**SHELL SYNOPSIS...** In the opener of the FSL Championship Series, Lakeland took the lead on an RBI double from Nick Dumesnil in the third. Two innings later, the Flying Tigers stretched the lead to 4-0 on a two-out, two-run triple from Jesus Pinto and RBI single from Chris Meyers. Daytona had no baserunners in the first five innings, then after putting two on in the sixth, scored a run on an Alfredo Alcantara RBI single. The Tortugas, though, did nothing else offensively, while Lakeland added another two-out, two-run triple from Samuel Gil in the eighth. The Flying Tigers cruised the rest of the way, shutting down Daytona on just one hit in a 6-1 defeat.

**OFFENSIVE OUTAGE...** In game one, the Tortugas had their quietest night at the plate all season, recording just one hit (an Ichiro Cano single in the sixth) and only one more baserunner, on a hit batter. The one hit equals the season low for Daytona (also July 23 at St. Lucie) while the two baserunners are the fewest for Daytona since the Tortugas only scratched out two runners (both singles) in a 6-0 loss vs. Lakeland on June 28, 2017. In the postseason, the Tortugas are slashing .164/.262/.197 with 12 runs scored and just two extra-base hits.

**CHECKERED FLAG AT THE JACK...** Sunday marked the final possible home game for the Tortugas, as the series and season will conclude at Lakeland's Joker Marchant Stadium. Including the postseason, Daytona played 68 games at The Jack this year, going 39-29 (0-2 in the postseason), while drawing 112,107 fans (2,2501 postseason). The record is Daytona's best at home since 2016 and the attendance is the Tortugas' highest since 2019. Both marks this season were second-best in the Florida State League.

**BACK AGAINST THE WALL...** Daytona plays for their season tonight facing elimination. The Tortugas are looking to accomplish what they did to reach the FSL Championship Series, win a pair of elimination games on the road. In Tortugas history, Daytona has done well with their season on the line in the postseason, with a 6-3 record all-time in elimination games, including a pair of series wins (2015 vs. Clearwater and 2025 vs. St. Lucie) in which they won a best-of-three series after dropping game one.

**ALFREDO LEADS ALL-STARS...** Earlier today, the Florida State League postseason All-Star team was unveiled, with the Tortugas having three representatives. Infielders Carlos Sanchez (promoted to Dayton June 24) and Sammy Stafura (traded to Pittsburgh July 30) were selected, while Tortugas catcher Alfredo Duno was named to the team, but also named FSL MVP. Duno led the FSL in home runs (18), RBI (81), runs (78), OBP (.430), slugging (.518), OPS (.948), doubles (32), extra-base hits (52), walks (95), total bases (202) and was second in batting average (.287) and hits (112). Duno joins Aristedes Aquino in 2016 as the only Tortugas to be named FSL MVP. His award also comes one year after RHP Nestor Lorant was named FSL Pitcher of the year.

**LAKELAND LOOKING FOR TITLE...** After finishing runner-up last season to Palm Beach, the Lakeland Flying Tigers are one win from their first Florida State League title since 2012 and fifth all-time. Lakeland (as both the Tigers and Flying Tigers) won titles in 1976, '77, '92, and '12. Unrelated Lakeland teams also took FSL championships in 1924 (Highlanders) and 1954 (Pilots). This series is the first-ever postseason matchup between teams from Daytona and Lakeland, despite those two cities both fielding FSL teams in 62 separate seasons.

**SUB-.500 TO CELEBRATING...** The Daytona Tortugas will look to accomplish a rare feat, as they will attempt to become Florida State League champions despite posting a losing record (65-66) during the regular season. They are the first sub-.500 club to reach the FSL Championship since Fort Myers took the crown with a 68-69 record, ironically at the expense of Daytona in the Tortugas' most recent finals appearance before this season. In Florida State League history, only four postseason champions have finished with a losing record: the 2018 Fort Myers Miracle (68-69), 2005 Palm Beach Cardinals (68-71), 1941 Leesburg Anglers (63-66), and 1936 St. Augustine Saints (58-60).

**POSTSEASON ON THE BEACH...** Daytona is making their fourth postseason appearance in the Tortugas era, having previously reached the playoffs in 2015, '18, and '24, with this season joining '15 and '18 as the three FSL Championship Series appearances for the squad. All-time, the Tortugas are 8-10 in the postseason (3-3 in series) and are playing for their first title as the Tortugas, their first overall since the 2013 Daytona Cubs, and the tenth all-time in Daytona Beach, would would break a tie with St. Petersburg and Tampa for most FSL titles for one city.

**SEASON SYNOPSIS...** Daytona finished just below .500 at 65-66, but the Tortugas still entered the playoffs with an 18-7 record since August 9, best in the Florida State League. The Tortugas reached the playoffs as the second-best second-half team in the East Division (after St. Lucie won both halves), going 36-29 in the second half, the best half for Daytona since 2018. That was a turnaround from a 29-37 first-half mark and a last-place finish, the worst first half in Tortugas history.

**RECORDS SET...** The Tortugas have enjoyed a banner season at the plate with multiple club records falling. This season, Daytona shattered franchise records for runs (705), runs per game (5.38), doubles (222), RBI (609), walks (635), stolen bases (223), hit batters (118), sacrifice bunts (44), sacrifice flies (54), on-base percentage (.356) and OPS (.732). Individually, Alfredo Duno set Tortugas records for RBIs (81), walks (95), on-base percentage (.430), and OPS (.948), while Kyle Henley set the Tortugas mark for stolen bases (57).

**TOP TURTLES...** A total of 14 Tortugas are ranked among the top prospects in the Cincinnati Reds organization and across Minor League Baseball. Here is how they currently stack up according to several key services:

Daytona currently boasts 11 of Cincinnati's Top 30 prospects by MLB Pipeline, 7 of Baseball America's Top 30 prospects, 4 of Reds Minor Leagues' Top 25 prospects, 7 of The Athletic's Top 20 prospects, and 12 of FanGraphs' Top 45. Alfredo Duno debuted on Baseball America and MLB Pipeline's Top 100 prospect lists midseason. Tyson Lewis joined Duno on MLB Pipeline's Top-100 list at the end of July.
