**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels beat the Baysox, 9-5, at Prince George's Stadium. After trailing, 5-2, heading into the seventh, Richmond scored seven runs in the final three innings. In the top of the seventh, **Alerick Soularie** hit a grand slam to give Richmond a 6-5 lead. **Ismael Munguia** added an RBI single in the eighth. **Jairo Pomares** hit a two-run homer, his team-high 10th of the season, to push the lead to 9-5 in the ninth. **Will Wilson** opened the scoring with a sac fly in the first inning. The Baysox scored five runs in the third to take a 5-1 lead, including a solo homer by Ryan Higgins, a three-run homer by Samuel Basallo and an RBI single by Matthew Etzel. **Brandon Martorano** started the rally with an RBI single in the fourth. **Seth Lonsway** started and allowed five runs, all in the third with two outs, and finished his day with five strikeouts in five innings. **Kyle Cody** pitched a scoreless sixth. **Kolton Ingram** worked around a pair of walks for a scoreless seventh in his Richmond debut. **Tanner Kiest** picked up his third save with two scoreless innings.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels face the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles, in the first of a three-game series. To start this week, Richmond took two-of-three in Bowie. In the Flying Squirrels' first trip to Bowie this season, they won five-of-six games in a series from May 21-26, with the lone loss being a 2-1 defeat on May 23. In that series, they outscored the Baysox, 46-26. This is Richmond's final series against Bowie this year. The Flying Squirrels won four-of-six at The Diamond against the Baysox from April 23-28. The Flying Squirrels have a 44-28 all-time record in sellouts.

**BOOM BOOM:** The Flying Squirrels have played at home every season on Independence Day since the franchise's first year in 2010, and each year the game has sold out. The team's first July 4 game was in 2010 and the Flying Squirrels beat the Erie SeaWolves, 4-3, with a walk-off single by Clay Timpner in the bottom of the 10th inning. They also won on a walk-off hit by C.J. Hinojosa in 2014, topping the SeaWolves, 4-3. Overall, the Flying Squirrels are 11-2 on July 4, with the only losses coming against Akron in 2013 and 2018. All time, the Flying Squirrels have outscored opponents, 96-51 (average 7.4-3.9) on Independence Day. Tonight marks the second time the Flying Squirrels have played the Baysox on July 4. Last year, they scored seven runs in the bottom of the eighth, including three homers, to beat Bowie, 11-5.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have 2-1 this week against the Baysox. They dropped four straight games to open the second half last week after going 7-2 in their previous nine games and 8-4 on their last 12-game road trip to New Hampshire and Portland. For the year, the Flying Squirrels are hitting .220 and averaging 3.8 runs per game (134 runs/35 games) at home compared to a .237 batting average and 4.93 runs per game on the road (202 runs/42 games).

**THE BAYSOX** went 4-2 last week at Reading to open the Eastern League's second half before dropping two-of-three against the Flying Squirrels in Bowie to open this week. In the first half of the season, they went 32-36, finishing in fifth place in the Southwest Division. Bowie is hitting .226 as a team this year, 11th in the league. The Baysox pitching staff has a 3.95 team ERA, fourth-best in the league and has allowed 82 homers, most in the circuit. Bowie's roster includes 10 of Baseball America's top-30 Orioles prospects, including C Samuel Basallo (No. 2), RHP Seth Johnson (No. 9), OF Dylan Beavers (No. 10), OF Jud Fabian (No. 12), 3B Max Wagner (No. 14), RHP Trace Bright (No. 20), OF John Rhodes (No. 26), RHP Alex Pham (No. 27), SS Frederick Bencosme (No. 28) and RHP Keagan Gillies (No. 29). Baseball America ranks Samuel Basallo as the best power hitter in the Orioles system, Silas Ardoin as the best defensive catcher, Jud Fabian as the best outfield arm and Trace Bright as having the best curveball. MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects list includes nine Bowie players, including Basallo (No. 2), Beavers (No. 7), Johnson (No. 10), Fabian (No. 12), Wagner (No. 14), Bright (No. 16), Rhodes (No. 23), Pham (No. 24) and Bencosme (No. 27).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Nick Sinacola** makes his sixth Double-A start. After allowing five runs in his Double-A debut on June 6, he has gone 3-0 with a 1.64 ERA (4 ER/22.0 IP) in his last four starts since June 12. In the Giants organization this year, Lonsway ranks first in wins (7), first in WHIP (0.90), second in ERA (2.70) and tied for second in BAA (.197). He began the season with High-A Eugene and went 4-1 with a 2.68 ERA in 10 outings, including two starts. At the time of his promotion to Double-A, Sinacola ranked second among Northwest League pitchers (min. 40 IP) in WHIP (0.79), third in BB/9 (1.56), third in BAA (.190), ninth in ERA (2.68), and 10th in K/9 (8.48). He spent the entire 2023 season with the Emeralds and went 2-5 with a 4.58 ERA over 23 outings (20 starts). Sinacola was selected by the Giants in the seventh round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of the University of Maine, where he was the America East Pitcher of the Year that season as a senior. **For more on Sinacola, see page two.**

**FOR BOWIE:** Right-hander Alex Pham makes his 16th start of the season and his third this year against the Flying Squirrels. Last time out, Pham pitched 4.1 innings at Reading on Friday and allowed three runs with seven strikeouts in a loss. He pitched at The Diamond on April 24 and allowed three runs over five innings in a no-decision. In Bowie on May 24, he allowed a career-high nine runs in four innings against the Flying Squirrels. In his career, Pham has a 6.86 ERA (16 ER/21.0 IP) in five games against the Flying Squirrels. For the season, Pham ranks tied for fourth in the Eastern League with 84 strikeouts. He ranks second in the league in K/9 (11.75) and strikeout percentage (30.3). He was selected by the Orioles in the 19th round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of the University of San Francisco. Pham is rated by Baseball America as the No. 24 Orioles prospect and No. 27 by MLB.com.

**CARTER'S CRUISING:** Dating back to June 13 in 16 games, **Carter Howell** is batting .344 (22-for-64) with three doubles, two triples and 12 RBIs. In that stretch, he has picked up three hits three times. He has two triples in his last seven games, including an RBI triple last Thursday night. His four triples are tied for the most in the Eastern League this season. He is also tied for sixth in doubles (16), eighth in batting average (.285) and tied for eighth in hits (70).

**BERICOTO BASHING:** In his last 21 games dating back to June 6, **Victor Bericoto** is hitting .360 (32-for-89) with three homers, five doubles, five walks and 14 RBIs. After leading the Giants organization in homers (27) last year, Bericoto hit just one homer in his first 34 games this season through May 21. From May 22-28, he homered three times in five games. He went deep again on June 14 at New Hampshire and added a homer on June 18 at Portland. In his last 31 games since May 22, Bericoto is batting .331 (40-for-121) with six homers, six doubles, 11 walks and 23 RBIs. Bericoto has picked up multiple hits in eight-of-13 games dating back to June 15 and is batting .389 (21-for-54) in that stretch.

**TO THE MUNGUIA:** Since being assigned to Richmond on June 19, **Ismael Munguia** is batting .340 (16-for-47) and has added two stolen bases. He has at least one hit in 10 of his 11 games played, including a three-hit game and four two-hit games. On Monday, he hit his first Richmond homer of the year, a two-run shot. He played 50 games with Triple-A Sacramento to open the year and batted .250 (36-for-144) in the Pacific Coast League. Munguia played 75 games for the Flying Squirrels last year and hit .282 (83-for-294), which led the team (min. 200 PA).

**PACKING THE HOUSE:** The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans in April for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and are ranked sixth among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance (6,862).

**PROSPECT WATCH:** Four of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the Richmond roster, including OF **Vaun Brown** (No. 10), RHP **Trevor McDonald** (No. 18), RHP **Eric Silva** (No. 20), C **Adrián Sugastey** (No. 23) and RHP **José Cruz** (No. 28). On Baseball America's Best Tools list, Sugastey is rated as the best defensive catcher and **John Michael Bertrand** is rated as having the best control. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features five Richmond players, including McDonald (No. 12), Brown (No. 15), OF **Victor Bericoto** (No. 19), Sugastey (No. 23) and OF **Jairo Pomares** (No. 26).

Bowie took an early 2-0 lead but Vaun Brown moved Richmond ahead with a three-run homer in the third. Bowie pulled ahead, 5-4, in the seventh. In the bottom of the eighth, Wade Meckler hit a go-ahead two-run homer. Later in the inning, Marco Luciano and Shane Matheny hit back-to-back homers. Hayden Cantrelle capped the seven-run frame with an RBI single.
