Tonight's Game: The Nashville Sounds begin a 13-day, 12-game road trip with a stop in Jacksonville, Florida. The Sounds and Jumbo Shrimp begin a six-game series tonight at 121 Financial Ballpark. Right-hander Adrian Houser makes a Major League rehab start for Nashville against left-hander Josh Rogers for Jacksonville.

Adrian Houser: 29-year-old Adrian Houser makes his third rehab start with Nashville in the series opener. The Brewers right-hander is 4-8 with a 4.72 ERA (76.1 IP/40 ER) in 15 starts with Milwaukee in 2022. Houser has tallied 5.0 innings in his first two rehab starts with Nashville and is 0-0. He has allowed one hit and one unearned run while walking four and striking out six. He started on August 6 at Norfolk and again on August 11 vs. Gwinnett. Houser is 21-27 with a 3.92 ERA in his Major League career, all with Milwaukee. The Brewers acquired Houser from the Astros in the trade which sent CF Carlos Gomez and RHP Mike Fiers to Houston in 2015. Houser was drafted by Houston in the second round of the 2011 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of Locust Grove (OK) High School.

Josh Rogers: 28-year-old Josh Rogers starts for the Jumbo Shrimp in tonight's series opener. The left-hander is making his second start with Jacksonville. Rogers began his season on the Washington Nationals Opening Day roster. He went 2-2 with a 5.13 ERA (26.1 IP/15 ER) in 16 games (three starts) with Washington and 0-3 with a 10.95 ERA (12.1 IP/15 ER) with Triple-A Rochester before he was designated for assignment on August 2. He signed a minor league contract with Miami on August 10 and reported to Jacksonville. Rogers started against Durham on August 10 and allowed five earned runs on five hits and three walks in 4.1 innings. He was drafted by the New York Yankees in the 11th round of the 2015 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Louisville.

2022 Standings: The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the International League West Division standings in 2022: First: 110, Second: 11, Third: 3, Fourth: 2, Fifth: 1, Sixth: 0, Seventh: 0, Eighth: 0, Ninth: 0, Tenth: 0.

Superlatives: Sunday's loss dropped the Sounds to 49-3 when leading after 7 innings...37-23 at First Horizon Park...12-7 in series finales...46-13 when scoring first...11-31 when getting out-hit...42-24 when committing at least one error.

Something Brewing: Milwaukee Brewers catcher Omar Narváez and right-handed pitcher Trevor Rosenthal have joined the Sounds on Major League rehab assignments. In 60 games, Narváez is hitting .237 (45-for-190) with 17 runs, 10 doubles, 4 home runs and 18 RBI. He was placed on Milwaukee's 10-day injured list on August 4 with a left quad strain. Rosenthal has not pitched since 2020 and is on the injured list with a left hamstring strain.

Piling up the Strikeouts: Nashville pitchers have recorded an International League-best 142 strikeouts in just 12 games in the month of August. The pitching staff also leads the IL in WHIP (1.01) and batting average against (.175).

Leading the Pack: Nashville hitters are batting a league-best .269 in the month of August. The Sounds .373 on-base percentage is also the best in the league during August.

To the Weston he Goes: Infielder/Outfielder Weston Wilson has reached safely in a team-high 10 consecutive games and has hit safely in six straight. During the 10-game streak, Wilson is hitting .243 (9-for-37) with 5 runs, 2 doubles, 2 home runs, 4 RBI and 3 walks.

The Kid Can Hit: Outfielder Sal Frelick added another hit on Sunday and has 18 in the month of August, tied for the second-most in the International League. Since joining Nashville at the beginning of August, Frelick is hitting .391 (18-for-46) with 5 runs, 3 doubles, 1 triple, 4 RBI, 7 walks and 2 stolen bases.

Among League Leaders: Shortstop Brice Turang continues to pace among the best hitters in the International League. Amongst all IL hitters, Turang is 2nd in hits (116), 3rd in runs (69) and is tied for 8th in stolen bases (23). Jon Singleton is 1st in walks (88) and tied for 10th in home runs (19).

200-Plus: Rick Sweet won his 213th game as Nashville's manager on Friday, good for 5th-most in franchise history. Don Money has the 4th-most wins in franchise history with 223. As well as Nashville, Sweet has 200+ wins with four other Triple-A teams: 1993-95 Tucson (251), 2001-03 Portland (212), 2005-11 Louisville (539) and 2015-18 Colorado Springs (282).

The Future is Now: Nashville has seven players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects, including four of the top five and six of the top 10. Outfielder Sal Frelick in the No. 2 prospect, outfielder Joey Wiemer is the No. 3 prospect, outfielder Garrett Mitchell is the No. 4 prospect, infielder Brice Turang is the No. 5 prospect, outfielder Esteury Ruiz is the No. 9 prospect, left-hander Ethan Small is the No. 10 prospect and right-hander Dylan File is the No. 25 prospect.

LAST OUTING: Houser made his second rehab appearance for Nashville on August 11 in a start against Gwinnett. He got a no-decision (3.0 IP, 0 H, 1 R, 0 ER, 3 BB, 4 K) in Nashville's 3-2 loss. Houser threw 24 of his 48 pitches for strikes.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Houser faced Jacksonville twice during the 2016 season and once in 2018 when he was a member of Double-A Biloxi.

2022 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Earned first win and quality start on 4/23 at Philadelphia.
- Tossed six scoreless innings on 4/29 vs. Chicago-NL.
- Had a loss and no decision in back-to-back quality starts on 5/17 vs. Atlanta and 5/23 vs. San Diego.
- Placed on the injured list with a right flexor strain on 7/1.

2021 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Went 10-6 with a 3.22 ERA in 28 games (26 starts) with Milwaukee...142.1 IP, 118 H, 61 R, 51 ER, 64 BB, 105 K.

- Pitched in two games in the NLDS...earned a win in game one (2.0 IP, 1 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 1 K) and took the loss in game three (1.0 IP, 3 H, 3 R, 3 ER, 1 BB).

- Went 1-6 with a 5.30 ERA in 12 games (11 starts) with the Brewers.
- Went 1-0 with a 0.75 ERA (12.0 IP, 1 ER) in his first two start of the season.
- Appeared in game two of the NL Wild Card Series at Los Angeles (2.0 IP, H, BB, K).

CAREER NOTES:

- Went 8-7 with a 3.42 ERA in 35 games (18 starts) with Milwaukee in 2019.
- Had "Tommy John" surgery on his right elbow on 7/21/16, performed by Dr. William Raasch.
- Selected by Houston in the second round of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft...signed by Jim Stevenson.

MISCELLANEOUS NOTES:

- Graduated from Lucust Grove (OK) High School where he played football and basketball in addition to baseball.
- His cousin, Bob Davis, was a Major League catcher from 1973-1981, playing with the Padres, Blue Jays and Angels organizations.
- Is a member of the Cherokee Nation and grew up speaking some Cherokee in school.
