is third-best in MiLB, while Lugo's $23.8 \%$ mark is good for ninth

THE TONG SONG: RHP Jonah Tong joined Brooklyn's roster from Single-A St. Lucie last Monday and punched out seven batters against Aberdeen in his High-A debut last thursday...In six appearances (four starts) between St. Lucie and Brooklyn, the 20-year old is $1-0$ with a 0.00 ERA ( 0 ER in 23.2 IP )...No pitcher in Minor League Baseball has thrown more innings this year without allowing an earned run...Entering play on Wednesday, the Markham, Ont. native is second among qualifiers in Minor League Baseball in strikeout strikeout-to-walk rate is also second in MiLB to Wilkinson (41.4\%)...Tong'.... 43 strikeouts are tied for fifth-most in the minors.
