FRES-NOTES

TAKE A GOOD LOOK: Fresno's power surge continued at Stockton on July 7, with both Roldy Brito and Derek Bernard going deep — the third time this season the two have gone deep in the same game. Brito's blast was his 7th of the year and, fittingly, a go-ahead shot; he now has 5 go-ahead home runs on the season, the most on the roster by a wide margin, and Fresno is 5-2 in games he's homered in. Bernard matched him with his own 7th of the year and is up to a .961 OPS against Stockton specifically. Between them, Brito and Bernard have combined for 14 of Fresno's 74 home runs this season — nearly one in every five — and both have shown a knack for making them count, with a combined 15 multi-RBI games on the year.

BRITO KEEPS COOKING: Whatever else has happened in this series, Roldy Brito hasn't slowed down. He's hitting .327 with 4 home runs and a 1.085 OPS against Stockton across 12 games this year, extending a trend that's held all season — he simply hits the Ports well.

OUT-HITTING THE OPPOSITION: Even with Tuesday night's series opening loss, across the full season series, Fresno's lineup has delivered more offense — a .287 team average and .876 OPS against Stockton, compared to just .239 and .701 for the Ports. The gap shows up in extra-base damage too: 19 home runs for the Grizzlies against Stockton pitching versus 9 the other way.

BERNARD BRINGS THE POWER: Derek Bernard has quietly been one of the most productive Grizzlies against Stockton this year — a .306 average, 3 home runs, and a .961 OPS across 9 games. Combined with Brito and Ciriaco, it gives Fresno three legitimate power-and-average threats near the top of the order who have all performed above their norms specifically in this matchup.
