YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels shut out the Fightin Phils, 2-0, for their fifth consecutive win. **Carson Ragsdale** picked up his first Double-A win and set a Richmond career high with nine strikeouts over five scoreless innings. **Evan Gates** worked the sixth and seventh and **Eric Silva** picked up his first Double-A save with two scoreless innings to finish the game. **Grant McCray** hit a solo homer in the second inning, his team-leading fifth of the season. **Luis Toribio** brought in a run with a groundout to extend the lead to 2-0 in the third.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels face the Reading Fightin Phils, Double-A affiliate of the Philadelphia Phillies, in the finale of a six-game series. This week marks the only series between the two team this season. Last year, the Flying Squirrels went 8-1 against the Fightin Phils, their best record against Reading in franchise history. Richmond swept a three-game series at The Diamond to open the season and won five-of-six at Reading in June and July.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have won five straight games after going 1-12 over a 13-game span from April 28-May 12, including 1-11 on the last road trip to Akron and Erie. They had lost eight straight games before winning on Wednesday night. In their last series at home, the Flying Squirrels picked up their first series win of the year, taking four-of-six against the Baysox. They clinched a win in this series on Friday afternoon.

THE FIGHTIN PHILS are in fifth place in the Eastern League's Northeast Division. They won five-of-six in last week's series in Reading against Hartford, outscoring the Yard Goats 34-23 for the series. Reading's roster includes five of Baseball America's top-30 Phillies prospects, including OF Gabriel Rincones (No. 10), OF Carlos De La Cruz (No. 16), RHP Christian McGowan (No. 17), C Caleb Ricketts (No. 20) and RHP Tommy McCollum (No. 29). There are six Reading players on MLB.com's top-30 Phillies prospects list, including Rincones (No. 10), De La Cruz (No. 13), McGowan (No. 16), Ricketts (No. 21), INF Robert Moore (No. 26), INF Jose Rodriguez (No. 28).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Matt Frisbee** makes his eighth appearance and his seventh start of the season. He last pitched last Sunday in the finale of Richmond's series at Erie and allowed one run over four innings with five strikeouts. He is currently ranked third in Flying Squirrels history in career strikeouts (256) and third (min. 150 IP) in K/9 (8.76). On May 13, 2021, Frisbee threw six perfect innings in a combined no-hitter with Joey Marciano, Matt Seelinger and Patrick Ruotolo, the first nine-inning no hitter in Flying Squirrels franchise history and the second overall no-hitter in team history. On August 10, 2022 at Portland, Frisbee set a single-game franchise record with 13 strikeouts and allowed one hit, a fourth-inning single by rehabbing Red Sox outfielder Kiké Hernández, over six scoreless innings. Last year, Frisbee spent most of the season with Richmond, going 6-0 with a 4.54 ERA in 27 appearances, his first season working primarily as a reliever. Frisbee was selected by the Giants in the 15th round of the 2018 MLB Draft out of UNC Greensboro. *For more on Frisbee, see page two.*

FOR READING: Right-hander Konnor Ash makes his fourth start and his 10th appearance of the season. It is also his first pitching appearance against the Flying Squirrels in his career. Ash last pitched on May 11 against Hartford and threw three scoreless innings. Ash signed with the Phillies as a non-drafted free agent out of the University of Missouri in 2021. He reached Reading for the first time last year, pitching one game.

PACKING THE HOUSE: The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans last month for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history, pending today's attendance. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and are ranked second among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance, trailing only Dayton (7,970).

RIGHT AGAINST READING: The Flying Squirrels have gone 13-1 against the Fightin Phils over the last two seasons. They have won the first five games of this week's series. Last year, they swept a three-game series at The Diamond to open the season from April 8-9. From June 28-July 3, Richmond won five-of-six in Reading. In the last 14 head-to-head games, the Flying Squirrels have outscored the Fightin Phils, 78-31.

HATS FOR BATS, KEEP BATS WARM: Over the last five games, the Flying Squirrels are hitting a league-best .289 (44-for-152) and have scored 28 runs, an average of 5.6 runs per game, which is also first in the Eastern League. Over the previous 13 games from April 28-May 12, the Richmond offense hit a league-worst .171 (69-for-407) and averaged 1.7 runs per game (22 runs/13 games). The Flying Squirrels broke the slump with a four-run eighth inning in a 6-4 win on Wednesday night. They outscored the Fightin Phils, 12-2, in Thursday night's doubleheader sweep.

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTY: There are four relievers on the active Richmond roster who hold a sub-2.00 ERA so far this season. Among Eastern League relievers (min. 15 IP), four Richmond pitchers rank in the top-12 in ERA, including **Evan Gates** (3rd - 0.86 ERA - 2 ER/21.0 IP), **Tanner Kiest** (10th - 1.59 ERA - 3 ER/17.0 IP), **Nick Garcia** (11th - 1.65 ERA - 3 ER/16.1 IP) and **Wil Jensen** (12th - 1.78 ERA - 5 ER/25.1 IP). Jensen also leads the league in relief innings pitched (25.1).

GLow SHOW: In his last eight games dating back to May 1, **Jimmy Glowne** is batting .286 (8-for-28) with three doubles, two walks and four runs scored. In those eight games, he has three two-hit games, including Wednesday night against the Fightin Phils and Game 1 of Thursday's doubleheader. This year, he has picked up two-or-more hits in five-of-18 games played, including a four-hit game on April 6 at Somerset. This month, Glowne has raised his batting average from .225 to .250.

SETTING THE TABLE: **Carter Howell** is batting .310 (13-for-42) over his last 12 games since May 3 with three doubles, a homer, six RBIs, seven walks and four runs scored. On Thursday night in the second game of a doubleheader against the Fightin Phils, he hit a go-ahead, two-run homer in the fifth inning in a 3-1 win. In his seven games batting first in the lineup, Howell is batting .308 (8-for-26) with two doubles and three walks. When leading off an inning, Howell is batting a team-best .346 (9-for-26).

MOVIN' UP: On Tuesday, **Reggie Crawford** and **Hunter Bishop** were promoted to Triple-A Sacramento. In his nine outings with Richmond, Crawford struck out 19 batters over 9.2 innings of work and posted a 4.66 ERA. Bishop played 26 games for the Flying Squirrels. He ranked second on the team in batting average (.242), tied for second in homers (2), second in OBP (.314), second in SLG (.358), second in OPS (.672), tied for second in doubles (5). He also led the team in total bases (34) and stolen bases (5) and ranked tied for first in hits (23).

PROSPECT WATCH: Seven of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the roster, including **Hayden Birdsong** (No. 6), **Grant McCray** (No. 10), **Vaun Brown** (No. 11), **Eric Silva** (No. 22), **Adrián Sugastey** (No. 25), **Ryan Murphy** (No. 28) and **José Cruz** (No. 30). In Baseball America's Best Tool in the Giants Organization list, **John Michael Bertrand** is rated as having the best control, Sugastey is rated as the best defensive catcher and McCray is rated as the best defensive outfielder and best outfield arm. Six players landed on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list, including Birdsong (No. 6), McCray (No. 13), Brown (No. 15), **Victor Bericoto** (No. 20), Sugastey (No. 24) and OF **Jairo Pomares** (No. 26).
