INDY BITS

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: In his first appearance at the Triple-A level, Pirates No. 1 prospect Bubba Chandler carved through the Nashville Sounds with 7.0 shutout innings in a 6-0 win for the Indianapolis Indians on Friday night at First Horizon Park. The Indians struck for the first time in the top of the fourth with a solo home run to left field for Henry Davis against Nashville starter Logan Henderson, who was also making his Triple-A debut. Scoring halted until the top of the seventh, when Nick Yorke singled in a run before Davis followed with another RBI knock, plating Alika Williams on an infield single in which Nashville third baseman Patrick Dorrian's pursuit of the ball was impeded by Davis' broken bat flying towards him. Two more runs came in for Indianapolis in the top of the eighth thanks to a two-run double from Williams, and the Indians tied a bow on their night offensively in the top of the ninth on a sacrifice fly from Matt Gorski.

SILENCED THE SOUNDS: Led by Bubba Chandler's 7.0 scoreless innings, the Indians recorded their fourth shutout of the season last night at Nashville. It was the Indians first shutout since June 19 vs. Iowa, their first shutout on the road since May 3, 2023 (2) at Toledo, and their first 9.0-inning shutout on the road since Aug. 12, 2022, at Memphis.

CHANDLER CARVED 'EM UP: The Pittsburgh Pirates' No. 1 prospect according to MLB Pipeline, RHP Bubba Chander, made his Triple-A debut last night after being promoted from Double-A Altoona to Indianapolis on Thursday and tossed 7.0 shutout innings to spark Indy's fourth shutout of the season. He held Nashville without a hit until the bottom of the sixth inning. Chandler struck out six Sounds hitters and walked just one, racking up 14 whiffs in the game. 11 of those swings and misses came on his four-seam fastball, which topped out at 98.7 miles per hour. He began the season with the Curve and went 6-7 with a 3.70 ERA (33er/80.1ip) and 94 strikeouts in 19 games (16 starts). Chandler is now rated as the No. 49 overall prospect in Minor League Baseball after being selected by the Pirates in the third round (72nd overall) of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of North Oconee (Bogart, Ga.) High

HAMMERED BY HENRY: Henry Davis went 2-for-3 with two runs, two RBI and his 12th Triple-A home run of the season last night to help the Indians to their 6-0 shutout win at Nashville. He has now homered in each of the Indians last three series, with two homers coming in his last six games vs. Toledo (Aug. 2) and last night. Davis now has 13 total home runs this season between Indy (12) and Pittsburgh (1) after launching a career-high 19 homers between Double-A Altoona (10), Indianapolis (2) and Pittsburgh (7) in 117 total games last season. In 46 games with the Indians, he is hitting .302 (52-for-172) with 25 extra-base hits, 35 RBI, a .403 on-base percentage and .990 OPS.

ALIKA ON BASE: Alika Williams extended his on-base streak to 12 consecutive Triple-A games since July 14 last night, going 1-for-4 with a two-run double in the eighth inning. It was his second consecutive performance with a pair of RBI after not driving in a run in six consecutive games. During his 12-game on-base streak, he is hitting .370 (17-for-46) with 11 runs, four doubles, six RBI, 12 walks and just six strikeouts. Williams' 12-game on-base streak trails Seth Beer's 15-gamer as the second-longest active streak among Indians batters (counting only games with Indianapolis), and is tied for the 10th-longest streak among Indians batters this season.

NICK YORKE, NICK YORKE: Playing in his ninth game with Indianapolis after being traded to Pittsburgh from Boston on July 29 in exchange for RHP Quinn Priester, Nick Yorke extended his hit streak to 13 games with a pair of singles and an RBI last night. He is currently rated as Pittsburgh's No. 5 prospect by MLB Pipeline and has 12 hits, four extra-base hits and six RBI in his short time with Indy. During his 13-game hit streak between Triple-A Worcester and Indianapolis since July 25, he is hitting .333 (16-for-48) with six runs, six extra-base hits and eight RBI. Yorke has also reached base safely in 17 consecutive games since July 19, which is tied for the fourth-longest active on-base streak among International League leaders.

BILLY OWNS THE BASES: Billy Cook, who was traded to Pittsburgh from Baltimore in exchange for RHP Patrick Reilly on July 30, picked up where he left off after having his eight-game hit streak snapped on Thursday night. Cook has hit safely in eight of 10 games since July 26 (1) with Triple-A Norfolk with a .522 batting average (18-for-34), nine runs, eight doubles, one triple, two home runs and eight RBI between Norfolk and Indianapolis. His streak featured a stretch of two extra-base hits in four consecutive games, the longest such streak in the International League since at least 2015. He began the season with the Tides and hit .279 (73-for-262) with 42 runs, 15 doubles, three triples, 11 home runs and 43 RBI in 70 games between two stints.

TONIGHT: The Indians continue a six-game series at First Horizon Park, home of the Milwaukee Brewers-affiliated Nashville Sounds, tonight at 7:35 PM ET. The Indians have gone 11-15 vs. the Sounds since 2021, going 2-4 last year during one series at Victory Field, and are looking to take a series lead with a win tonight. Taking the mound for Indianapolis is RHP Thomas Harrington (0-0, 7.94), who made his Triple-A debut last week. Countering for the Sounds is RHP Carlos Rodriguez (6-7, 5.09), who has never faced Indianapolis after making one start in Triple-A last season.

THIS DATE IN 1941: Pitcher Ray Starr became the second Indians hurler in the Bush Stadium era to win 20 games with a 10-5 win over St. Paul in the first game of a doubleheader. Unlike other times in his career where he pitched in both games of a doubleheader, Starr only pitched in Game 1 as Indianapolis split the twin bill. He went the distance and allowed five runs on seven hits and five walks with four strikeouts. The following season, Starr was selected as an All-Star for the Cincinnati Reds and finished the year with a 2.67 ERA (82er/276.2ip).

Thomas Harrington: Right-hander Thomas Harrington makes his Triple-A road debut today after making his home debut on 8/4. He is currently rated as Pittsburgh's No. 6 prospect by MLB Pipeline after going 2-2 with a 2.24 ERA (17er/68.1ip) with the Curve.

Last Outing: Harrington logged 5.2 innings with four strikeouts in his first Triple-A start vs. Toledo on August 4.

Against the Sounds: Harrington has never faced Nashville.

Punch 'Em Out, Tommy: Harrington fanned double-digit batters in back-to-back starts with the Curve on July 10 vs. Bowie and July 20 at Somerset. The prior featured 11 strikeouts across 7.0 one-run innings, tying his career-high in both innings and punchouts.

SAL Player of the Week: Chandler was named the South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Week on June 11, 2023, after tossing 7.0 shutout innings with two hits, no walks and eight strikeouts. After giving up back-to-back fourth-inning ingles, he retired his final 11 batters consecutively.

Miscellaneous: Selected by Pittsburgh in the first round (36th overall) of the 2022 First-Year Player Draft out of Campbell (Buies Creek, N.C.) University.
