of the 8th, **Pedro Pineda** led off the bottom of the 8th with a triple and **Daniel Bucciero** singled him in to lift the Lugnuts to the Wednesday matinee victory. Pineda finished the game 3-for-3 with two doubles, one triple and two walks out of the leadoff slot.

LUG-NOTES

Who's Hot: 18-year-old **Breyson Guede** went 3-for-4, HBP yesterday and is 7-for-14 in his last three games and batting .317 in his first 14 games in High-A. **Pedro Pineda** has a 1.129 OPS in August; 15-for-43, six doubles, two triples, two homers, .349/.408/.721.

Who's Streaking: A third outfielder on the roster, **Jake Reinisch**, went 2-for-5 with a pair of singles yesterday, extending his on-base streak to 30 games, the longest of the Nuts' season. Reinisch is batting .298/.434/.519 with 31 base hits and 23 walks during the streak.

No Place Like Home: With yesterday's win, the Lugnuts are 9-1 in their last 10 home games. For the year, the Nuts are 6-2-2 in home series and are averaging 6.28 runs/game, the best run-scoring home rate in the Midwest League. Lansing's overall 30-23 home record trails only Great Lakes (33-25) and South Bend (33-19) among MWL teams; not coincidentally, those are the top two teams in the league.

Roll Call: Second baseman **Jared Davis** had a sparkling Lansing Lugnuts debut yesterday, going 2-for-2 with a single, double, walk and sacrifice. The 22-year-old, the Athletics' 17th-round selection in 2025 out of Virginia Tech, is the 1,010th all-time Nut and the 50th different Lugnut of 2026. A native of Orlando, Davis was batting .300 with a .459 OBP and 10 steals in 48 games in the Arizona Complex League. His older brother, Austin, played five years at West Virginia and is currently in his second year as a regular for Sioux City (American Association).

Transactions: Earlier today, catcher **Logan Sauve** was promoted to Double-A Midland, starter **Devin Kirby-Williams** was given his release, and the Lugnuts added infielder **Tanner Marsh** and starting pitcher **Jose Parra** from the Arizona Complex League Athletics. Marsh, 21, was the A's ninth-round selection in the 2026 draft from Liberty University where he started all 56 games at shortstop, batted .295 with a .378 OBP and a team-hit 18 steals, and gained renown for his defensive ability. A native of Asheboro, N.C., Marsh is the first 2026 A's draft pick to join the Lugnuts.

Movin' on up:

• Infielders **Ali Camarillo** and **Jared Sprague-Lott** earned promotions up to Double-A Midland to start the week. Camarillo, 23, had just been named to the A's Top 30 Prospects list in MLB Pipeline's re-ranking of the organization, incorporating the 2026 Draft class and breakout prospects. He exits the High-A level with the following Midwest League ranks: No. 4 in doubles (23), No. 6 in base hits (97), No. 7 in batting average (.284). Camarillo further leads the Lugnuts in at-bats (342), total bases (135), RBIs (58), HBPs (8) and steals (20 in 21 attempts), all the while drawing 32 walks and striking out only 56 times in 86 games. slashed .284/.355/.395 with 23 doubles, five home runs and 20 stolen bases. Over two stints with the Lugnuts in 2026, Sprague-Lott hit .250/.365/.357 with 10 doubles, one triple, five home runs and 17 stolen bases. Both players were hot in July, with Camarillo hitting .313 and Sprague-Lott batting .306.

2009: It was a nightmarish start for Fort Wayne's Dexter Carter: HBP, single, RBI single, HBP, two-run single, single, RBI single, strikeout, RBI walk, and then a three-run double by leadoff hitter Chris Emanuele in the second tour around the order, knocking Carter out of the game. In all, the Lugnuts scored eight runs in the 1st on their way to a 15-7 victory at Parkview Field. 3B Mark Sobolewski went 4-for-6 with a double, a home run, and four RBIs, and the Lugnuts collected 18 hits in all.

2017: Nick Sinay was hit by a pitch for the 36th time, tying the Midwest League single-season record set by Clinton's Jonathan "Dirt" Greene in 2008, but the Lugnuts lost to South Bend, 8-6, at Cooley Law School Stadium. It was one of three Nuts HBPs in the game, giving them 104 total, nine away from tying the MWL record.

What a Year! As a senior at Westbrook Christian H.S., 1) threw four no-hitters, one a perfect game, as a senior, going 9-0, 0.40 ERA, 53 IP, 14 H, 5 BB, 117 K, and 2) batted .515 with .612 OBP, 4 HR, 39 RBI, leading Warriors to 2021 state title (first title in school history)... named Collegiate Baseball First Team All-American.

College - From Tiger to Tiger: Spent three years at LSU, one year at Auburn... ascended to Game 3 starter as true freshman at LSU in 2022, spent 2023 as reliever and was named SEC Academic Honor Roll (sport administration), majority reliever in 2024 (tossing 1 1/3 scoreless IP vs. Tennessee in SEC championship game)... transferred to AU for senior season and was named Second Team All-SEC (first Auburn player to earn All-SEC since 2018) and ABCA First Team All-Southeast Region... led Auburn in wins (7) and strikeouts (95), the most strikeouts for a Tiger since 2019... played with older brother Andrew at Auburn; Andrew had been at Birmingham-Southern for four years, forced to transfer when they shut their baseball program; he transferred in to Auburn for 2025 and blasting a home run in his only plate appearance of the year.
