FROM THE CROWS NEST

BURNING THE BASE PATHS: Yordany De Los Santos stole his 40th stolen base of the season last night, adding to a career-best mark (34 between FCL/Single-A in 2024). In the process, he passed Jesus Castillo (2023), for the most single-season stolen bases by a Marauder in franchise history. He ranks first in the Florida State League and seventh in Single-A. Moreover, he sits only behind Konnor Griffin (44) for the most swipes in the Pittsburgh Pirates system. They are the ninth and tenth 40+ stolen-base seasons in Pirates-MilB history. The two are approaching Rich Thompson for the most in a season by a Pirates minor leaguer when he stole 58 in 2005 between Double-A Altoona and Triple-A Indianapolis.

PLAN Z: Right hander **Zander Mueth** will toe the rubber for the Marauders in game one of the series tonight. Mueth is set to make his eighth start of the season with Bradenton, and sixth since being activated off the injured list. Last Friday at Jupiter, he tossed 2.1 innings of one-run ball and allowed just three hits. Despite walking a season-high four hitters, Mueth limited the damage after bases-loaded jam in the first. Throughout the year, Mueth has struggled with his command, having walked 16 hitters over 11.1 innings. However, he has done a tremendous job of pitching with traffic as he's limited oppoents to a .208 average with runners in scoring position. On Friday, the Hammerheads standed four runners over their three trips to the plate against Mueth. Since being activated off the injured list, he's allowed four earned runs over 13.1 innings. Mueth entered the 2025 season ranked as the Pirates No. 10 prospect (MLB Pipeline). This season, right-handed hitters have struggled to find the barrel against Mueth, as they're batting just .154 with one extra-base hits against him. He features a sinker (94.1 mph), slider (83.9 mph), and changeup (86.7 mph). 29 of his 30 hardest thrown heaters this month have come in the month of July (topped out at 98.1 mph on 7/1 vs FTM).

SECOND-HALF TRENDS: Bradenton is off to a 13-14 start in the second half, currently 0.5 games back of Fort Myers for the FSL West's final playoff spot. With 39 games to go, the Marauders are eyeing their first postseason appearance since 2021 when they won their second FSL title. Entering the week, Bradenton has been stellar on the mound in the second half, posting a 3.28 ERA over 228 innings - the sixth best mark in Class-A and the third best in the Florida State League. In the process, their starters have been dominant, registering a 1.90 ERA to lead all Single-A clubs over the stretch (San Jose - 2.48, 2nd). In the process they've limited opponents to a .197 average and have only allowed two homers as a group. Moreover, as an offense, they're 66-for-228 (.289) with runners in scoring position, good for the third highest clip in Single-A in run-scoring opportunities. They've also swiped 64 bases, the second most in Single-A.

MARAUDERS MASHERS: The Bradenton Marauders return from the All-Star Break as one of the best home-run hitting teams in all of Class-A. Their 74 longballs this season are the most in the Florida State League and second-most throughout the entire level. 111 of their 428 total runs have been generated via the long ball (25.9%). They're 25-21 when leaving the yard at least once, and 17-28 when not homering at all. They've seen three players launch 9+ home runs this season, more than any other team in the FSL (A. Plaz, Y. De Los Santos, K. Griffin)

WELCOME TONY: Pirates No. 21 prospect (MLB Pipeline) **Tony Blanco Jr.** was activated and assigned to Single-A Bradenton on Saturday, July 19 at Jupiter and collected his first Single-A hit and RBI on a first-inning single and fourth-inning sacrfice fly. Blanco began the season on the injured list and just completed a two-game rehab assignment with the FCL Pirates where he went 1-for-6 with a home run. In 30 FCL games last year, Blanco Jr. batted .305 and slugged .505 with four homers. His father Tony Blanco played 62 big-league games for the Washington Nationals in 2005 and spent eight seasons in the Nippon Professional Baseball League in Japan.

MARAUDERS ON THE MEND: In this year's draft the Pittsburgh Pirates selected RHP Seth Hernandez sixth overall in the first round of the 2025 MLB Draft and signed with the organization on Tuesday for 7.25 million dollars, the largest bonus ever for a prep pitcher. Hernandez was recently named 2025 Gatorade National High School Player of the Year and spent the 2025 season as a senior at Corona High School in California (0.39 ERA/53.1 IP, 105 K). He was committed to Vanderbilt University. At 19 years old, he was touted as the best prep arm in the draft, and the No. 3 overall prospect in the draft class via MLB Pipeline. His fastball reached 100 miles per hour, paired with an esteemed changeup, curveball and slider. Other notable selections included C Easton Carmichael (3rd Rd., Oklahoma), SS Gustavo Melendez (4th Rd., HS) and IB Jared Jones (9th Rd., LSU) among others.

ZANDER MUETH'S HIGHS

Right hander **Zander Mueth** will toe the rubber for the Marauders in game two of the series tonight. Mueth is set to make his eighth start of the season with Bradenton, and sixth since being activated off the injured list. Last Friday atJupiter, he tossed 2.1 innings of one-run ball and allowed just three hits. Despite walking a season-high four hitters, Mueth limited the damage after bases-loaded jam in the first. Throughout the year, Mueth has struggled with his command, having walked 16 hitters over 11.1 innings. However, he has done a tremendous job of pitching with traffic as he's limited oppoents to a .208 average with runners in scoring position. On Friday, the Hammerheads standed four runners over their three trips to the plate against Mueth. Since being activated off the injured list, he's allowed four earned runs over 13.1 innings. Mueth entered the 2025 season ranked as the Pirates No. 10 prospect (MLB Pipeline) after a strong 2024 season where he posted a 2.31 ERA over 74 innings between the FCL and Single-A. He was selected by the Pirates in the CB-B Round as the 67th overall pick of the 2023 draft. This season, right-handed hitters have struggled to find the barrel against Mueth, as they're batting just .154 with one extra-base hits against him. He features a sinker (94.1 mph), slider (83.9 mph), and changeup (86.7 mph).Last year Single-A opponents batted just .176 against his heater and .077 versus his slider.

Legue Pirates on 7/19. In his Marauders debut last Saturday, the southpaw only recorded two outs in the first inning after surrendering two runs on four walks. In the process he recorded one punchout. Through 34 pitches, he used his heater about two-thirds of the time and it averaged 95.5 mph while generating four whiffs on seven swings.
