YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Sea Dogs, 7-5. **Carter Aldrete** opened the scoring with an RBI single in the second inning. In the third, Portland tied the score, 1-1, with an RBI single by Phillip Sikes. The Sea Dogs moved ahead, 3-1, with an RBI double by Nathan Hickey and an RBI single by Corey Rosier. In the bottom of the fifth, **Ismael Munguia** hit an RBI single and **Vaun Brown** brought in two runs with a single to moved Richmond ahead, 4-3. Later in the inning, a double steal and an RBI single by **Brady Whalen** extended the lead to 6-3. The Sea Dogs closed the score to 6-5 with run-scoring singles by Chase Meidroth and Hickey in the seventh, but in the bottom of the inning, Brown stole home on a throw back to the pitcher to push Richmond's advantage to 7-5. **Parker Dunshee** threw two scoreless innings out of the bullpen to pick up his second win this year. **Tyler Myrick** closed out his first Double-A save with a scoreless ninth.

TODAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the third of a six-game series against the Portland Sea Dogs, Double-A affiliate of the Boston Red Sox. This series is the first match-up between the two teams this season. The Flying Squirrels will travel to Portland for a six-game series from August 22-27. Last year, the two teams split a six-game series at The Diamond, with Richmond's series finale win clinching the Southwest Division First-Half title. The Sea Dogs won five-of-six against the Flying Squirrels at Hadlock Field last year.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 20-10 in their last 30 games since June 18. On the last road trip, they went 1-2 in a series at Harrisburg and split a six-game set in Akron. In their last 30 games, the Flying Squirrels are batting .243 (232-for-954), tying the best in the Eastern League, with 30 homers, 44 doubles and have score 150 runs. In that same span, the Richmond pitching staff has combined for a 3.43 ERA, fourth-best in the league, with 321 strikeouts. Over the last 35 games since June 14, Richmond starting pitchers have combined for a 3.12 ERA (45 ER/130.0 IP) and have allowed nine home runs. For the year, the Flying Squirrels' 3.77 ERA, second-best in the league. Richmond starters have thrown 331.1 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 458.2 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.38 ERA, which is the lowest in Double-A, just ahead of Akron (3.43), and the fourth-lowest of the 120 full-season teams in the minors.

THE SEA DOGS have the best overall record in the Eastern League this season and are leading the second-half standings in the Northeast Division. The Sea Dogs are 12-7 in their last 19 games since July 2, including taking four-of-six in last week's series against the Fisher Cats, closing it with a no-hitter on Sunday. Portland's roster includes six of Baseball America's top-30 Red Sox prospects, including SS Marcelo Mayer (No. 1), 2B Nick Yorke (No. 4), RHP Wikelman Gonzalez (No. 7), C Nathan Hickey (No. 10), 2B Chase Meidroth (No. 11) and 1B Blaze Jordan (No. 20). MLB.com's top-30 Red Sox prospects list includes Mayer (No. 1), Yorke (No. 3), Jordan (No. 10), Gonzalez (No. 11), INF Matthew Lugo (No. 13), Hickey (No. 15), Meidroth (No. 19), RHP Jacob Webb (No. 24) and OF Phillip Sikes (No. 30).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **Nick Zwack** makes his 11th start of the season. He last pitched on Friday at Akron and picked up a loss, allowing three runs over 4.2 innings with five strikeouts. Over his three outings in July, Zwack has gone 1-1 with a 4.61 ERA (7 ER/13.2) and has struck out 19 batters with one walk. Two outings ago on July 16, he struck out eight batters over a season-high five innings in a no-decision at Harrisburg. Zwack was selected in the 17th round of the 2021 MLB Draft by the Mets out of Xavier and traded to the Giants last August as part of the deal for Darin Ruf. After starting the 2022 season with Low-A St. Lucie, Zwack earned a promotion to High-A Brooklyn, where he went 5-1 with a 1.84 ERA in 14 outings, landing him a South Atlantic League Post-Season All-Star selection. He closed the season with six starts for High-A Eugene following the trade. Zwack, a native of Minneapolis, played his college career at Xavier, where he was a First-Team All-Big East selection in 2021 as a senior. **For more on Zwack, see page two.**

FOR PORTLAND: Right-hander Hunter Dobbins makes his fourth Double-A start and fifth appearance. Last time out, he allowed two runs in five innings against the Fisher Cats on Friday, striking out eight, working out of the bullpen behind MLB rehab pitcher Corey Kluber. He has struck out 18 batters over 10.2 innings in his last two outings. Dobbins was selected in the eighth round of the 2021 MLB Draft by the Red Sox out of Texas Tech. He made his professional debut last year with Low-A Salem, going 0-5 with a 5.22 ERA in 17 starts. Dobbins began this season with High-A Greenville and went 4-1 with a 2.63 ERA in seven starts before being promoted to Double-A on June 23.

PACKING THE HOUSE: The Flying Squirrels are leading the Double-A level in total attendance (287,911) and average attendance (6,398) this year. They are also 13th in the minors in average attendance. Last year, Richmond led all 30 Double-A teams in total attendance (406,560) and average attendance (6,160) for the first time in franchise history.

FULL MUNGUIA: In his five games since returning from the IL, **Ismael Munguia** is batting .381 (8-for-21) with two doubles, a walk and four RBIs, adding a .409 on-base percentage. He picked up four hits in his three games of last week's series at Akron and has four hits in the first two games of this week's series. Munguia was placed on the injured list on May 20 and reinstated on July 20, missing 49 games.

GLDW SHOW: Over his last 11 games since July 6, **Jimmy Glownke** is batting .333 (12-for-36) with two homers, three doubles, 10 RBIs and five walks. In last week's series in Akron, he hit .450 (9-for-20) with two homers, three doubles and 10 RBIs. Last Tuesday, he closed the game a triple shy of the cycle and went 3-for-6 with a three-run homer, a two-run double and an RBI single, picking up a career-high six RBIs. On Friday, he drove in two runs, going 1-for-3 with a double. On Saturday night, Glownke clubbed a two-run homer in the top of the 11th in a 6-5 win. He worked a walk in this week's series-opener on Tuesday.

ALL ABOARD THE SHANE TRAIN: **Shane Matheny** has picked up three hits in this week's series against the Sea Dogs, including a pair of RBI doubles on Tuesday and added a walk and two singles on Wednesday. For his Flying Squirrels career, Matheny has worked 110 walks, moving ahead of **Jarrett Parker** (2013-14) for third-most in franchise history. He trails **Ricky Oropesa** (2013-16) with 112 and **Jacob Heyward** (2019, '21-22) with 158. His .354 career on-base percentage is third-highest in Flying Squirrels franchise history (min. 700 PA). On Tuesday to open the series, Matheny went 2-for-4 with a pair of RBI singles.

RETURN OF THE MECK: **Wade Meckler** has picked up multiple hits 10 times in his 34 Double-A games. He went on a 24-game on-base streak from May 17-July 6, which was the longest on-base streak to begin a Double-A career in Flying Squirrels history, passing the previous record set by **Luis Matos** (17 games) earlier this season. It was also tied for the ninth-longest on-base streak in franchise history. Meckler also had an 11-game run scored streak from June 23-July 6, which was a Flying Squirrels franchise record, passing the previous mark of nine straight games by Tyler LaTorre in 2014. In Game 1 of a doubleheader on June 23, Meckler tied the single-game franchise record for hits, going 5-for-5 and capping the night with a two-run, walk-off single for a 9-8 win over the Senators. For the season, Meckler leads all MiLB hitters (min. 220 PA) in batting average (.381), ranks eighth in OBP (.452) and is ninth in wRC+ (165). He ranks second in the Eastern League (min. 150 PA) in batting average (.338), fourth in OBP (.429) and is third in BABIP (.398) while posting the eighth-lowest strikeout percentage (14.9) and the second-lowest swing-and-miss percentage (5.6).

MARTY PARTY: **Brandon Martorano** has reached base 12 times in his last seven games with an at-bat since July 14. He reached base five times on July 14 at Harrisburg, picking up three hits with a walk and was hit by a pitch. In his last 12 games since July 3, Martorano is batting .242 (8-or-33) with seven walks, two RBIs and four runs scored. Martorano missed 39 games on the injured list from April 21-June 8.

TAKE A WALK: **Hayden Cantrelle** has walked 57 times this season, which is tied for the most in the Giants organization and is the fifth-most in the Eastern League. His 18.3% walk rate is tied for the second-highest in the league this season. He also has the fifth-best on-base percentage (.394) in the league this year. His 57 walks this season are tied for the eighth-most in a single year in Flying Squirrels franchise history, even with **Javier Herrera** (57 - 2013). He is one walk away from tying **Skyler Stromsmore** (2014), **Shane Matheny** (2022) and **Joe Panik** (2013) for the fourth-most walks in a season. The single-season record of 80 was set by **Jacob Heyward** in 2019. Cantrelle is on pace for 86 walks this season.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have eight players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including LHP **Carson Whisenhunt** (No. 6), OF **Vaun Brown** (No. 8), RHP **Mason Black** (No. 9), RHP **Carson Seymour** (No. 14), RHP **Landen Roupp** (No. 15), OF **Wade Meckler** (No. 16), RHP **Ryan Murphy** (No. 27) and RHP **José Cruz** (No. 30). Brown is rated by Baseball America as the best hitter for average and the best athlete, Meckler as having the best strike-zone discipline, Roupp as having the best curveball and Cruz as having the best change-up. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospect list includes eight Richmond players, including Whisenhunt (No. 4), Brown (No. 6), Black (No. 9), Roupp (No. 12), Seymour (No. 16), Murphy (No. 25), Cruz (No. 28) and Meckler (No. 29).

THIS DATE IN SQUIRRELS HISTORY

In 2018, the Flying Squirrels beat the Reading Fightin Phils, 2-1, at The Diamond. Conner Menez started and threw 5.2 scoreless innings, striking out 10 batters. John Polonius gave Richmond a 1-0 lead with an RBI double in the second inning. Reading tied the game, 1-1, with an RBI single by Deivy Gruillon in the top of the ninth inning. In the bottom of the ninth, Polonius was hit by a pitch with the bases loaded to bring home the walk-off winning run.

IN OTHER WORDS...

Manager **Dennis Pelfrey** on **Vaun Brown**:

"He's one of the most dynamic players we have in our organization and probably in most others. He does a lot of things really well. I think the most important thing he does for us is what he brings to the table with his mind; how he prepares for the game, how he prepares each day and what he does on the field. Like stealing home yesterday on the throw-back. He mentioned to me that the catcher was a little light on the throw back to the mound. I'm all about being aggressive with a one-run lead. I told him just make sure it was a right-handed hitter in there. Before I could even turn around, he was gone. He brings things like that to the table. He is so focused on the little details of the game."
