#### BULLPEN SOLID BUT CARDS CAN'T OVERCOME EARLY HOLE: The

Arkansas Travelers scored 5 runs in the top of the first inning and never looked back as the Cardinals dropped their third straight game this week at Hammons Field with a 7-2 loss on Saturday night. Lars Nootbaar had two hits including a solo home run for Springfield, who had 9 hits but went just 2-for-10 with runners in scoring position. Benito Garcia helped save the Cardinals bullpen with 5.1 innings of scoreless relief following starter Alex Cornwell. Garcia, Andrew Marrero and Matt Svanson combined to allow just 2 R over 8.1 innings out of the bullpen.



**DPPOSING STARTER:** Right-hander **Juan Mercedes** makes his 15th start of the season for the Travs... Started the series opener for Arkansas at Hammons Field and did not factor in the decision, allowing 2ER on 4 H with 4 BB and 3 K over 4.1 IP...Allowed just 1 R over his first 3 starts of June buthas surrendered 9 R over 10.1 IP in his last two against the Wind Surge and Cardinals...Against Springfield this season is 2-0 with a 1.69 ERA and the Cards are batting just .190 against him...Made 12 appearances (10 starts) for Arkansas last season and went 2-1 with a 6.60 ERA...Began 2023 with High-A Everett making 4 starts... Had two IL stints last season...Pitched across 3 levels in 2022, appearing at every full-season affiliate besides Arkansas, and put together a 7-11 record with a 4.59 ERA over 26 appearances (22 starts)... Made his full season debut with Low-A Modesto in 2021 and went 7-4 with a 5.54 ERA in 34 relief appearances...Signed by the Mariners as an International Free Agent in 2017 out of the Dominican Republic...24 years old

**CARDS BEGIN 2ND HALF WITH FINAL REGULAR SEASON MATCHUP VS TRAVS:** After clinching a postseason berth on the final day of the first half, the Cardinals kick off the 2nd half with a six-game series against the Arkansas Travelers (Double-A, Seattle Mariners) at Hammons Field. The Cards and Travs will not meet again in the regular season. The two clubs met in the division series last season.



#### **CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD**

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to Southwest Missouri from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

#### CARDS' RADIO HOME

For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals! **FIRST HALF CHAMPS:** For the first time since 2016, the Springfield Cardinals clinched a postseason berth with a first half title. The race came down to the wire, with the Cards needing a win on the last day of the first half to clinch. Springfield trailed the Arkansas Travelers by 2.5 games with 5 to play and by 1.5 games with 2 to play, but the Travs lost their final two games of the first half to the Wichita Wind Surge and the Cards defeated Corpus Christi on back-to-back nights to clinch the title. The Cardinals will be playing in the postseason in backto-back seasons for just the 2nd time in franchise history (2009, 2010).

**NDDDDDDDDDT:** For the 2nd time during the 2024 season, Cardinals OF Lars Nootbaar is rehabbing in Springfield. He has been on the IL with St. Louis since May 31 with an oblique strain. Nootbaar appeared in one game for Springfield on April 9 rehabbing from fractured ribs, going 1-for-4 with an RBI and 2 runs scored before being activated by St. Louis on April 11. In 5 games with Memphis at the start of the season, he went 3-for-17 with a 2B. In 39 games in the big leagues this season, Nootbaar is batting .234 with 5 HR and 19 RBI to go along with 7 2B and a .741 OPS.

**LOOKING TO FLIP THE SCRIPT AT HOME:** The Cardinals got off to a good start at home this season with 8 straight wins, but have dropped 11 of their last 12 and 22 of their last 28 games at Hammons Field. Springfield's last consecutive wins at home came May 24-25 against the Tulsa Drillers. Over their last 12 home games the Cards have been outscored 93-41. Overall the Cardinals are a league-worst 14-22 at home with a 6.07 ERA, the highest home mark in the Texas League.

Road games, however, have been a much different story. The Cardinals have the best road mark in the Texas League at 24-14, and sport a 3.62 ERA which is the 2nd best in the circuit behind Frisco and tops in the North Division.

**GRINDIN':** Simply put, the Cardinals don't strike out very much. The Cards have struck out the 2nd-fewest times in all of full-season Minor League Baseball with 520 whiffs in 74 games. The only team with fewer strikeouts than Spring-field is the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers (496 K in 74 games). The Cards are averaging just 7.03 K's per game.

**WALK THIS WAY:** In 25 games in the month of June, the Cardinals have drawn 110 walks, most in the Texas League during that time. Springfield's OBP for the month is a league-high .342, and also tops in the league for the season at .349. **Jacob Buchberger** has led the way for the Cardinals drawing 20 free passes in 20 games since the calendar flipped, while also riding a 14 game on-base streak.

**BIG INNINGS COSTLY:** Big innings have happened more frequently than the Cardinals' pitching staff would like so far this season. The Cards have surrendered 52 innings of 3+ runs in 2024. All together, "big innings" have accounted 207 of the 387 runs (53.4%) Springfield has allowed this season. Cardinal opponents have batted around (9+ in an inning) 20 times this season, 9 of which have happened in June. The Travelers have done it in back-to-back games entering play on Sunday. The Cardinals are 29-6 when they don't allow a "big inning" and 9-30 when their oppoonent scores 3+ runs in an inning.

**RUNNING WILD:** The Cardinals are 22-for their last-26 in stolen base attempts over their last 11 games. Jeremy Rivas, RJ Yeager and Mike Antico lead the Cards with 4 SB during that time, while Matt Lloyd and Bryan Torres each have swiped 3 bags. The Cardinals are 4th in the Texas League with 100 SB as a team, while Rivas and Bryan Torres are tied for the team lead with 19 SB. In the month of June, Antico is 4th in the Texas League in steals, going a perfect 10-for-10.

**REDMOND ON DOORSTEP OF SPRINGFIELD HISTORY:** With his go-ahead two-run homer in the 8th inning on April 23 against Arkansas, Cardinals slugger **Chandler Redmond** tied the franchise record for most home runs. His 59 career home runs in a Springfield uniform bring him even with **Xavier Scruggs** (2010-13). **Redmond** already holds the Springfield record for career RBIs with 217.

Since tying the record, however,  $\ensuremath{\textbf{Redmond}}$  has gone 38 straight games without a home run.
