THIS DATE IN HISTORY

The Sounds have won four straight games on May 28th, including 2018's Memorial Day walk-off victory over the Oklahoma City Dodgers at First Horizon Park. Steve Lombardozzi delivered a bases-loaded single in the bottom of the ninth inning to the left field corner to give the Sounds the 3-2 victory.

Tonight's Game: The Nashville Sounds and Toledo Mud Hens play game five of a six-game series tonight at Fifth Third Field. The Mud Hens took their third straight in the series last night, 6-4. Right-hander Caleb Boushley starts for Nashville, going against right-hander Markus Solbach for Toledo.

Caleb Boushley: 28-year-old Caleb Boushley makes his 10th start of the season tonight. He is 4-2 with a 4.23 ERA (44.2 IP/21 ER). The Hortonville, Wis. native last pitched on May 22 vs. Louisville, pitching 6.0 innings in the win. Boushley allowed six hits and four runs (all earned). He struck out and walked a couple. The former UW-La Crosse Eagle went 5-11 with a 5.24 ERA in 24 games (23 starts) with Double-A San Antonio (8) and Triple-A El Paso (16) in the Padres organization last season. He was picked up by the Brewers in the Triple-A Phase of the 2021 Rule 5 Draft. He was originally drafted by San Diego in the 33rd Round of the 2017 MLB First-Year Player Draft.

Markus Solbach: 30-year-old Markus Solbach starts for the Mud Hens tonight. The right-hander is making his second start for Toledo. He began the season with Double-A Erie and went 0-2 with a 3.50 ERA (18.0 IP/7 ER) in five starts before joining Toledo on May 20. He made his Mud Hens debut on May 21 at Indianapolis. He took the win, yielding four hits and two unearned runs in 5.0 innings. Solbach struck out five and walked one on 78 pitches (47 strikes). Last season, he went 0-6 with an 8.12 ERA in 17 games (9 starts) for Triple-A Oklahoma City in the Dodgers organization. Solbach was signed by the Tigers to a minor league deal in the offseason. He was born in Dormagen, Germany and was originally signed by the Twins as an international free agent in 2011.

Superlatives...Yesterday the Sounds fell to 18-5 when hitting a home run...24-6 when scoring 4+ runs...23-4 when scoring first...12-9 in road games...21-11 against a right-handed starter and 17-10 against AL affiliates.

Series Streak Broken: With three consecutive losses the Sounds are behind 3-1 in the series. The team had won its first seven series of the season, a franchise record dating back to at least 1988. The Sounds have lost three straight games for the first time this year.

Tremendous Turang: Brice Turang went 2-for-5 for his third consecutive and team high 14th multi-hit game of the season. He is tied for fifth in the International League with 50 hits.

Welcome Back Ajax: Alex Jackson went 2-for-3 with a double, triple and walk yesterday in his first game since Sunday. He also gunned down a runner from behind the plate, his 11th caught stealing of the season.

100: Right-hander Josh Lindblom threw 100 pitches last night, becoming the first Sound to reach the triple-digit pitch count in 2022. The Lafayette, Ind. native last reached the century mark on Sept. 8, 2021 in a win vs. Memphis.

He Gets On Base: Jonathan Davis reached base safely in his 12th-straight game yesterday, going 1-for-4 with a run and RBI. His .440 on-base percentage ranks fifth in the International League among players who have appeared in at least 20 games.

The Seven: Jason Alexander turned in the longest outing by a Sounds pitcher in 2022 in Wednesday's game (7.0 IP, 4 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 0 BB, 5 K). It was his second quality start of the season. Despite taking the no decision, Alexander still leads the International League in wins (6) and ranks among league leaders in innings pitched (4th, 47.2), WHIP (8th, 1.09) and ERA (9th, 2.64).

Earn It: Nashville's team ERA sits at 3.14 (395.2 IP/138 ER) after yesterday's loss. The 3.14 ERA is the best mark across Triple-A Baseball, far ahead of Iowa with a 3.65 ERA. Nashville's six shutouts also leads Triple-A Baseball.

How Sweet It Is: Sounds manager Rick Sweet is in his third season overall and second consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. Sweet led the Sounds to a 70-58 record in 2021 and a 77-67 record in 2014. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season.

The Future Brew Crew: Nashville has five players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Infielder Brice Turang is the No. 4 prospect, left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 7 prospect, catcher Mario Feliciano is the No. 20 prospect, right-handed pitcher Alec Bettinger is the No. 22 prospect and right-handed pitcher Dylan File is the No. 24 prospect.
