ShoreTown Ballpark – Lakewood, New Jersey (opened 2001)

Game 6 of 6 (Hudson Valley leads season series 3-2 of 24)

Last Game Recap...The BlueClaws walked-off Hudson Valley 5-4 in 10 innings on Saturday, scoring the winning run on a strikeout/passed ball...It was Jersey Shore's third straight win and second walk-off win of the season...John Spikerman had three walks, two runs and three stolen bases...Brandon Beckel got the win, allowing one run (the 10th inning inherited runner) in three innings of relief...Devin Saltiban had two hits including an RBI double.

Going For Four...A win today gives the BlueClaws four straight wins for the first time this year...They are currently on their third three-game winning streak, something they did five times last year, but the third was not until July 27-30.

Spike and Go...Of John Spikerman stole three bases on Thursday and three more on Saturday, giving him 12 on the year to lead the team...He was caught for the first time on Thursday since 8/20/2024 with Clearwater against Dunedin, only the second time he's been thrown out in his career...He had a stretch of 41 straight successful stolen base attempts (including going 30 for 30 last season)...He is now 49-50 stealing bases in his professional career...He was 8-27 at the plate on the recently concluded road trip and his four hit game on April 14th at Rome marked the first of his career...A 3rd round pick in 2024 from Oklahoma, Spikerman finished last year with the BlueClaws, hitting .217 in 24 games.

Extra, Extra...The BlueClaws have played 11 home games, and five have gone to extra innings (2-3)...They are the only team in the minors to have played five extra inning games at home this year (six others have played four) but all have done so in at least 14 home games...The BlueClaws played 10 extra inning games all of last year (two at home)...Extra Inning Home Games By Year: 2021 (3), 2022 (3), 2023 (8), 2024 (3), 2025 (2)...Since 2005, the most extra inning games they have played at home is 14 (7-7) in 2010...They have reached double-figures four times, most recently in 2012.

Jose Hot, Faces Former Team...Jose Colmenares, a former Hudson Valley Renegade (he hit .222 in 76 games with HV last year) hit a three run home run on Friday night, his second home run (one last year) against his former club...Colmenares had two hits and two walks in the win and is now 19-53 since April 12th and up to .343 on the season, fifth best in the league...Colmenares had three hits on both April 12th and 14th (he had two three-hit games all of last year, both with Hudson Valley)...Colmenares turned 24 on Opening Day (April 3rd)...He joined the Phillies in August after being released by the Yankees...Colmenares hit home runs both for and against the BlueClaws and for and against the Renegades last year...In the winter, he hit .357 in 16 games (eight home runs in 64 PAs) to help the Adelaide Giants win the Claxton Shield as Australian Baseball League champions.

Welcome to the Claws...LHP Camron Hill has joined the BlueClaws from Clearwater, where he gave up three earned runs in 7.1 innings with 11 strikeouts and 7 walks...He was an 8th round pick in 2024 from Georgia Tech...Last year, he gave up 10 earned runs in 21.2 innings between the FCL Phillies and Clearwater.

Run Run BlueClaws...The BlueClaws have 19 stolen bases (caught five times) in five games this week (including five by eight Spikerman and three by Brady Day and Carter Mathison)...Eight different players have at least one stolen base in this series...They entered the week with 30 stolen bases in the first 20 games of the season...Spikerman (12), Devin Saltiban (9), and Day (8) lead the team.

Raider Day...Raider Tello had three hits on Friday after he smashed a two run double in the BlueClaws win on Thursday night...Tello now has five RBIs in his last seven games, over which he is 9-25...Tello had five RBIs including a three run home run on Opening Day in Wilmington but had only one RBI between April 4th and April 23rd...He hit eight home runs last year with Clearwater and signed with the Phillies in 2024 out of the University of Iowa...Tello has already started games this year at 1B, 3B, LF, and RF and last year also played 2B and SS.

Don't Even Think About It...Kodey Shojinaga threw out three potential Renegades base-stealers on Wednesday and is now 7-17 throwing out runners this year (he nailed 32% of runners last year, 25-79)...Since the BlueClaws became a High-A affiliate in 2021, he is the fourth catcher to throw out three base-stealers in a game (Kehden Hettiger in 2025, Jordan Dissin in 2024, Arturo De Freitas in 2023), though Shojinaga is the only one to go a perfect 3 for 3.

Mathi-boom...Carter Mathison, who had three hits and two RBIs on Wednesday, hit his first BlueClaws home run on Tuesday, his 8th professional home run after he hit seven last year with Clearwater (this was his first home run since June 5th of last season)...Mathison hit 42 career home runs in three years at Indiana...He was the third Hoosier (Alex Dickerson and Kyle Schwarber) in program history with at least 40 home runs in their first three seasons of college baseball.

The Claws and the Renegades...The BlueClaws and Renegades meet for the first time this season...All told, they will play 24 times this year (the next time will be June 9-14 at Hudson Valley)...The BlueClaws entered this week 54-75 all time against Hudson Valley (they met for the first time in 2021)...The Renegades won 11 of 21 meetings last year.

Locking It Down...The BlueClaws have a bullpen ERA of 3.47 so far this year, the 9th best in Minor League Baseball (of 120 teams) and the third best in the Sally League (Hudson Valley is at 2.84 and Bowling Green is at 3.07; Tacoma [AAA Mariners] leads the minors at 2.50)...Brandon Beckel has allowed one earned run in 15.1 innings with 19 strikeouts and Danyony Pulido has thrown 10.2 innings having allowed one run with 12 strikeouts.

Brock and Roll...Brock Vradenburg had two hits on Friday night, his 3rd multi-hit game of the year...After beginning the season 2-17, he is 12-49 with five doubles...He also had two outs on Saturday on balls hit at least 106 mph...Vradenburg was a 3rd round pick of the Marlins in 2024 out of Michigan State and signed with the Phillies as a free agent in August.

Things in 10s...The BlueClaws have already reached 10+ runs in a game four times this year (twice on the last road trip, 4/14 and 4/18 at Rome), and 19 on Opening Night in Wilmington, a new club record...Last year, the BlueClaws scored 10+ runs in a game seven times and did not do it for a fourth time until June 8th...After their 13-2 win on April 18th, the BlueClaws have won by 10 runs or more three times already this year...They did so twice all of last year, four times in 2024, once in 2023, and once in 2021 (8 times as a High-A affiliate from 2021-2025).

Power Index...The BlueClaws have 10 home runs so far this year including four by Brady Day, three by Jose Colmenares (4/18 at Rome and 5/1 vs Hudson Valley), two by Luis Caicuto (4/11 vs Brooklyn and 4/19 at Rome) and one each by Carter Mathison on 4/26 vs Hudson Valley, and Raider Tello in Wilmington on 4/3...Devin Saltiban (17 in 2024 with Clearwater) and Brock Vradenburg (10 in 2024 between Jupiter and Beloit in the Marlins system) are the only two BlueClaws with a 10 home run season...Last year, the BlueClaws did not have a player hit 10 home runs, the second time in franchise history the BlueClaws did not have a player reach double-digits (Jordan Dissin in 2024 and Zach Arnold in 2025 led the team with nine).

Mr. 900...The BlueClaws entered the season having used 894 different players in their club history, and technically, RHP Danyony Pulido, who threw a scoreless eighth inning on 4/4, was the sixth player to appear in a game this year that had not yet done so before the season, making him the 900th player to play in a game for the BlueClaws.

Familiar Faces...Of the 30 players on the BlueClaws Break Camp Roster, 22 are returning to the BlueClaws and only eight are making their BlueClaws debuts...By comparison, last year, 13 players on the Break Camp roster made their BlueClaws debuts...The new faces: LHP Juan Amarante, RHP Ryan Degges, RHP Adilson Peralta, RHP Danyony Pulido, RHP Giuseppe Velasquez, IF Brady Day, IF Raider Tello, and OF Carter Mathison.

Walk-Off This Way...The BlueClaws have two walk-off wins this year...They beat Hudson Valley on 5/2 on a strikeout/passed ball...They picked up their first walk-off win in 2026 on 4/9 vs Brooklyn on an 11th inning RBI single from Devin Saltiban...The BlueClaws had three walk-off wins last year – a 9/4 win over Brooklyn when Dante Nori scored on a 10th inning wild pitch, an 8/7 win over Hub City on a 9th inning single from Avery Owusu-Asiedu and a 5/6 win over Aberdeen on a home run by Kehden Hettiger...The BlueClaws had three walk-off wins in 2024 – July 23rd vs Abedeen (Keaton Anthony RBI single), plus July 9th against Hudson Valley (Emaarion Boyd 2-run single) and April 5th against Aberdeen (Opening Night, Boyd scores on wild pitch).

The Big Five...The BlueClaws have two pitchers from Big Five schools in Philadelphia...RHP Luke Gabrysh went to St. Joseph's and RHP Ryan Dromboski went to the University of Pennsylvania.

College Teammates...The BlueClaws have two pairs of college teammates in IF Trent Farquhar and 1B Brock Vradenburg, who played together at Michigan State, and C Kodey Shojinaga and RHP Reese Dutton, who played together at Kansas.

Just Grand...Luis Caicuto hit a grand slam in Rome on April 17th...Bryan Rincon's grand slam on May 20, 2025 vs Brooklyn was the BlueClaws first since Jordan Dissin's on June 11, 2024 at Greensboro...The BlueClaws hit three grand slams between 2021 and 2023, but they hit three grand slams in two weeks in 2024 – one by Justin Crawford (May 30th), one by Emaarion Boyd (June 9th), and one by Jordan Dissin (June 11th)...These were the only three grand slams hit by the BlueClaws in 2024.

From The Shore to the Show...132 players have now gone *From the Shore, to the Show* including two to debut Opening Week with the Phillies and five total this year...Justin Crawford (2023-24 BlueClaw) made his debut in the March 26th season opener while Andrew Painter (2022 BlueClaw) debuted on March 31st in the fifth game of the season...RHP George Klassen (2024 BlueClaw) debuted on April 6th with the Angels...IF Hao-Yu Lee (2022-23 BlueClaw) debuted on April 17th with the Tigers...UT Felix Reyes (2023-24 BlueClaw) debuted on April 18th with the Phillies and homered in his first at bat...Two former BlueClaws made debuts in 2025 – RHP Mick Abel (2022 BlueClaw) and UT Otto Kemp (2023-24 BlueClaw).

Mycal Jones Takes Over...Mycal Jones, in his seventh year in the organization, takes over for Greg Brodzinski as the new BlueClaws manager and is the 18th manager in BlueClaws history...Jones was a coach with Reading last year and with Clearwater the two years prior...He played in the Braves system and was originally a fourth round pick in 2009.

On the Staff...Ryan Buchter returns the BlueClaws as the pitching coach...Buchter went to Highland Regional High School in Blackwood, New Jersey...Darnell Sweeney, with the FCL Phillies last year, is the hitting coach...Ryan Wroblewski makes his coaching debut after playing four years in the Astros organization, serving as the position coach and assistant hitting coach...Orlando Munoz returns to the BlueClaws position coach...Marissa VanHassel is the Athletic Trainer, Sam Cartier is the Assistant Athletic Trainer, and John Sweeney is the Strength & Conditioning Coach.

How Acquired: 6th round pick, 2022 draft from Eastside High School (SC)

Season Notes: Matched his BlueClaws high with 9 strikeouts over four scoreless innings on 4/14 at ROM...On Opening Day Roster...#21 prospect in system per MLB Pipeline.

Career Notes: Spent all of 2025 with the BlueClaws, where he went 6-7, 4.41 in 21 starts, with 103 strikeouts and 51 walks in 81.2 innings pitched...In his final eight starts of the year, gave up five earned runs in 34.2 innings pitched with 40 strikeouts and 19 walks...Had a five start stretch (7/11 to 8/8) in which he did not allow an earned run in 23 innings (one unearned run)...Spent 2024 with Clearwater, where he struck out 117 batters in 84 innings, going 7-6 with a 3.64 ERA...Committed to Clemson before signing with the Phillies.

- Cabrera (4/30 and 5/7/24) and Painter (8/6 and 8/13/22) are the only ones to do it in back to back starts.

April 19 th	Luis Caicuto hits the first grand slam of 2026 (first since Bryan Rincon on 5/20/25 vs BRK) in a win at Rome...Caicuto's home run was his second of the year – before April 11 th , his previous home run was on 7/15/22 with the AZL-Diamondbacks.
