The Ponies got on the board in the 5th on RBI singles from Matt Winaker and Jake Mangum to take a 2-0 lead. The Yard goats would cut the lead in half on a sacrifice fly from Elehuris Montero in the 6th. C Nick Meyer would respond with a solo shot in the 7th to put the Ponies up 3-1. The goats would cut the lead to 3-2 before RHP Eric Orze earned his 2nd save this season.

GREY'S FIRST PONIES WIN: Wednesday's starter RHP Connor Grey earned his first win in a Ponies uniform. Grey went six innings allowing one run and five hits while striking out nine and walking one. Over his last three appearances between Brooklyn (A+) and Binghamton, Grey has allowed 4 runs over 17.1 innings while walking 3 and striking out 24.

ORZE STEADY IN THE PEN: Ponies RHP Eric Orze continued his solid work out of the bullpen going 2 scoreless innings allowing only 1 hit and striking out 5. In 12.1 innings with the Ponies, Orze has a 21:1 K:BB ratio.

HE'S THE MAN-NY: Ponies INF Manny Rodriguez continued his strong month last night going 2-4 at the plate. Rodriguez is hitting .324 this month compared to .172 over the first two months of the season.

MEGILL MAKING HISTORY: Mets RHP Tylor Megill had another stellar start Wednesday night in Queens going 5.1 innings allowing a run on 5 hits while striking out 6 in the Mets 2-1 win over the Atlanta Braves. Megill's 2.04 ERA is the second lowest in Mets history for a rookie in his first seven starts behind only Nolan Ryan's 1.99 ERA

MONTERO MASHING: Yard Goats INF Elehuris Montero went 2-3 Wednesday night and has crushed the ball in July hitting .421 with 10 HR this month. Montero added another RBI last night and now has 54 on the season, good for 2nd in the Northeast League. The infielder came over to the Colorado Rockies as part of the Nolan Arenado trade that sent the 3rd baseman to St. Louis.

PONIES POWER SURGE: After last night's Nick Meyer home-run, the Ponies have homered in eight straight games. Over this span they have slugged 14 of their 72 homers this season.

COMING UP: Tonight is the third game of a 6-game series in Hartford. The Rumble Ponies will return home for a 13-game homestand starting on August 3rd with a 7 game series against the Portland Sea Dogs.
