### History vs. Quad Cities

The Lugnuts are 82-88 all-time vs. the River Bandits, 44-37 at home and 38-51 in Davenport.

The Nuts have played at Quad Cities for four straight seasons, 2023-2026, but the River Bandits have traveled to Michigan's state capital only once in the last five years: 2023, when the Lugnuts won four of six.

Today is the first LAFUC Fireworks Spectacular of the year with a special appearance from the **Zooperstars**, as the Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Athletics, and the Quad Cities River Bandits, High-A affiliate of the Kansas City Royals, play the fourth game of a six-game series. The Lugnuts have won each of the first three games of the series, clinching at least a split, and enter today on a five-game winning streak.

**Yesterday: Lugnuts 12, River Bandits 3.** Zane Taylor allowed three runs in six innings for the Lugnuts' fifth consecutive quality start, Ali Camarillo went 4-for-5, and Dylan Fien, C.J. Pittaro and Casey Yamauchi added three hits apiece in a 17-hit attack: 13 singles and four doubles (including two doubles from Devin Taylor. The Nuts have outscored Quad Cities 30-6 since Rodney Green, Jr.'s three-run tie-breaking home run in the eighth inning on Tuesday.

### LUG-NOTES

**A Milestone Night:** Last night was the 2,000th all-time win in Lansing Lugnuts history! (Coincidentally, the Lugnuts' April 26 defeat at Quad Cities was the club's 2,000th all-time loss.)

**High Five!** The Nuts' current five-game winning streak marks their longest such streak since a five-game winning streak from August 13-16, 2025. A win tonight would mark the longest winning streak since a seven-game winning streak from April 13-19, 2025.

**Prospecting:** The Nuts' roster boasts four players on MLB Pipeline's Top 30 rankings of Athletics prospects: No. 8 (**Devin Taylor**), No. 16 (**Steven Echavarria**), No. 19 (**Zane Taylor**) and No. 26 (**Nate Nankil**).

**That's Quality:** **Zane Taylor's** six-inning gem yesterday marked the Lugnuts' fifth consecutive quality start, following on the heels of **Samuel Dutton** (6 IP, 3 R), **Steven Echavarria** (6 2/3 IP, 2 R), **Tzu-Chen Sha** (6 IP, 3 R) and **Nathan Dettmer** (6 1/3 IP, 0 R). Not coincidentally, the Lugnuts have won all four games. The Nuts have seven total quality starts this year from six different pitchers; only the 20-year-old Echavarria has more than one.

**Taylor-Made Success:** Outfielder **Devin Taylor** is tied for the Midwest League in base hits (42) and runs batted in (30) while ranking 7th in walks (30), 8th in OBP (.436), 8th in batting average (.318) and 9th in total bases (63).

**Got Their Number:** Speaking of **Devin Taylor**, the Indiana Hoosier is batting .412/.487/.618 this year against Quad Cities, going 14-for-34 with four doubles, one homer and five walks in nine games.

**Power to Batsmen:** The Lugnuts are batting .311 with a .435 OBP this week against Quad Cities pitching... but the River Bandits are batting .308 with a .462 slugging percentage against Lansing pitching. Each team has collected 32 hits, second most in the league behind South Bend (which scored 25 runs yesterday in a rout of Wisconsin), but the Lugnuts have outscored the River Bandits 34-10. What's the difference? Check out the walk disparity, with the Nuts drawing 23 walks in three games while only issuing eight free passes.

**Building Speed:** In April, no team in the Midwest League stole fewer bases than the Lugnuts (13 steals in 18 attempts). May has been a completely different matter: 19 steals, more than six MWL squads, with a league low one runner caught stealing. Seven different players have swiped a base.

**Green Power:** **Rodney Green, Jr.'s** 490-foot home run on Tuesday night was the longest tracked home run of the 2026 season, Major League or Minor League; it was also Green's first home run since he blasted a pair on Opening Day against Dayton on April 2.

**Debut Day:** **Ben Newton** makes his 2026 debut tonight as the Lugnuts' designated hitter. An undrafted free agent from Fresno State, the switch-hitting Newton is capable of playing catcher, infield or outfield. Last year, he played in six games for Triple-A Las Vegas, five games for Double-A Midland, 16 games in the Arizona Complex League, and 32 games for the Nuts, batting .239/.283/.291 with four doubles, one triple and one steal.

### MAY 15 IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

**2012:** The Lugnuts beat the Dragons in a walk-off for the second straight day, capturing their seventh straight win, 10-9, on Yeltsin Gudiño's RBI single off Ryan Nutof in the bottom of the tenth. It was also the Lugnuts' third straight walk-off victory over the Dragons dating back to April 27th's series finale. The Lugnuts had blown a 9-3 lead, allowing six runs in the eighth inning.

**2019:** 19-year-old catcher Gabriel Moreno was a smash in his Lugnuts debut, homering in his first at-bat, delivering a two-run single in the fourth inning, tripling in the eighth and finishing 3-for-5, and Rafael Lantigua drew a bases-loaded, four-pitch walk in the bottom of the ninth in a 7-6 win over West Michigan.

**Texas Tech:** Robinson opened up his time in Lubbock as a reliever in 2022, appearing in 12 games (including nine appearances without allowing an earned run)... as a sophomore, was named to the 2023 Collegiate National Team; posted 5.36 ERA in 45 1/3 innings before finishing strong, posting five scoreless innings with eight strikeouts in the Big 12 Tournament against Oklahoma State to earn a nod on the All-Tournament Team, then limited No. 2 Florida to two ER in five innings in the NCAA Tournament... as a junior, led the Red Raiders with 76 IP in 15 starts, with a 5.09 ERA; struck out 11 in six innings at Oklahoma State on May 11, 2024... drafted following junior year.

**Welcome to Pro Ball:** Signed for \$150,000 after being selected with the first pick of Day 3 by the A's... made pro debut for Stockton on August 23, 2024 (2 IP, 3 H, 2 R, 1 BB, 2 K)... made three starts in total before Stockton's season ended, allowing exactly two earned runs in each outing... lefties hit .333 (6-for-18) with 1 BB / 6 K, while righties hit .273 (3-for-11) with 2 BB, 3 K... base-stealers went 2-for-2... pitched in the 2025 Crosstown Showdown, tossing two scoreless innings against Michigan State in relief of Yunior Tur.
