LAST OUTING: Herb last pitched on July 9 at Columbus. He tallied his first quality start for the Sounds, allowing just one run on four hits and a walk in 6.0 innings. Striking out six, Herb managed 66 strikes on 98 pitches.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Herb has pitched against Memphis twice: once in 2018 with Sacramento and on June 16 this season. He is 0-2 with an 8.31 ERA all time against the Redbirds. He allowed six runs in 2.2 innings at AutoZone Park in a Sounds' 7-6 loss earlier this season.
