LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn matched a season-best with its fourth-straight victory, a 6-2 romp over Rome on Tuesday night...IB Nick Lorusso registered a 2-for-5 night, scoring a pair of runs and adding a double and an RBI single to start the scoring in the third...DH Nolan McLean also had multiple knocks, going 2-for-4...The 22-year-old singled and provided a three-run double to cap Brooklyn's scoring in the fifth...CF Nick Morabito went 1-for-5 with a run scored and a stolen base, while C Chris Suero went O-for-3 with a walk in their Cyclone debuts...LHP Felipe De La Cruz earned his first win of the season, striking out a season-best eight over a year-high five shutout innings... RHP Jake Stevenson tossed a scoreless sixth – striking out two – in his Mets' organizational and Brooklyn debut...2B E.J. Exposito broke up the shutout for Rome with two out in the ninth on a two-run home run to left-center.

FOURTH MEAL: The Cyclones enter Wednesday's contest riding a season-high-tying four-game winning streak...This dates back to Friday's 2-0 victory vs. Aberdeen...During the stretch, the 'Clones have outscored opponents, 17-4...Brooklyn previously won four straight from April 20-24 at Jersey Shore and vs. Wilmington...The Cyclones have not won five consecutive contests since July 3-7, 2023, vs. Jersey Shore and at Wilmington.

WALK THIS WAY: IF/OF Ryan Clifford and INF William Lugo have been accumulating walks in droves so far in 2024...Clifford's 29 walks are not only the most in the South Atlantic League but they are tied for the most in Minor League Baseball...Additionally, Lugo's 24 free passes are tied for second-most in the league...Clifford's 25.9% walk rate is third-best in MILB, while Lugo's 23.8% mark is good for ninth.

WELCOME TO BROOKLYN: OF Nick Morabito picked up a single, a stolen base, and a run scored in his High-A and Cyclones debut on Tuesday night...Entering play on Wednesday, the now 21-year-old is fourth in Minor League Baseball in on-base percentage (.514) and fifth in batting average (.386)...At the time of his promotion from Single-A St. Lucie, Morabito led the Florida State League in hitting (.397), on-base percentage (.530), and OPS (1043)...He was also third in slugging (.513), hits (31), and stolen bases (11), tied for sixth in walks (18), and seventh in total bases (40)...O Chris Suero, who also joined the team from St. Lucie, walked in his debut...The 20-year-old was tied for the FSL lead in runs scored (18) by the time of his departure and seventh in OPS (.824), tied for seventh in RBI (15), eighth in on-base percentage (.390), and 10th in slugging (.434).

YIPPEE KI-YAY: TWP Nolan McLean continued his incredible start to his Cyclones career on Tuesday...At the plate, the 22-year-old went 2-for-4 with a single, a double, and a career-high-tying three RBI...On the mound, McLean extended his scoreless inning streak to 13.0 straight by tossing five spotless frames last Saturday vs. Aberdeen, en route to his second victory...Over his last three starts, McLean is 2-0 with a 0.00 ERA (0 ER in 13.0 IP), allowing just six hits and three walks (6.82 BB%), adding 16 strikeouts (36.36 K%)...In addition to his success on the mound, McLean enters play on Wednesday with nine extra-base hits...The Willow Springs, NC. native has registered 30 fewer plate appearances (48) than any other player with 9+ extra-base knocks in the South Atlantic League and 15 fewer plate appearances with that total across the minor leagues.

NICK THE STICK: INF Nick Lorusso has quietly been one of the top hitters in the South Atlantic League in 2024...The Connecticut native picked up two more hits on Tuesday night, adding a double and an RBL.Coming into Wednesday's matchup, the 23-year-old is tied for second in the South Atlantic League in triples (2), tied for third in doubles (7), fifth in OPS (.908), tied for fifth in extra-base hits (11), sixth in slugging (.526), and eighth in batting average (.303).

COUNTDOWN TO 1K: After Tuesday's 6-2 win over Rome, the Brooklyn Cyclones are now two wins shy of their 1,000th in franchise history...Brooklyn holds a record of 998-840 (.543) in 1,838 games since 2001...The victory also marked the franchise's 200th since joining the South Atlantic League in 2021...The Cyclones are 200-209 (.489) in 409 games...Brooklyn captured its 900th franchise victory with a 6-5 triumph over Wilmington on August 14, 2022...Brooklyn's very first win came in a 3-2 victory on June 19, 2001, at Jamestown.

THE TONG SONG: RHP Jonah Tong joined Brooklyn's roster from Single-A St. Lucie last Monday and punched out seven batters against Aberdeen in his High-A debut last Thursday...In six appearances (four starts) between St. Lucie and Brooklyn, the 20-year-old is 1-0 with a 0.00 ERA (0 ER in 23.2 IP)...No pitcher in Minor League Baseball has thrown more innings this year without allowing an earned run...Entering play on Wednesday, the Markham, Ont. native is second among qualifiers in Minor League Baseball in strikeout rate (48.9%)...Single-A Lynchburg's LHP Mart Wilkinson (49.5%) is first...Tong's 39.8% strikeout-to-walk rate is also second in MiLB to Wilkinson (41.4%)...Tong's 43 strikeouts are tied for fifth-most in the minors.

GOING BACK TO BACK: The Cyclones shut out the IronBirds for the second-straight day with a 4-0 win on Saturday...RHP Nolan McLean (5.0 IP), RHP Victor Castañeda (2.0), and RHP Ben Simon (2.0) combined on a five-hitter...On Friday, RHP Brandon Sproat (5.0), RHP Jeffrey Colón (2.2), and RHP Joey Lancellotti (11) united to one-hit Aberdeen, 2-0...The back-to-back shutouts are the first for the Cyclones at the full-season level and the first since Brooklyn blanked the Connecticut Tigers on the road in both ends of a doubleheader on August 23, 2019...RHP Michel Otañez (4.1), RHP Mitch Ragan (1.2), and RHP Josh Hejka (1.0) united on a 4-0 win in Game 1, while RHP Dan Goggin (2.0), RHP Hunter Parsons (2.0), and RHP Jared Biddy (3.0) led the charge to a 5-0 victory in Game 2...It is also the first for Brooklyn in consecutive nine-inning games since August 21-22, 2014, vs. Staten Island and Tri-Otx, RHP Daisuke Matsuzaka (5.0), LHP Brad Wieck (2.0), LHP Kelly Secrest (1.0), and LHP Shane Bay (1.0) twirled the Clones to a 2-0 win over Staten Island in the first leg...RHP Martires Arias (5.0), RHP Gaither Bungardner (2.0), and RHP Cameron Griffin (2.0) provided the zeroes in a 7-0 rout of Tri-Oity on the back end...Saturday's blanking marked the fifth of the season for Brooklyn's pitching staff...The five shutouts are the most in the South Atlantic League and tied for the second-most in all of Minor League Baseball...

vs. ROME: Brooklyn opens its only two-week road trip of the season against the Braves' High-A affiliate...The Emperors possess seven of Atlanta's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: RHP Spencer Schwellenbach (3), RHP Owen Murphy (5), RHP Drue Hackenberg (10), RHP Jhancarlos Lara (13), INF Sabin Ceballos (18), INF Ambioris Tavarez (21), and RHP Lucas Braun (24)...This marks the first ever meeting between the Rome and Brooklyn franchises since the Cyclones entered the South Atlantic League in 2021...Rome will visit Coney Island from July 23-28.

clones set a franchise record with 11 shutouts in 2023

SWIPING THE TOP SPOT: With a pair of stolen bases off the bench on Thursday afternoon, OF Omar De Los Santos (54) became the Cyclones' all-time stolen base king, breaking a tie with UT Jaylen Palmer (50)...In 2023, the 24-year-old eclipsed INF Walter Rasquin's (32) single-season stolen base record with 37 swipes...De Los Santos enters Wednesday's contest 17-for-18 stealing bases to start the season...The 17 swipes are second in the South Atlantic League and tied for sixth throughout the minors...Since the start of 2022, De Los Santos is sixth across the Minors in steals (124).

ATOP THE HEJ-ES: RHP **Josh Hejka** earned his first save of the season on Sunday afternoon vs. Aberdeen, making his Cyclones' franchise-record-setting 48th pitching appearance in the process...The 27-year-old broke a tie with **Hunter Parsons** (47) for the most pitching appearances in Cyclones franchise history...In his 48 career outings for Brooklyn since 2019, Hejka has accumulated a 5-1 record with a 2.70 ERA (23 ER in 76.2 IP) and 4 saves, walking just 18 and striking out 69.

FEAR THE HAWK: RHP Dakota Hawkins continued his stellar start to his 2024 season last Thursday with four innings of shutout relief...Since one out in the bottom of the eighth on April 19 at Jersey Shore, the 24-year-old has not allowed a run...The 8.2-consecutive scoreless frames is the longest spotless stretch by a Brooklyn reliever this year...Among South Atlantic League relief arms, Hawkins is tied for third in strikeouts (23), fourth in strikeout-to-walk rate (11.50), and ninth in innings pitched (15.2).

LONG ARM OF THE LAW: RHP **Justin Lawson** has started his 2024 with a bang...The former member of the N.C. State Wolfpack is third in the circuit in saves (4)...Among South Atlantic League relievers with at least 14.0 innings pitched, the 23-year-old leads the circuit in ERA (0.63) and WHIP (0.70), in addition to being tied for the fewest hits allowed (5).

KING STANLEY: With his RBI double in the bottom of the first inning last Friday, OF Stanley Consuegra became the first player in Cyclones history to reach the century mark in RBI...The 23-year-old is Brooklyn's all-time leader in several categories, including 67 extra-base hits, 29 home runs, and 101 RBI...On the final day of the 2023 regular season, he broke a tie with O Francisco Alvarez for Brooklyn's single-season home run record (23)... Consuegra also surpassed Alvarez (22) for the franchise record in career home runs on August 23 at Asheville...The Dominican native also broke the franchise's single-season record for extra-base hits (42) and tied the mark for RBI (63) set by Ronny Mauricio in 2021.

SEVENTH HEAVEN: The Cyclones' offense exploded for seven runs in the bottom of the first in last Tuesday's 9-2 win vs. Aberdeen...They also accomplished the feat in the bottom of the third in a 13-3 win vs. Wilmington on April 24...Brooklyn had 10 consecutive batters reach base with one out in the inning...The seven-run frames are the largest for the Cyclones since they erupted for nine in the bottom of the second inning on July 27, 2023, vs. Wilmington, in an 11-7 triumph...The 13 runs for Brooklyn set a new season high... The Cyclones had not tallied that many in a single contest since a 13-12 win at Asheville in 10 innings on August 24, 2023...It was the first time Brooklyn scored 13+ in a nine-inning game dating back to an 18-1 thrashing at Jersey Shore on August 28, 2022...Since 2005, the Cyclones' highwater mark for runs in a single inning is 10 in the top of the sixth of a 20-6 romp at Bowling Green on May 27, 2022...The 20 runs were also a franchise record.

YOUTH IS SERVED: Gilbert Gómez takes over as manager of the Brooklyn Cyclones in 2024...At 32 years of age, the Santo Domingo, D.R. native is the youngest skipper in franchise history...After leading Single-A St. Lucie last summer, Gómez served as manager of Tigres del Licey in the Dominican Winter League (LIDOM)...Became the youngest manager to win a championship in LIDOM history and the second-youngest manager to win a game in Caribbean Series history...Gómez's younger brother, Dariel, played at Double-A Binghamton in the Mets' organization last summer and is currently with the Charleston Dirty Birds of the MLB Partner Atlantic League...Older brother, José, is a scout for the Tampa Bay Rays and general manager for LIDOM's Leones del Escogido...Older brother, Héctor, is a well-known baseball reporter...Gómez also played seven years in New York's farm system, posting a .662 OPS in 537 games.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to Baseball America and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have five of the Top 30 per BA: Ryan Clifford (No. 6), Brandon Sproat (10), Nolan McLean (11), Jonah Tong (22), and Calvin Ziegler (29)...Plus six of the Top 30 per MLB: Clifford (4), Sproat (13), McLean (19), Ziegler (22), Wilfredo Lara (23), and OF Nick Morabito (26)...MLB Pipeline also considers Clifford the 87th-best farmhand in all of baseball.

LAST TIME OUT: Took a no-decision in his High-A and Cyclones debut last Thursday afternoon vs. Aberdeen...Allowed one unearned run on two hits over five innings...Walked a season-high-tying three and punched out seven...Hurled a wild pitch...Tossed 81 pitches and 56 strikes (69.14%)...Relieved by RHP **Dakota Hawkins** to start the top of the sixth with Brooklyn trailing, 1-O...Cyclones tied it at one in the seventh...IronBirds scored six runs in the top of the 10th and defeated Brooklyn, 7-1.

PROSPECT RADAR: Tong is considered the New York Mets' No. 22 prospect in 2024 according to *Baseball America*.

JONAH'S WHALE OF A START: Entering play on Wednesday, the Markham, Ont. native is second among all qualifiers in Minor League Baseball in strikeout rate (48.9%)...Single-A Lynchburg's LHP **Matt Wilkinson** (49.5%) is first...Tong's 39.8% strikeout-to-walk rate also rates as the second-best in MiLB...Wilkinson (41.4%) is first...He is one of three qualifiers who has not allowed an earned run, and none has thrown more innings than Tong this year...His 43 strikeouts are tied for fifth-most in the minors.

2023: After he did not pitch in 2022 after being drafted, Tong started the campaign and made his professional debut in the Florida Complex League...Registered an 0-1 record with a 6.39 ERA (9 ER in 12.2 IP), 13 walks, and 25 strikeouts in seven appearances (five starts)...Transferred to Single-A St. Lucie on August 22...Composed an 0-1 mark with a 5.40 ERA (5 ER in 8.1 IP), nine walks, and 13 strikeouts in three starts...Returned to the FCL Mets on September 7.

TRAVELING MAN: A native of Canada, Tong's journey to professional baseball has included a lot of travel...After attending Bill Crothers Secondary School in Unionville, Ont., Tong moved on Georgia Premier Academy in Statesboro, Ga. for his final high school season...Prior to the 2022 draft, Tong participated in the MLB Draft League as a member of the Frederick (Md.) Keys...Accumulated an 0-1 record with a 10.80 ERA (14 ER in 11.2 IP), 10 walks, and 14 K's in four outings (three starts)...Was a teammate of Aberdeen's RHP **Zachary Fruit** and former Cyclones and current Double-A Binghamton RHP **Jordan Geber**, whose rotation spot he is taking...He was also committed to North Dakota State University before signing his professional contract.
