NOTES AND NUGGETS

GOOD TIMES, BAD TIMES

2026 has been a roller coaster for Omaha, with the Storm Chasers currently playing some of their best baseball this season.

Of 20 series this year, the Chasers have won 8, lost 9 and split 4 ... prior to last week's series loss to Columbus, the Storm Chasers had gone unbeaten their last 4 series between July 17 and August 9.

Since July 10, Omaha has gone 18-10 (.643 win %), a winning percentage that ranks 5th among Triple-A teams in this stretch.

LEAN WITH IT, ROC(HESTER) WITH IT

This week, the Rochester Red Wings make their first Triple to Werner Park and the Rochester franchise's first visit to Omaha since 1990.

Since joining the International League in 2023, Omaha has visited Rochester 3 times ... the two clubs split a series in Rochester July 12-17, 2022; Omaha won a series 4-2 over Rochester from June 20-25, 2023, and the clubs split a series from July 30 to August 4, 2024.

Rochester's last visit to Omaha came in September 1990, when the Omaha Royals defeated the Rochester Red Wings 4 games to 1 in the Triple-A Classic, giving Omaha its 4th of now 8 Triple-A National Championships ... the clubs played at Rosenblatt Stadium September 13 (9-7 Omaha win) and 14 (4-3 Omaha win).

COMEBACK KIDS

The Chasers have 31 comeback wins and have blown a lead in 34 losses this year.

31 comeback wins are the 6th-most in the International League, tied 8th-most in Triple-A ... 34 blown leads rank tied 3rd in the International League and tied 4th in Triple-A.

Over the last 82 games (since May 9), Omaha is 40-42 ... the Chasers have trailed at some point in 25 of their 40 wins in that stretch, and led at some point in 24 of their 42 losses - meaning 49 of Omaha's last 82 games (60%) have featured a comeback from the eventual winner ... it's also been a tight stretch overall: 49 of those 82 games (60%) have been decided by 3 runs or fewer.

THE SUMMER OF SQUIRES

Brett Squires has swung the bat especially well over the last 2 months.

In his last 41 games (since June 21), Brett Squires is slashing .305/.381/.603 (46-for-151) with 32 RBI ... in this stretch, he ranks 4th in the IL in total bases (91) and SLG, tied 5th in RBI and extra-base hits (21) and 7th in home runs (11).

June 16 to July 2, he hit safely in a career-best 14 games, Omaha's 2nd-longest hitting streak this season, reaching base safely in 17 straight, June 16 to July 5.

Since his Triple-A debut (May 12), Squires ranks 3rd in the IL in total bases (157), tied 4th in home runs (20), 5th in SLG (.586) and RBI (57) and tied 6th in OPS (.936).

HONEST ABE

Abraham Toro started the season slow, but has been one of the International League's best hitters since mid-May.

Toro hit just .189 (21-for-111) from March 27 to May 10, but in 65 games since May 12, he has a .313 average (77-for-246) ... since May 12, he ranks tied 3rd among qualifiers in the International League in OPS (.958), 5th in average and 6th in SLG (.577).

Overall in 2026, Toro ranks tied 6th in the International League in extra-base hits (44), 8th in total bases (184) and tied 9th in RBI (67).

GETTING OFFENSIVE

The Storm Chasers have seen success at the plate this season, especially in recent months.

Overall in 2026, Omaha ranks tied 3rd in the International League in batting average (.263), leading the league in doubles (240), while 3rd in triples (27), 5th in hits (1029) and tied 5th in total bases (1728) ... however, with a Triple-A-low 417 walks drawn, the club's .338 OBP ranks tied for the 4th-lowest in the 20-team IL.

In 61 games since June 1, Omaha's offense leads the league in batting average (.281), SLG (.479), OPS (.828), hits (595), total bases (1015) and doubles (142), while 2nd in runs scored (363) and triples (16) ... Omaha leads all of Minor League Baseball in doubles since June 1, while 4th in the Minors in slugging percentage, tied 4th in batting average and 7th in total bases.

NEW GUYS IN THE HOUSE

The Storm Chasers will be seeing the Triple-A debuts from two players this series.

OF Carson Roccaforte joins Omaha along with LHP Hunter Patteson after both starting the year and spending all season to this point in Double-A.
