Tonight's Game

The Clippers will send RHP **Pedro Avila** to the mound tonight, needing a win to lock up their second straight series victory (1-0-5 in last six, 3-1-5 overall). Toledo will counter with RHP **Sawyer Gipson-Long**. Columbus is 24-12 (.667) versus right handers this year. Gipson-Long has pitched against the Clippers twice in his career, going 1-0 with a 1.00ERA (9.0IP, 7H, 1R, 1ER, 3BB, 9K).

vs. the Mud Hens

Columbus has pulled ahead in the season series vs. Toledo (6-4) after going 10-11 opposing the Mud Hens last year (have not won a season series since going 11-10 in 2022). The Clippers have scored first in seven of 10 against Toledo this year (5-2), compared to 16 times (9-7) in their other 44G. Individually, **Bo Naylor** has hit .306 (19x62, 1HR and 10RBI) in 17G against Toledo in his career.

Crazy Eighthths

Columbus had an 8th inning scoring streak snapped at 7G on 5/12, but has scored in 14 of the last 18G (also scored in eight of 12 last 9ths). On the year, the Clippers have 92 runs from the 8th inning on (17 more than 2nd place), crafting a collective .987OPS (+132 points on 2nd). In the 8th alone, Columbus has 26 runs in the last 18G (more than 11 teams have all season, including Toledo).

Too High

Though **Cooper Ingle** has reached base five of his last 12 times, his OBP dipped to .486 (3rd best in pro baseball among players with at least 100PA). Since going deep in consecutive games at St. Paul on 5/16, Ingle is slashing .308/.429/.615 with 3HR and 13RBI in 10G, as he is already closing in on a personal best in homers (8; had 11HR in 2024). Last night he reached 200BB in his career (18% of PA).

Watch Out for Watson

Kahlil Watson is hitting .301/.383/.609 with 20XBH and 31RBI in his last 34G (1XBH in first 12G), including 7HR and 19RBI since 5/11 (1-3rd most HR in the IL during that span, 3rd in RBI). However, with RISP this year, he is hitting just .172 (10x58). Watson has not drawn a walk in his last 15G (67PA, 23K; 34%), his longest walkless stretch since 17G from 5/21-6/17/22 (career long, 76PA; hit .189, 14x74).

Weak Spot

Over the last 9G, in which Columbus is 6-3, the Clippers have a total of 6HR (292AB), the worst 9G stretch since collecting 5HR from 4/26-5/6 (307AB, went 5-4 in those games). Only one of those bombs has come from hitters 4-6 in the order (**George Valera** batting fifth on 5/19 vs. Louisville), with two of today's such batters (**Ralph Velazquez** and **Bo Naylor**) having yet to homer with Columbus.

Misleading Streak

Nolan Jones has reached base in 19 straight games, posting a .373OBP since 5/3, but has seen his OBP drop seven points over the course of the streak, while his average has dipped nine points (.257, 18x70). The streak is tied for 13th longest in the IL this season and ranks as the 6th longest active streak. Jones has not homered since the start of the month vs. Toledo (76AB; 3RBI in last 20G).

Hot Huff

Kody Huff rebounded from a pair of hitless games to end April with hits in each of his first 12G this month (.476, 20x42, 14RBI). The hit streak, from 5/1-5/16, set a new career best, topping his streak in the first 10G of April, 4/1-4/12 (.316, 12x38; hit .220, 11x50, in last 13G of April). Huff is 5x20 (.250) in 7G since the streak ended, but has 6RBI (39RBI in 44G; had career high 47RBI in 101G last season).

POW Hangover

Since being named the IL's Batter of the Week for 4/14-4/19 vs. Iowa (10x20, 4HR, 10RBI), **Milan Tolentino** is hitting .200/.290/.274 with 1HR and 14RBI in 27G. He's starting to snap out of it, with last Saturday's grand slam ending a HR drought (83AB) and hits in each of his last 4G (6x16). In the field he ran his errorless streak to 26G last night (tied with **Kahlil Watson** for longest among active Clippers).

Back on Track

In the last 16G, the Columbus bullpen has a 3.23ERA (61.1IP, 22ER), 4th best in the IL (3ER or fewer in all 16G, longest streak of the year). Clipper relievers allowed 21ER in 10.1IP of the 2G prior to the streak, as the relief ERA rose to 6.08 (worst in the IL, currently 17th at 5.32; starters have a 5.52ERA, 16th). Relievers allowed 1HR to 182BF from 5/10-5/22, but have given up 4HR to 90BF since.

This Date in Clipper History

5/30/1999

Clipper outfielder **Bubba Carpenter** played in his 500th game in a Columbus uniform, going 4x5 with an RBI and three runs scored in a 9-1 win vs. Scranton/WB. Carpenter was a Clipper from 1993-1999 and is the all-time leader in games played with the Clippers (574). He also tops the career lists in at bats (1848), total bases (768) and walks (276). He ranks 2nd in hits (476) and doubles (90).

Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,429 to 1,376).

Challenging Times

The Clippers are 77-73 (.513) in pitch reviews, with batters going 43-48 (.473) and pitchers/catchers going 34-25 (.576). They have run out of challenges in 30G and have not challenged in 3G. Last season, they were correct 43.1% of the time (2nd worst in the IL).

Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus is 1-3 in extra innings this season, after having gone 5-5 in 2025 and 9-9 in 2024 (most losses since 2013, 12). Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 51-36 when playing past regulation (.586, best in the IL; no other team above .570), including 26-17 at home (.605, but 4-7 in last 11G). Of the 87G to require extra play, 69 have been resolved after one frame (including eight DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 innings on 9/20/22 at Toledo). From 7/31/19-6/26/21, Columbus played 85 straight within the allotted innings.

On the Runs

Starting with the embiggened 150G schedule in 2022, the Clippers scored over 800 runs in three consecutive seasons from 2022-2024 (855, 808 and 805 runs, respectively; accounting for the 3rd, 4th and 5th best totals in team history). Following a steep decline last season (670, fewest scored in a full season since 2018), Columbus is looking to easily top 800 again, with an outside chance to establish a new team high (on pace for 858, would rank as 3rd most all-time; 898 scored in 1983).

On the Run

On the basepaths, the Clippers are making a run at the franchise mark in stolen bases, with 77 through the first 54G (on pace for 212SB). The team record was set in 2024 when Columbus swiped an even 200, but the team speed was throttled last year (129SB; still, the 2nd highest total since the Cleveland affiliation started in 2009). However, with 18CS so far, the Clippers are also pacing (50) for the 2nd most times caught stealing of the Cleveland affiliation (nabbed 51 times in 2004).

Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 78 grand slams and 1,932RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

Hits the Spot

When turning in as many or fewer hits than their opponents last season, the Clippers went 18-64 (.220), coming in 13th out of 20 in the IL. The 2024 season saw them post an IL-worst .185 (12-53) winning percentage in such games. When allowing at least 10 hits last year, Columbus was 7-41 (.146, 20th in the IL; started the season 1-20).

In Big Trouble

The Clipper pitching staff is trending toward the worst ERA in club history, sitting at 5.42 through the first 54G. Since the reorganization of the minor leagues in 2021, Columbus has twice finished the season with a 5+ ERA (current record is 5.32, set in 2023), after having done so just once in the first 43 seasons (5.08 in 1983). However, the staff is pacing to give up only 156HR (3rd lowest total since 133HR in 2018; averaging 182 per season since the Year of the Homer in 2019).

Department of Defense

The Columbus defense is sitting at 11th in the IL this year (.979), following a 2025 that saw a franchise record (.985, led the IL). On 4/10 at Worcester, the defense collapsed for the first 5E game since 8/27/24 (topped out at 3E in a game twice last year and had fewer than 5E in 21 of 26 series). The Clippers have played flawlessly in 29G this season (18-11, .621), after doing so in nearly 60% of games last year (44-42, .512), including 16 straight from 6/20-7/8/25 (longest streak in the IL over the last 20 years).

Key to Victory

From 2022-23, Columbus owned the best record in the IL when holding opponents to three runs or fewer, going 95-8 (.922, no other team was above .880). The Clippers were 43-10 in such games in 2024 (.811, 13th in the IL), accumulating four losses by 4/14, and were just 47-10 (.825, 9th) last year, collecting four losses over 14G from 4/23-5/9 (had four losses total in both 2022 and 2023).

Good Baseball

Kody Huff bunted a run in, while moving another to scoring position in a 5/24 win vs. Louisville. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 87-23 (.791) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 4-2 mark this season (.667, blew 7-run lead in one of the losses; went 23-2 in 2018).

To the End

The Clippers had the 6th most last at bat losses last season (17), after pacing the circuit with 23 in 2024 (tied with Toledo). They also suffered the 4th most walk-off losses (8), watching three in a row slip away at Rochester from 5/29-5/31. The 2024 season saw 41G decided in the last at bat (tied for 2nd most in the IL, one off lead), with Columbus going 18-23 in those contests (-17th, .439).

Manager Profile

Andy Tracy made his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's sixth year as a manager (first was with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 415-431 (.491), 385-385 with Columbus (.500).

Unfortunate Run:

Prior to 3GS from 4/19-5/1 (14.2IP, 16ER), Avila had only one stretch of consecutive games with at least 5ER in his previous 248G as a professional. That run came with El Paso in 2023, as he surrendered at least 5ER in each of 5G to end April (19.0IP, 27ER). In total, he has given up at least 5ER on 24 occasions, maxing out at 7ER with both Fort Wayne in 2017 and San Diego in 2023.

2026 Spring Training:

Avila pitched six times for Cleveland in spring training, turning in a 3.24ERA (8.1IP, 10H, 4R, 3ER, 1BB, 4K). He was released on 3/17, then signed a new minor league deal on 3/22 and assigned to minor league camp.
