EARLY DEFICIT SINKS JACKSONVILLE

The Jumbo Shrimp could not overcome a 6-0 deficit on Friday in a 6-4 loss to the Storm Chasers. Omaha jumped out to a 3-0 lead in the first and added another run in the second and two more in the fourth. A **Victor Mesa Jr.** RBI double and **Javier Sanoja** RBI single in the fifth halved the lead. In the eighth, **Griffin Conine** collected an RBI double to pull Jacksonville within 6-4. The Jumbo Shrimp brought the go-ahead run to the plate in the ninth, but **Will Klein** picked up his sixth save for Omaha. Conine reached base three times in the effort.

ALWAYS THE BRIDE. NEVER THE BRIDESMAID

Jumbo Shrimp infielder **Jonah Bride** has had two short stints in the major leagues this season, batting 2-for-12. With Jacksonville, however, Bride is 32-for-98 (.327/.464/.663/1.127) with seven doubles, one triple, eight home runs, 18 RBIs, 22 walks and 16 runs scored in 28 games played. The Owasso, Okla., native ranks third in the IL in OBP, slugging percentage and OPS, respectively, eighth in batting average, tied for ninth in home runs, tied for 15th in extra-base hits (16) and tied for 16th in walks.

TO THE VICTOR GO THE SPOILS

Jacksonville outfielder **Victor Mesa Jr.** missed the first six games of the season with an injury, but the 22-year-old has quickly made up for that lost time. In 28 games thus far with the Jumbo Shrimp, Mesa Jr. is 33-for-113, slashing .292/.357/.513/.870 with seven doubles, six home runs, 26 RBIs, 12 walks and 22 runs scored. In 123 games last season with Double-A Pensacola, Mesa Jr. struck out in 22.9 percent of his plate appearances. He has shaved that to 15.9 percent this season with Jacksonville.

TWO DOWN, A MILE TO GO

Over the club's last seven games dating back to May 3, the Jumbo Shrimp have surrendered 47 runs (6.7 per game), the ninth-most in Triple-A during that span. Of those 47 runs, a whopping 29, or 61.7 percent, have come with two outs. On the season, Jacksonville pitching has ceded 112 hits in 103.1 innings pitched with two outs, the third-most in Triple-A. Opponents are hitting .267 with an .809 OPS against the Jumbo Shrimp with two down, both of which respectively represent the fourth-highest marks at the level.

NOT GREAT, BOB

After falling 6-4 on Friday at Omaha, Jacksonville has now dropped nine of its last 10 games. The Jumbo Shrimp have struggled in nearly every facet of the game during this stretch. Offensively over this stretch, the club ranks 25th in Triple-A in batting average (.228), 27th in OBP (.318), 26th in SLG (.351), 27th in OPS (.669), 27th in runs scored (40), tied for 24th in hits (76) and tied for 27th in runs scored. On the other side of the ball, Jacksonville has surrendered the eighth-most hits (97) and tied for the 10th-most runs (61) on the seventh-worst BAA (.280) and eighth-worst OPS-against (.833).

FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

A remarkable 24 of Jacksonville's 37 games (64.9 percent) in 2024 have been decided by three runs or fewer, including six straight contests and nine of the club's last 10 affairs. After beginning the season 12-3 (.750) in these narrowly-decided contests, the Jumbo Shrimp have suddenly struggled in games determined by no more than three runs. Jacksonville has lost eight of its last nine games decided by three runs or fewer. Last season, 85 of the club's 149 games (57.0 percent) were determined by no more than three runs, with the club going 39-46 (.459) in those contests.

TROY MEETS WORLD

Troy Johnston, the Miami Marlins Minor League Player of the Year in 2023, got off to a slow start this season. Through his first 16 games, the Puyallup, Wash., batted just .203/.292/.234/.526 with two doubles, six RBIs, four walks and three runs scored. In his last 21 games, however, Johnston is 26-for-87 at the plate, hitting .299/.337/.437/.774 with nine doubles, one home run, 10 RBIs, four walks and 13 runs scored. He has reached base at least once in 18 of the 21 games during this hot stretch, recording multiple times on base nine times.

SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville has made an error in five consecutive games entering play on Saturday, a season-worst stretch... After an 0-for-19 stretch from May 1-5, Jumbo Shrimp outfielder **Griffin Conine** has reached base in 10 of his last 15 plate appearances over the last four games. He is 4-for-9 with a double, home run, three RBIs and six walks.

ABOUT YONNY

-A native of Bachaquero, Venezuela, Chirinos signed with the Tampa Bay Rays for \$10,000 as an international free agent from Venezuela in June 2012.

-On March 25, 2018, the Rays announced that Chirinos had made the Opening Day roster. Chirinos made his opening debut in a long relief role against the Boston Red Sox on April 1. He worked four scoreless innings while allowing just one hit. Chirinos set a franchise record by pitching his first 14 2/3 innings without allowing an earned run.

-Chirinos pitched for Tampa Bay on August 16, 2020 against the Blue Jays. His start that night followed a stint on the injured list due to right triceps inflammation. A week later, he underwent Tommy John surgery. Chirinos' rehab and recovery process was stalled in September 2021 when he fractured his elbow while throwing batting practice. The injury required surgery and, as it turned out, set him back another year. He wound up going 752 days between appearances for the Rays, finally returning to the mound on September 8, 2022. Chirinos allowed four hits, one walk and struck out four while blanking the Red Sox during a three-inning stint. When he took the mound in the fourth in relief of Jeffrey Springs, the game was scoreless. When he exited after the sixth, the Rays had a 1-0 lead. That is how the game finished and Chirinos had his first win since August 4, 2019.

-After more than a decade in the Rays' organization, Chirinos was claimed off waivers on July 23, 2023 by the Atlanta Braves. Atlanta non-tendered Chirinos in November and he signed a minor league deal with the Miami Marlins in February.

-With both Tampa Bay and Atlanta, when pitching with the bases empty, opponents posted an .832 OPS in 224 appearances. In 138 plate appearances with runners on base, that figure dropped to .794. Additionally, in 87 plate appearances with runners in scoring position, opponents compiled a .742 OPS.

-According to Baseball Savant, Chirinos was in the 87th percentile in offspeed run value (+4) while also ranking in the 71st percentile in ground ball percentage (46.3 percent).


