Daniel Bucciero began the rally with a two-run homer to center field before ending the frame's scoring with an RBI double to left.

LUG-NOTES

Promotions galore: Three Lugnuts starting pitchers have been promoted to Double-A Midland in the last two days:

- Athletics No. 28 ranked prospect (MLB Pipeline) **Nathan Dettmer** received the call up to Double-A Midland yesterday. In 10 starts for the Lugnuts, Dettmer had a 4.08 ERA and a 1.43 WHIP with 51 strikeouts, allowing just two home runs and accumulating a 3-4 record. Dettmer pitched a scoreless 6th inning of relief for the Rockhounds yesterday, striking out one with one hit-by-pitch.
- Lansing ace **Zane Taylor** was called up today. The No. 16 A's prospect (MLB Pipeline) leads the Midwest League in ERA (3.22), is third in BAA (.234) and second in WHIP (1.21) over the fourth-most innings pitched (81.0).
- Pitcher **Ben Hansen** also moves up. In five games with the Nuts, Hansen had a 2.16 ERA and a 0.96 WHIP over 8 ⅓ innings. Hansen made his first start for the squad on Sunday, allowing two hits, one run, two walks and five strikeouts over 3 ⅓ innings.
- In a corresponding move, **Devin Kirby** joins the Lugnuts from Class-A Stockton. Kirby, 26, spent 2025 in the Twins' (Fort Myers) and Orioles' (Delmarva and Aberdeen) organizations before opening this season in the Atlantic League's Southern Maryland Blue Crabs' starting rotation. After five starts for Southern Maryland, Kirby's contract was purchased by the A's. He made four appearances in the Arizona Complex League (1.38 ERA, 13 IP, 2 ER, 2 BB, 18 K) and six appearances with Stockton (5.70 ERA, 23 2/3 IP, 15 ER, 5 BB, 18 K). Kirby is a native of Ukiah, California.

Bucciero's Blast: Former Fordham Ram **Daniel Bucciero** crushed his first roundtripper at the High-A level last night, telling David Powell after the game, "Honestly, I was just going up there swinging first pitch and just trying to get the head out and try to pull something, and it was fastball middle in and got enough of it to get it out to center. Getting the first one out of the way always feels good. Hopefully got some more coming." Over nine games with Lansing, Bucciero is hitting .258 with an OPS of .862 with eight hits, six runs scored, six RBIs and six walks.

Major League Notables:

- This is the second time in franchise history that four players have vaulted from the Lugnuts to MLB in one season, joining 2023.
- There are 12 former Nuts on the Athletics' active roster: pitchers **Gage Jump**, **Yunior Tur**, **Brady Basso**, **Hogan Harris** and **Jack Perkins**; infielders **Max Muncy**, **Tommy White** and **Jacob Wilson**; and outfielders **Henry Bolte**, **Lawrence Butler**, **Tyler Soderstrom** and **Colby Thomas**.
- With White's and Tur's arrival, nine former Lugnuts have made their MLB debut this season and 209 have achieved the feat all-time.

Welcome to the Lugnuts: Since the last time the Nuts were at home, the ballclub added a bunch of newcomers: pitcher **Ben Hansen**, catchers **Bryan Arendt** and **Logan Sauve**, infielder **Daniel Bucciero** and outfielder **Jake Reinisch**. The Lugnuts have used 46 total players this season (24 pitchers, 22 position players), bringing the total to 1,006 all-time Nuts in 30 years of Lansing baseball.

Lugnut All-Stars: In the 2026 Major League All-Star Game, 2017 Lugnut **Vladimir Guerrero, Jr.** was voted to start at first base for the A.L., but took the game off; 2019 Nut **Otto López** (Miami Marlins shortstop, N.L. reserve) went 1-for-2 with a single and a strikeout; and 2022 Nut **Mason Miller** (San Diego Padres closer) struck out the only batter he faced, the White Sox' Munetaka Murakami.

Cooperstown Bound: A member of the very first Lugnuts lineup on April 5, 1996, **Carlos Beltrán** went on to be voted 1999 American League Rookie of the Year, was named a nine-time All-Star, and won three Gold Gloves, two Silver Sluggers, the Roberto Clemente Humanitarian Award, and the 2017 World Series during a 20-year MLB career. On July 27, Beltrán will be inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown.

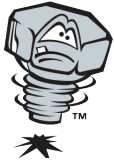

JULY 22 IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2009: Mike McDade hit a simply monstrous home run off Austin Bibens-Dirx over the parking lot in Peoria out beyond right-center (estimated over 450 ft.) and the Lugnuts beat the Chiefs, 6-2, behind five shutout innings from Henderson Alvarez.

2017: Griffin Jax, a third-round selection from the Air Force Academy in 2016, pitched 6 2/3 innings before departing to a standing ovation on his way to reporting to active duty with the U.S. Air Force, and the host Cedar Rapids Kernals topped the Lugnuts, 12-4.

2022: 2021 first-rounder Max Muncy debuted with a 2-for-5 performance, delivering doubles in each of his first two at-bats, and 2020 first-rounder Tyler Soderstrom went 2-for-4 with a walk and a 444-foot home run out of the park to right-center, but the Lake County Captains built a 7-0 lead, gave up six runs, and then scored 11 unanswered to rout the Lugnuts, 18-6, in Lansing.

Last Time Out: Started at Lake County on July 12: 4 2/3 IP, 6 H, 2 R, 1 BB, 4 K on 85 pitches, 51 strikes... allowed solo tallies in the 3rd and the 5th... departed with a 3-2 lead, and the Lugnuts' bullpen combined for 4 1/3 scoreless IP to secure the 3-2 win.

What a Year! As a senior at Westbrook Christian H.S., 1) threw four no-hitters, one a perfect game, as a senior, going 9-0, 0.40 ERA, 53 IP, 14 H, 5 BB, 117 K, and 2) batted .515 with .612 OBP, 4 HR, 39 RBII, leading Warriors to 2021 state title (first title in school history)... named Collegiate Baseball First Team All-American.

College - From Tiger to Tiger: Spent three years at LSU, one year at Auburn... ascended to Game 3 starter as true freshman at LSU in 2022, spent 2023 as reliever and was named SEC Academic Honor Roll (sport administration), majority reliever in 2024 (tossing 1 1/3 scoreless IP vs. Tennessee in SEC championship game)... transferred to AU for senior season and was named Second Team All-SEC (first Auburn player to earn All-SEC since 2018) and ABCA First Team All-Southeast Region... led Auburn in wins (7) and strikeouts (95), the most strikeouts for a Tiger since 2019... played with older brother Andrew at Auburn; Andrew had been at Birmingham-Southern for four years, forced to transfer when they shut their baseball program; he transferred in to Auburn for 2025 and blasting a home run in his only plate appearance of the year.
