### FROM THE CROWS NEST

LAST TIME OUT: Axiel Plaz hit a two-run home run in the second inning before the Lakeland Flying Tigers scored 10 unanswered runs to end the contest and defeat the Bradenton Marauders 10-2 on Wednesday morning at LECOM Park. Carlson Reed struck out four while allowing three runs in 5.1 innings. Keiner Delgado and Esmerlyn Valdez each tallied multi-hit games to lead the offense.

LAST DAY: Thursday night marks the final game of the first half of the 2024 Florida State League season with Friday being the start of the second half. The Marauders opponent, the Lakeland Flying Tigers, have to wintonight and have the Clearwater Threshers lose to clinch the West Division First Half Championship. If Lakeland loses, they would finish second. The Marauders have been eliminated from winning the First Half.

 $\textbf{A GOOD START TO SUMMER:} \ Marauders \ \textbf{C Omar Alfonzo} \ is currently riding a 10-game on-base streak, the sixth-longest active streak in the Florida State League. During this stretch, Alfonzo is hitting .375/.444/.575 with two doubles, two home runs, five RBIs, four walks, and six runs scored. The Pirates' No. 28 prospect session-long 16-game on-base streak lasted from 5/11-6/1 and has reached base safely in 26$ of his last 30 games. Since May 11, Alfonzo has a .411 on-base percentage, the third-best in the FSL among qualified batters.

HERE COMES THE POWER: The Marauders finished the month of May with 20 home runs in 26 games, the second-most in the FSL, with the Dunedin Blue Jays in first at 24. This came after the Marauders had only 10 longballs in 22 games in April. So far in June, Bradenton has 21 home runs in 17 games, which is the most in the FSL and all of Single-A. Bradenton has homered in four-straight and 11 of their last 12 games.

**TAPE MEASURE BLAST: C Axiel Plaz** clubbed a game-tying home run in the ninth inning on Sunday afternoon that was measured at 449 ft, the third-longest HR in the FSL this season. The 18-year-old owns the longest home run at 454 ft that was hit back on May 18 at George M. Steinbrenner Field in Tampa. Bradenton holds the top three spots with Sergio Campana's 451 ft blast the second-longest.

IT'S BEEN A MINUTE: Tuesday marked the start of a six-game series at LECOM Park against the Lakeland Flying Tigers. Bradenton and Lakeland haven't faced each other since the first full week of the season from April 9 - 14 back at Joker Marchant Stadium. It's the first time Lakeland pays a visit to the Friendly City since Aug. 15 - Aug. 20, 2023 where both teams earned a split.

WELCOME TO THE K ZONE: Since June 4, Bradenton's pitching staff has accumulated 157 strikeouts in 120.0 IP, which is the fourth-most in Minor League Baseball, with the Durham Bulls (Triple-A, TB) pacing the pack. However, Bradenton's 11.78 K/9 is the second-best in MiLB during this stretch only trailing the Jersey Shore Blue Claws (High-A, PHI).

JAVVY'S MASHIN: Since June 4, Javier Rivas is slashing .425/.489/.775 with three doubles, a triple, three home runs, seven RBIs, one walk, and eight runs scored in 13 games. Rivas' career-long 13-game on-base streak came to an end on Wednesday against Lakeland. It was his longest streak since he reached base in 11-straight games from 8/10/21 - 8/26/21 when he was a member of the DSL Pirates Black. He's also tied his career-high with five home runs this season.

PROSPECTS, PROSPECTS: With the addition of OF Enmanuel Terrero, the Bradenton Marauders now hold seven of the Pittsburgh Pirates' Top 30 prospects according to MLB Pipeline, which is the most of any Minor League team in the Pirates system. The Altoona Curve (Double-A) are the closest team holding six of the Top 30 with five of the Pirates top eight prospects there. **LHP Michael** Kennedy is the highest-rated player on the Marauders roster at No. 14

CLOSE QUARTERS: Tuesday's win against Lakeland marked the Marauders' 25th one-run contest of the season. The Marauders own an 14-11 record in those games with 42 of their first 65 (64.6%) games having been decided by three runs or less. Only five of their last 14 games have been decided by three-runs or less.
