Round Rock and Albuquerque face off in game two of the series at Isotopes Park on Wednesday. Express RHP Robert Dugger is scheduled for the start up against Isotopes LHP Ty Blach. First pitch is set for 7:35 p.m. CT.

### TOUGH WAY TO START

Round Rock dropped the series opener against Albuquerque on Tuesday by a final score of 13-4. C Sam Huff and SS Davis Wendzel drove home the first two runs of the game as Huff singled to score Texas Rangers rehabber DH Mitch Garver in the first inning and Wendzel hit a solo homer in the second. Following a solo home run in the bottom of the second inning from Albuquerque CF Trevor Boone, the Isotopes tied the game in the third with a run-scoring single from RF Yonathan Daza. Albuquerque broke things open with a four-spot in the fourth inning to extend the lead to 6-2. In the sixth, Wendzel scored Huff with a single and cut the lead to 6-3. Boone answered in the home half on a solo home run for Albuquerque. Round Rock scored their last run of the night in the seventh as Garver scored on a Justin Foscoe single to make it 7-4. The Isotopes called game in the bottom of the seventh as they played six runs on seven hits and one walk for the 13-4 score.

### IT'S DUGGER TIME

Express RHP Robert Dugger is slated for Wednesday's game two start on the mound. The righty has made eight starts this season and thrown to a 1-3 record and 4.15 ERA (16 ER/34.2 IP). Dugger has walked 21 batters and struck out 34 to start the 2023 season.

### ABOUT THOSE REHABBERS

Texas Rangers rehabbers DH Mitch Garver and CF Travis Jankowski saw their first action for Round Rock on Tuesday. Garver, a native of Albuquerque, went 2-for-4 with two doubles and two runs scored. Jankowski finished the night 0-for-3 with two strikeouts.

### BIG BIRTHDAY OUTING

Round Rock SS Davis Wendzel played in a game on his birthday for the first time in his professional career on Tuesday. The now-26-year-old went 2-for-3 with two RBI, a run scored and a walk. The last time he played on his birthday came on May 23, 2019 while playing for Baylor in the Big 12 Tournament. Then, he went 1-for-3 with a strikeout as the Bears fell to Oklahoma State, 5-0.

### WRONG KIND OF RECORDS

The Express pitching staff combined to allow a season-high 13 runs, all of which were earned, during Tuesday's loss. The Isotopes also tallied 16 hits throughout the contest, which matches the most allowed by Round Rock in a single game this season.

### E-TRAIN DEBUT ALERT

Tuesday saw RHP Tyler Zombro deliver a scoreless outing in his Express debut. Zombro tossed 1.2 innings and did not allow a hit while walking one and collecting a strikeout. He was one of three relief pitchers that shut out the Isotopes during the loss. The righty signed with the Rangers to a minor league contract on May 21 and was assigned to Round Rock. Zombro last pitched in a game on April 26, 2022 with Triple-A Durham.

### SEVENTH-INNING WOES

The seventh inning has not been kind to Express pitchers this season as opponents have scored 44 runs, 35 of which have been earned, recorded 56 hits and drawn 28 walks. Round Rock's pitching staff has a 7.16 ERA (35 ER/44.0 IP) during the seventh inning as opponents are hitting .311 (56-180). Round Rock is 0-20 this season when trailing after the seventh inning.

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2023 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's Pacific Coast League debut. Davis spent the previous two years as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.



In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.
