### Tonight's Game

The Clippers will send RHP **Rorik Maltrud** to the mound tonight, making his first start since leaving the game after getting hit by a line drive on 6/25 at Omaha (hit by **Gavin Cross**; also left 6/7 game after a Cross line drive). Louisville will counter with RHP **Davis Daniel**. Columbus is 37-22 (.627) versus right handers this year. Daniel is 0-1 with a 7.04ERA in 2G against Columbus in his career.

### vs. the Bats

Columbus was 7-11 against Louisville last year, going 4-10 in the last 14G to lose the season series for the third straight year (4-0 from 2018-22). The Clippers took the series 3-2 in the first half of the season this year, with each team scoring 18 runs. **George Valera** has collected 6HR and 14RBI in 31G opposing Louisville, while **Angel Genao** has hit .357 (10x28) in 9G this year.

### Leading Off

The Clippers managed to start five innings with a runner last night, but plated only one of those men (**Petey Halpin** in the 1st, left the bases loaded). In the series, Columbus has managed just seven leadoff runners (20% of innings, zero on Wednesday and Thursday), scoring just once (leadoff man reached 45 times in previous two series, 43% of innings played, scoring in 27 of those innings, 60%).

### Coming Back Strong

**Petey Halpin** is 7x18 (.389) in 4G since getting optioned, scoring a run in each game (112 runs since Triple-A debut, 10th most in the IL in that time). Including the week before his last stint in Cleveland (at Indy, 6/9-6/13), Halpin has hit .325 (13x40) over his last 9G with Columbus. He has 36K in 39G this year (none in last 5G), following a '25 campaign that saw the 7th most in team history (156 in 126G).

### Angel Ascendant

**Angel Genao** has a 1.059OPS in the last 15G, batting .389 (21x54) while drawing 10BB in 66PA (15%) over that time (11BB in 139PA, 8%, in first 35G with Columbus). Genao has scored 13 runs in those 15G, collecting 10RBI and 6XBH (.574SLG). Among IL hitters with at least 35PA from the 7th inning on, Genao has the 2nd best OPS (1.200; 1st- **Travis Bazzana**, 9th- **Kody Huff**, 10th- **Cooper Ingle**).

### Snapping Out of It

**Juan Brito** doubled in the 1st inning last night to extend his hitting streak to 8G (.345, 10x29 since 6/25; hit .136, 8x59, in 16G prior, 6/4-6/23). He has 6XBH (.690SLG) during the hit streak and last night's double tied him with **Ricky Ledee** for the 24th most doubles in franchise history (62). He walked again last night, extending his walk streak to 7G (9BB) and giving him 151 in his career (tied for 21st).

### Fourth and Two

**Ralph Velazquez** will be making his 35th start at the cleanup spot tonight (all 36 starts with Akron were #2). His bomb on Sunday was just the second homer from the #4 Clipper in the last 53G (last team in MiLB to hit multiple homers since 5/2). While the .369SLG produced in that time ranks 19th in the IL, Columbus cleanup hitters have still managed the 4th best exit velocity (91.0mph).

### More Ralphy

**Ralph Velazquez** extended his career best on base streak to 24G last night (.390OBP since 6/3), collecting a single (hits in 10 of last 11; .341, 14x41) and a walk (1BB in each of last 5G). His streak is the third longest active streak in the IL (**Kody Huff** is 8th at 20G). Over his last 16G, Velazquez has watched his OBP rise 63 points to .358, but his SLG has dropped by nine points (1XBH in 65AB).

### Solid Trip

**Milan Tolentino** was 8x19 (.421) in 5G at Omaha, collecting hits on 67% of balls put in play (7K in 21PA). Dating to the nightcap vs. Scranton/WB on 6/19, he is 14x37 (.378) in his last 11G, collecting 8XBH (.676SLG) and 8RBI. Last night's steal put him halfway to 20, as he attempts to record his second straight 20-20 season (10HR; became first Clipper ever to achieve 20-20 last year).

### Frias Feeling It

**Dayan Frias** is hitting .333 (12x36) in his last 10G, after having gone 2x27 (.074) in his previous 15G (5/6-6/16). Wednesday's multi-hit game was his third of the stretch, boosting his season batting average to a high of .208 (was also .208 on 4/8). He counts 4XBH among his last 8G (4XBH in previous 46G), raising his slugging to a season high of .283 (.298OBP, has not been over .300 since 4/12).

# Columbus Clippers Game Information

Saturday, July 4

## This Date in Clipper History

7/4/1982

In a double header at Syracuse, Clipper pitcher **Lynn McGlothern** broke **George Bell's** jaw with a pitched ball. The fireworks started when Syracuse pitcher **Jackson Todd** retaliated by throwing two pitches at **Otis Nixon's** head, inciting a bench clearing brawl. The Clippers and Chiefs split the double header with Columbus taking game one 8-1 and Syracuse prevailing 9-1 in the second game.

## First Half Wrap

Despite being eliminated from playoff contention on the penultimate Sunday of the first half, the Clippers were 41-33 and finished with their first winning record in the front half since the season was split in 2023 (averaged 32 wins from 2023-25, topping out at 34-38, .472, last season). From 4/22-6/17, they spent every day between 3.0 and 6.0 games off the lead, while occupying anywhere between 4th and 13th in the standings. A late push (15-6 from 5/16-6/9) got them to within 2.5 before derailing with a 3G losing streak at Indy to seal their fate. On the back half, Columbus has posted just one winning record, clinching a playoff berth in 2024 with a mark of 48-26 (.649).

## Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,450 to 1,397).

## Challenging Times

The Clippers are 122-101 (.547) in pitch reviews, with batters going 64-67 (.489) and pitchers/catchers going 58-34 (.630). They have run out of challenges in 36G and have not challenged in 4G. Last season, they were correct 43.1% of the time (2nd worst in the IL).

## Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus is 5-3 in extra innings this year, after having gone .500 in each of the last two seasons. Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 55-36 when playing past regulation (.604, best in the IL; no other team above .571), including 27-17 at home (.614; 5-7 in last 12G). Of the 91G to require extra play, 72 have been resolved after one frame (including nine DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 on 9/20/22 at Toledo).

## On the Runs

Starting with the embiggened 150G schedule in 2022, the Clippers scored over 800 runs in three consecutive seasons from 2022-2024 (855, 808 and 805 runs, respectively; accounting for the 3rd, 4th and 5th best totals in team history). Following a steep decline last season (670, fewest scored in a full season since 2018), Columbus is looking to top 800 again (on pace for 809, would rank as 4th most all-time; record is 898 scored in 1983).

## On the Run

On the basepaths, the Clippers are making a run at the franchise mark in stolen bases, with 102 through the first 84G (on pace for 181SB). The team record was set in 2024 when Columbus swiped an even 200, but the team speed was throttled last year (129SB; still, the 2nd highest total since the Cleveland affiliation started in 2009). However, with 29CS so far, the Clippers are also pacing for the most times caught stealing of the Cleveland affiliation (51; also nabbed 51 times in 2024).

## Crazy Eighthths

From the 8th inning on, the Clippers have scored an IL-best 133 runs while crafting a .936OPS (over 100 points better than all other teams). On the flipside, Columbus has given up 68 runs on the 8th on, resulting in a +65 run differential (Clippers are getting outscored 196-130 from innings 5-7).

## Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 78 grand slams and 1,950RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

## In Big Trouble

The Clipper pitching staff is trending toward the worst ERA in club history, sitting at 5.28 through the first 84G. Since the reorganization of the minor leagues in 2021, Columbus has twice finished the season with a 5+ ERA (current record is 5.32, set in 2023), after having done so just once in the first 43 seasons (5.08 in 1983). However, the staff is pacing to give up only 172HR (average of 182 per season since the Year of the Homer in 2019).

## Department of Defense

The Columbus defense is sitting at 6th in the IL this year (.980), following a 2025 that saw a franchise record (.985, led the IL). On 4/10 at Worcester, the defense collapsed for the first 5E game since 8/27/24 (topped out at 3E in a game twice last year and had fewer than 5E in 21 of 26 series). The Clippers have played flawlessly in 45G this season (27-18, .600), after doing so in nearly 60% of games last year (44-42, .512), including 16 straight from 6/20-7/8/25 (longest streak in the IL over the last 20 years).

## Good Baseball

**Dayan Frias** bunted the tying runs into scoring position on 6/20 vs. Scranton/WB and the Clippers ended up completing the comeback win. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 89-23 (.795) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 6-2 mark this season (.750, blew 7-run lead in one of the losses; went 23-2 in 2018).

## To the End

The Clippers have the most last at bat wins this year (14, tied with Syracuse) while playing in the most games decided in the last at bat (23, tied with Omaha). Since the start of the 2024 season, Columbus has played in 97G decided in the last at bat (2nd most in the IL), going 48-49 (.495, 14th best winning percentage; 3rd most wins, 2nd most losses).

## Manager Profile

**Andy Tracy** made his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's sixth year as a manager (first was with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 432-444 (.493), 402-398 with Columbus (.503).
