TODAY'S GAME / OPPOSING STARTER: The Curve roll into New Hampshire for their first week-long series at the Toronto Blue Jays affiliate since 2022. New Hampshire features former Curve INF Charles McAdoo who was traded to Toronto in exchange for Isiah Kiner-Falefa last July.

On the mound, Ryan Watson takes the ball in the series opener. Watson is a 26-year-old who played his college ball at Georgia state and signed with the Jays as an undrafted free agent in 2023. Watson attended North Gwinnett high school and rose to become Georgia State's top starter in his 5 year career there. His father, Randy played baseball at Georgia Tech.

THE TERMINATOR: Infielder Termarr Johnson, who has not yet faced a pitcher younger than him in his professional career, has reached base safely in 39-of-46 games played this year. Johnson has picked up a hit in 18-of-26 games since May 1 recording 8 extra-base hits and 11 RBI in that time. <u>He is one of five players at the level</u> who have recorded an .800 OPS or better this season when playing 2B.

COMEBACK KIDS: Altoona rallied from a late deficit in each of the final two games of their series with Portland on May 31 and June 1 to earn a series split. The Curve trailed by at least four runs after the top of the sixth inning in both games and rallied back for a win.

MORE LIKE NICK SLAMILLO: First baseman Nick Cimillo has hit his stride in the final two weeks of May, capped off by a game-tying Grand Slam against Portland in the 6th inning of a 7-inning game on May 31. In his last 16 games, he's hitting .333/.396/.604/1.000 OPS with 2 2B, 1 3B, 3 HR and 12 RBI. Cimillo has 4 multi-hit games during this stretch of play since May 14.

WE'RE AT THE DOTEL HOTEL: Starter Wilber Dotel has used a vastly improved splitter this season to become a true strikeout artist. This season, he holds a 20.5% K-BB% after he recorded an 11.2% mark in 2024 with Greensboro. <u>In his last 8 outings, he's struck out 48 batters in 35.2 IP. He ranks 4th in the Eastern League in</u> strikeouts (55) and 10th in IP (44.1).

NOTHING SULLEN: Righty Sean Sullivan has allowed an earned run in one of his six outings with the Curve this year. After he allowed just 2 runs or fewer in 19-of-34 career starts across the 2023 and '24 seasons in the rotation. Sullivan has taken his typical effectiveness to the bullpen where he's allowed 3 runs (1 earned) in 13.2 innings, he's picked up 13 strikeouts and allowed just 6 hits (.133 BAA) with only 2 walks (0.59 WHIP)

JEBBIDIAH: Mitch Jebb had a hit in 19-of-27 games in the month of May, totaling a .297 average and .377 onbase percentage in the calendar month. Jebb ranks 8th in the Eastern League in batting average (.291), 7th in OBP (.385), and 3rd in SB (17).

ENTER SANDMAN: Closer Cam Sanders has dazzled in his 16 outings with the Curve this season, keeping the opponent off the board in 12-of-16 outings. His .143 batting average against ranks 5th among Eastern League relievers (min. 20.0 IP), he is also 2nd in saves (9) among minor league players.

WE'LL SEE THEM ALL: For the first time since the 2019 season and the creation of the six-game series, the Curve will face every team in the Eastern League this season. Altoona will face New Hampshire and Binghamton on the road only, while Hartford and Reading will only play the Curve at PNG Field.
