### THIS DATE IN HISTORY

On July 16, 2016, Bruce Maxwell went 5-for-5 with 4 runs, 2 home runs, and 6 RBI as the Sounds pumel El Paso 19-5. The former Oakland A's catcher hit .321 with 41 RBI in 60 games for the Sounds that season.

**Tonight's Game:** Tonight, the Nashville Sounds face the Memphis Redbirds in Episode V of the six-game series. The Sounds walked-off in the 10th inning with a 4-3 victory last night. Right-hander Tyler Herb will start for Nashville, going against Aaron Brooks for Memphis.

**Tyler Herb:** 30-year-old Tyler Herb starts for the Sounds this evening. The right-hander is 1-4 with a 5.49 ERA (39.1 IP/24 ER) in nine appearances (six starts) for Nashville this season. He began the season with Biloxi, going 3-1 with a 1.31 ERA in seven outings. Herb tallied his first quality start for Nashville in his last outing on July 9 at Columbus, allowing just a run on four hits and a walk while striking out six. He was signed as a free agent by Milwaukee prior to the 2022 campaign. The Pennsylvania native went 3-6 with a 4.16 ERA in 17 games (16 starts) for Double-A Arkansas in the Mariners organization last season. He was originally drafted by the Mariners in the 29th Round of the 2014 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of Coastal Carolina University.

**Aaron Brooks:** 32-year-old veteran Aaron Brooks starts for the Redbirds on Saturday night. The right-hander begins the night 4-4 with a 6.50 ERA (54.0 IP/39 ER) with Memphis in 2022. Brooks also possesses a 7.71 ERA (9.1 IP/8 ER) in seven appearances for St. Louis this season. He earned the win in his last outing on July 10, finishing with six scoreless innings in a nine-strikeout game at Durham. Brooks earned wins on both June 14 and 19 vs. Nashville. He went 3-5 with a 3.35 ERA in 13 starts for the Kia Tigers of the Korea Baseball Organization in 2021. He has pitched for the Royals, Athletics, Orioles and Cardinals in his career. Brooks was originally drafted by Kansas City in the Ninth Round of the 2011 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of Cal State San Bernardino.

**2022 Standings:** The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the International League West Division standings in 2022: First: 80, Second: 11, Third: 3, Fourth: 2, Fifth: 1, Sixth: 0, Seventh: 0, Eighth: 0, Ninth: 0, Tenth: 0.

**Superlatives:** Last night's win moved the Sounds to 46-12 when scoring 4+ runs...22-6 when hitting multiple home runs...38-4 when outpitching opponents...5-2 in extra innings and 29-17 at First Horizon Park.

**(H)R2-D2:** Patrick Dorrian and Garrett Whitley hit back-to-back homers for the Sounds, taking their 1-0 deficit to a 2-1 lead in two swings. The Sounds have hit back-to-back homers in consecutive games and have homered consecutively on four occasions in 2022.

**Leading the Rebel Alliance:** Infielder/Outfielder Pablo Reyes has hit safely in seven of his last eight games with five multi-hit contests over the span. During the eight-game stretch, Reyes is hitting .400 (12-for-30) with 4 runs, 2 doubles, 1 triple, 1 home run, 5 RBI and 3 stolen bases.

**The Chosen One:** Brice Turang stole his 18th base of the season in the third inning of last night's game. He is now tied for 10th-most in the International League. Turang has stolen four bases in his last three games. He's also tied for fourth with 92 hits in the International League.

**A Jedi Master:** Reliever Trevor Kelley tossed a couple more scoreless innings in last night's win. On the season, Kelley has a 0.50 ERA (18.0 IP/1 ER) in 17 outings with the Sounds. He is holding opposing hitters to a .197 average with a 0.94 WHIP in Triple-A this season.

**Using the Force:** Marcus Walden picked up his first quality start as a Sound last night, allowing just one run on three hits and two walks in 6.0 innings. The former Red Sox reliever has allowed only a run in each of his last two appearances (9.1 IP).

**The Death Star:** The Sounds are back at First Horizon Park where they will play eight of their next 11 games through the month of July. Nashville is tied with Columbus for the best home record in the International League at 29-17.

**Obi-Wan Otero:** Reliever Andy Otero continues to throw the ball well and delivered 2.2 scoreless innings Tuesday night. Dating back to his outing on June 16 at Memphis, Otero has a scoreless innings streak of 11.1 innings. In 11 total games with Nashville, the southpaw is 0-0 with a 1.59 ERA (28.1 IP/5 ER). Opponents are hitting just .179 against him.

**Win a Lot, He Does:** Rick Sweet took his 200th wins as Nashville's manager last night, good for 5th-most in franchise history. Don Money has the 4th-most wins in franchise history with 223. As well as Nashville, Sweet has 200+ wins with four other Triple-A teams: 1993-95 Tucson (251), 2001-03 Portland (212), 2005-11 Louisville (539) and 2015-18 Colorado Springs (282).

**LAST OUTING:** Herb last pitched on July 9 at Columbus. He tallied his first quality start for the Sounds, allowing just one run on four hits and a walk in 6.0 innings. Striking out six, Herb managed 66 strikes on 98 pitches.

**AGAINST OPPONENT:** Herb has pitched against Memphis twice: once in 2018 with Sacramento and on June 16 this season. He is 0-2 with an 8.31 ERA all time against the Redbirds. He allowed six runs in 2.2 innings at AutoZone Park in a Sounds' 7-6 loss earlier this season.
