**ABOUT LAST NIGHT...** The Vancouver Canadians were victimized by a lethal combo of lights-out pitching and an offensive onslaught from the Everett AquaSox (Mariners), as the C's fell 9-1 Saturday night at Ron Tonkin Field.

Everett got the scoring started in the first with a couple of runs on two hits and two walks before blowing the game open in the second. In that inning, the 'Sox sent 10 men to the plate, scored five runs on six hits and bounced starter Adam Kloffenstein (L, 1-2) from the game. Six hits in one inning matches a single stanza high this season for the C's pitching staff.

Vancouver scored their lone run in the bottom of the second when Spencer Horwitz deposited a 2-0 pitch beyond the right field wall for his first home run of the season, but that was the only mistake left-hander Brandon Williamson all night. MLB.com's #10 Mariners prospect was nearly unhittable for 7.1 innings in which he gave up two hits, walked one and struck out a career-high 13 batters. All told, the C's were K'd a season-high 15 times

The AquaSox scored single runs in the third and fourth to go up 9-1 but didn't record a hit from the fifth frame forward as Cobi Johnson and Parker Caracci combined on four innings of shutout relief work.

Tanner Morris collected the other two of Vancouver's three hits on the night, a first inning single and a broken bat base hit in the ninth.

**FEELING SOXY:** The Everett AquaSox (Mariners) hop into town this week for the first of 6 series between these two clubs, for a total of 36 head-to-head matchups. Everett will be a tall task for the C's; entering today, the Sox lead or are among leaders in all of Advanced-A in AVG (.249, T-3<sup>rd</sup>), R (150, 1<sup>st</sup>), H (194, T-1<sup>st</sup>), TB (335, 2<sup>nd</sup>), 2B (55, 1<sup>st</sup>), 3B (7, T-2<sup>nd</sup>), HR (24, T-5<sup>th</sup>), RBI (133, 1<sup>st</sup>), BB (128, 2<sup>nd</sup>), OBP (.362, 1<sup>st</sup>), SLG (.431, 3<sup>rd</sup>) & OPS (.792, 2<sup>nd</sup>).

**HOME AWAY FROM HOME:** Due to pandemic-related border closures, Ron Tonkin Field in Hillsboro will serve as Vancouver's home ballpark this year. 78 of 120 C's game will take place in the Tualatin Valley over the course of the season (60 home games, 18 as the visitors).

**SPLIT CITY:** The C's need a win today to earn a series split and avoid losing their first series of the season.

**UN-DAY-FEATED:** Vancouver is a perfect 3-0 under the sun this season.

**ON THE HILL:** Paxton Schultz climbs the hill for Vancouver as he looks to continue his dominant start to 2021. He wet a career-long six innings in his last turn on May 23 against Hillsboro, when he blanked the Hops on two hits, no walks and five strikeouts. The right-hander has been especially effective limiting opposes offenses; he enters today with 19 strikeouts in 14 innings pitched and an opponent's batting average of .204. Schultz, 23, is in the midst of his first season with Toronto. He was the Player To Be Named Later in the deal that sent Derek Fisher to Milwaukee after the Brewers originally drafted him in the 14<sup>th</sup> round out of Utah Valley. While a member of the Wolverines, Schultz tied a school record with 99 strikeouts his junior season and led the staff with 99.1 innings. In high school, Schultz was a standout two-way player at Orem High School in Orem, UT, where he went 11-1 with a 2.90 ERA and hit .426 with 11 doubles and 31 RBI his senior year as he led the team to a Region 7 Championship and second place in the State Championship game. The Salt Lake Tribune named him one of the Top 10 prep players in Utah.

Right-hander Juan Then (pronounced "ten") will toe the slab for Everett. His last outing on May 23 was the worst of his season; he allowed five runs (four earned) on four hits in 3.1 innings pitched. He's the #9 Mariners prospect according to MLB.com.
