#### **SHUCKERS NEWS & NOTES**

NOW THAT'S HOW YOU START A WEEK: The Shuckers enter today with a chance to clinch their second series win against a South Division opponent in 2023... Over the first three games of their series with the M-Braves, the Shuckers have outscored them 14-4 (+10), allowing three runs or less in all three games.

Since Tuesday, Biloxi's four runs allowed are the least allowed by any team in Double-A... The staff's 39 strikeouts also rank as the second-most in Double-A and the most among teams who have played three games.

BREAKING INTO DOUBLE-DIGITS: With a save on Thursday night, RHP Cam Robinson became the eighth player in franchise history (since 2015) to reach 10-plus saves in a single-season... Since the start of July, Robinson has earned seven saves, including two during this week's series against the Mississippi Braves... In August, Robinson has a 1.17 ERA over six appearances and 7.2 innings.

CARLOS KEEPS COLLECTING: OF Carlos Rodriguez tallied his seventh multi-hit game in his last eight games on Thursday night with a 2-5 performance... Over his last eight games, Rodriguez is 14-34 (.412) with three doubles, two walks and 10 RBI... Of his eight hits, six have come with a runner in scoring position, a .667 clip (6-9, 10 RBI).

CREEPING UP ON 20: With a 115 MPH home run on Wednesday, C/1B Wes Clarke is now one home run away from becoming the fourth player in Shuckers franchise history (since 2015) to hit 20 home runs in a season... Clarke would join **OF Corey** Ray (27, 2018), C/OF Jakson Reetz (22, 2022) and INF Cam Devanney (20, 2022) with his 20th home run.

CLOSING IN ON THE RECORD BOOKS: OF Jackson Chourio enters today three home runs away from becoming the first teenager in Double-A or Triple-A to record 20 home runs and 20 stolen bases in a season since OF Delmon Young in 2005 with the Montgomery Biscuits (TB).

📚 Chourio's 73 RBI are the second-most in a single-season in Shuckers' history (since 2015)... Chourio is one away from tying the single-season franchise record (74), set by **OF Corey Ray** in 2017.

PLAYOFFS? WE'RE TALKING ABOUT PLAYOFFS: Entering today, the Biloxi Shuckers would qualify for the 2023 Southern League Playoffs, their first appearance since 2019... The Shuckers have two paths to make the playoffs; win the South Division in the second half OR finish runner-up in the division if the Pensacola Blue Wahoos win the second-half title in the division... The Shuckers have a one-game lead on the Montgomery Biscuits and a four-game lead on the Blue Wahoos for the division lead... The Shuckers would face the Blue Wahoos in the South Division Championship Series if they qualify.

TODAY'S STARTER // RHP TJ SHOOK [4-4, 5.48]: RHP TJ Shook will make his first start against the M-Braves since he set a career-high with 11 strikeouts on July 3 at MGM Park... Today marks Shook's seventh start of the year and 20th appearance... Over his last four starts, Shook has gone at least five innings twice.
