#### By the Numbers

**27** The Captains lead the Midwest League and rank T-7<sup>th</sup> in High-A with 27 HR this season. However, after hitting 6 HR in their last home series versus Great Lakes, **Lake County has been held without a home run over its last 10 games.**

**12** **RHP Dylan DeLucia, tonight's Captains starter, has pitched 12 straight scoreless innings over his last 3 appearances.** The 2022 6<sup>th</sup>-round pick out of Ole Miss has recorded 13 K and a .100 opposing AVG during this span.

**7** **Lake County has caught 7 Quad Cities runners stealing so far this series.** The River Bandits have been held to just 3-for-10 (.300) stealing against the Captains' defense this week.

#### CAPTAINS LOG

**LAST TIME OUT:** The Captains, who suited up as **Los Picantes de Lake County**, tied the game down to their final out in the bottom of the 9<sup>th</sup> inning. However, Lake County fell to Quad Cities by a final score of 2-1 in 10 innings on Friday night at Classic Auto Group Park in Eastlake.

**TINCHER TIES IT UP:** DH Johnny Tinchler drove in the Captains' lone run of the night. With Lake County down to its final out in the home half of the 9<sup>th</sup> inning, **the 2023 11<sup>th</sup>-round pick out of Washington hit an RBI single to tie the game and ultimately send the contest to extra innings.**

**APRIL SHOWERS BRING KNAPCZYK HITS:** INF Christian Knapczyk recorded a leadoff single in the bottom of the 6<sup>th</sup> inning on Friday night. **The 23-year-old entered Saturday tied for the Midwest League with 11 H so far this month, while ranking T-2<sup>nd</sup> with a .393 AVG.**

**SMOOTH, SCORELESS SAILING:** LHP Matt "Tugboat" Wilkinson (ND) did not record a decision in his 7<sup>th</sup> start of the season on Friday night. The 2023 10<sup>th</sup>-round pick out of Central Arizona College (JUCO) worked 4 scoreless innings, allowing just 2 hits and 3 walks, while throwing 5 strikeouts. **Wilkinson entered Saturday leading qualified Midwest League pitchers with a 0.00 ERA so far this month, while ranking top-10 in opposing AVG (.133, 3<sup>rd</sup>) and WHIP (0.89, 6<sup>th</sup>).**

**JASIAK'S STREAK CONTINUES:** RHP Jack Jasiak (L, 4-2) permitted 1 unearned run in 1 inning of relief on Friday night, as an RBI single in the top of the 10<sup>th</sup> inning drove in the River Bandits' ghost runner from 2<sup>nd</sup> base. **The 2022 12<sup>th</sup>-round pick out of South Florida still has yet to allow an earned run through his first 9 career High-A appearances (18.1 IP).**

**DEFEND THE 'SHIP:** This season, the Captains are looking to win back-to-back Midwest League Championships. **Lake County will look to record the 7<sup>th</sup> instance of a franchise winning consecutive MWL titles.**

#### TRENDS & NOTABLES

**JOSE'S HOT START:** After winning the 2024 Midwest League Championship with Lake County, SS **Jose Devers** has excelled early to begin the 2025 campaign. **The Samana, DR native leads the Midwest League with 17 XBH**, while ranking top-5 in 2B (11, 2<sup>nd</sup>), TB (54, T-4<sup>th</sup>), and HR (5, T-5<sup>th</sup>). After hitting 7 HR in 102 games with the Captains last year, **Devers already has 5 HR in his first 29 games this season.**

**CHRISTIAN'S CRUSHING IT:** INF Christian Knapczyk has become one of the Midwest League's premier hitters to begin his High-A career. **The 2023 5<sup>th</sup>-round pick out of Louisville ranks 5<sup>th</sup> in the Midwest League in both AVG (.316) and OPS (.909)**, while ranking 8<sup>th</sup> in OBP (.425) and SLG (.484, 8<sup>th</sup>), as well as 12<sup>th</sup> in H (30).

**ALFONSIN'S AWESOME OFFENSE:** OF Alfonsin Rosario, MLB Pipeline's No. 25 Cleveland prospect, has had a strong start to his High-A career. **The 20-year-old ranks top-5 in the Midwest League in SLG (.516, 3<sup>rd</sup>) and HR (5, T-5<sup>th</sup>)**, while ranking just outside of the top-10 in OPS (.863, 12<sup>th</sup>) and TB (48, T-15<sup>th</sup>). **Rosario was the only Single-A player with 15+ HR, 70+ RBI, and 20+ SB last year with Single-A Myrtle Beach (CHC).**

**JASIAK'S SHUTDOWN STRETCH:** RHP Jack Jasiak is off to an impressive start to begin his High-A career. The 2022 12<sup>th</sup>-round pick out of South Florida has yet to allow an earned run in his first 9 appearances for Lake County, logging a 0.00 ERA over 18.1 innings during this span. **Jasiak is the only MiLB/MLB pitcher with 18.1+ IP, 2-or-fewer BB, and a 0.00 ERA so far this season.**

**10'S ACROSS THE BOARD:** OF Jonah Advincula has recorded 16 BB, 12 SB, and 10 RBI so far this season. **The 2023 8<sup>th</sup>-round pick out of Washington State is 1 of just 8 Midwest League players with 10+ BB, 10+ SB, and 10+ RBI this year (also Joshua Baez (PEO), Kyle DeBarge (CR), Kendall George (GL), Cristian Hernandez (SB), Carson Roccaforte (QC), Seth Stephenson (WM), and Fenwick Trimble (BEL)).**

**TUGBOAT CRUISE:** After being named a 2024 Midwest League All-Star, LHP Matt Wilkinson continues to fare well for Lake County's pitching staff. The southpaw ranks top-3 in the Midwest League in GS (7, T-1<sup>st</sup>) and K (37, T-3<sup>rd</sup>) this season, while ranking just outside of the top-10 in IP (28.0, 13<sup>th</sup>). **Last year, Wilkinson led MiLB with an average of 13.20 K/9 and a 37.6% strikeout percentage across Lake County and Single-A Lynchburg, while ranking 2<sup>nd</sup> in MiLB with: 174 K, a 1.90 ERA, a .169 opposing AVG, and a 0.91 WHIP.**

**LAKE COUNTY IS BACK:** Lake County has had a strong offensive start so far this year. **Through their first 31 games of the season, the Captains lead the Midwest League and rank T-7<sup>th</sup> in High-A with 27 HR.** The Captains also entered Saturday ranking top-4 in the Midwest League in RBI (139, 3<sup>rd</sup>) and R (149, T-4<sup>th</sup>).

**WELCOME BACK, OMIR!** On Jan. 30, it was announced that Manager Omir Santos would return for his 3<sup>rd</sup> season as Lake County's skipper. **He is now the longest-tenured manager in Captains history, and 1 of just 2 to win a championship for Lake County (Ted Kubiak, 2010).** With a 158-132 (.545) record at the helm, **Santos is 13 victories away from becoming the winningest manager in Captains history.**

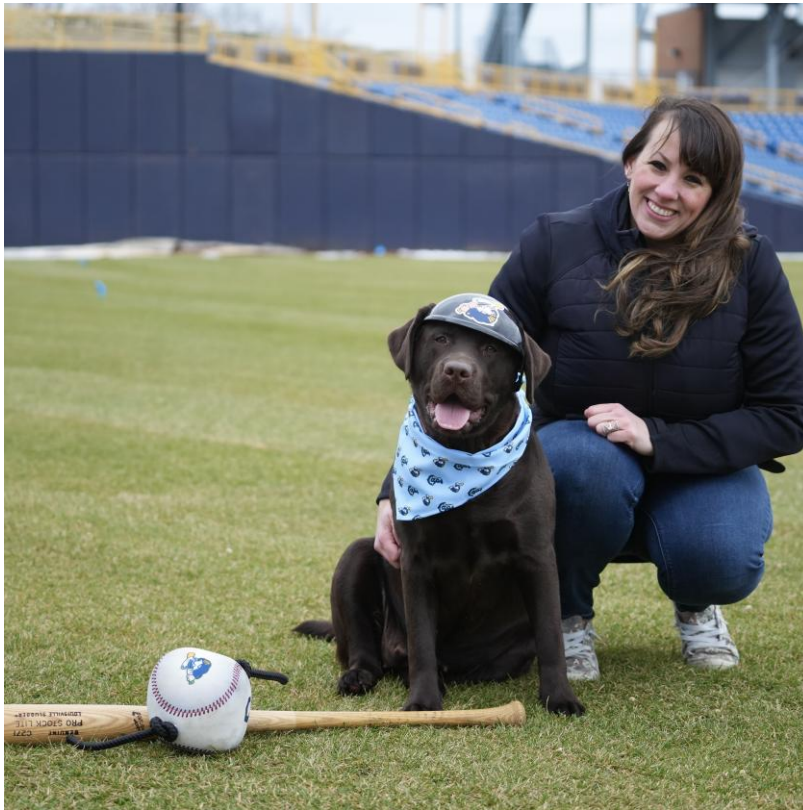




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2025 LAKE COUNTY CAPTAINS BAT DOG: MOKORO

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**Mokoro**, the Lake County Captains' Bat Dog, with her owner and trainer, **Victoria Brody**, of Mission Empawthy, LLC.

### **BIO**

**Mokoro** (wears #43) enters her first season as Lake County's Bat Dog, and first season with the Guardians organization. The 1-year-old Chocolate Labrador Retriever is owned and trained by **Victoria Brody**. **Brody** is a professional dog trainer who started Mission Empawthy, LLC, a local dog training company which focuses on specializing in psychiatric service dogs for those whose disabilities aren't always visible. **Mokoro will retrieve bats and balls for the Captains alongside Brody at all Thursday home games this season!**

**Mokoro** is named after a type of dugout canoe found in Botswana. These vessels, which usually carry 1-2 passengers, are commonly used to navigate the Okavango Delta for both transport and game viewing safaris. While mekoro (plural form of "mokoro") used to primarily be made from Jackalberry, Mangosteen, and Sausage trees, they are now mainly made from fiberglass.

**LAST TIME OUT:** RHP Dylan DeLucia (ND) did not record a decision back on Sunday, May 4 in Lake County's series finale at Lansing. The right-hander pitched 4 scoreless innings in his 3<sup>rd</sup> consecutive outing, allowing just 1 hit and 1 walk, while throwing a season-high 6 strikeouts in 72 pitches (50 strikes). Lake County eventually lost the game 1-0 in 10 innings.

**DYLAN'S SHUTOUT STRETCH:** DeLucia has pitched 12 straight scoreless innings over his last 3 appearances, including a 4-inning save versus Great Lakes back on April 23. The right-hander has recorded 13 strikeouts and a 0.92 WHIP, allowed just 3 hits and 7 walks, and held opposing hitters to a .100 opposing AVG during this span.

**CAPTAIN OF THE WEEK, PART 2:** DeLucia was named Captain of the Week, presented by Official League, on May 5, becoming the 1<sup>st</sup> Captain to receive multiple Captain of the Week awards since its inception last season. The 24-year-old recorded a pair of impressive starts at Lansing on April 29 and May 4, allowing just 2 hits and throwing 9 strikeouts across 8 combined scoreless innings of work. For the week of April 29 through May 4, DeLucia was 1 of just 4 qualified Midwest League pitchers to record a 0.00 ERA. The right-hander also ranked 2<sup>nd</sup> in the league in IP (8.0), opposing AVG (.077), and strikeouts (9, tied), while ranking 9<sup>th</sup> in WHIP (1.00). He was 1 of just 3 Midwest League pitchers to make 2 starts during this span.

**DeLUCIA DELIVERS IN THE PLAYOFFS:** DeLucia was 1 of just 4 pitchers to make 2 starts during the 2024 Midwest League Playoffs. The right-hander pitched a combined 9 innings, allowing 9 hits, 4 runs (3 earned), and 2 walks, while throwing 10 strikeouts, which ranked 2<sup>nd</sup> during the 2024 MWL Playoffs. This includes his start in the winner-take-all Game 3 of the 2024 Midwest League Championship Series, in which he pitched 4.2 scoreless innings in Lake County's eventual 9-4 championship clinching win.

**CAPTAIN OF THE WEEK:** DeLucia was named Captain of the Week, presented by Official League, on Aug. 26, 2024 for his 2 strong starts at West Michigan. In his 2 starts against the Whitecaps on Aug. 20 and Aug. 25, he pitched 9.2 shutout innings, allowing 4 hits and a walk while striking out 8. DeLucia was 1 of 5 Minor League pitchers to make 2 scoreless starts during this span. In his 3 starts from Aug. 13 to Aug. 25, DeLucia recorded a 0.61 ERA, a .122 opposing AVG, and 17 strikeouts.

**RETURN FROM INJURY:** After undergoing Tommy John surgery in June of 2023, DeLucia returned in 2024, making 2 starts for the ACL Guardians and 3 for Single-A Lynchburg. With the ACL Guardians, he made 2 scoreless starts and pitched 5 shutout innings, allowing 3 hits and striking out 3 in his first appearances since the 2022 College World Series at Ole Miss. From July 1 to July 21 with Lynchburg, he posted a 4.15 ERA (4 earned runs) while striking out 10 across 8.2 innings. In his 3 starts for the Hillcats, DeLucia threw 69% of his pitches for strikes.

**OMAHA LEGEND:** DeLucia spent his 3<sup>rd</sup> and final season of college baseball with Ole Miss in 2022, where he led the Rebels to their first College World Series title and won CWS MOP. In the CWS, he pitched went 2-0 with a 0.53 ERA (1 earned run), 17 strikeouts and no walks in 16.2 innings. On June 23 versus Arkansas – his last college start – he pitched a 9-inning, complete game shutout to send Ole Miss to the CWS Finals. DeLucia threw 100+ pitches in each of his last 4 starts in the Super Regionals and College World Series. There are 35 pitchers to win CWS Most Outstanding Player, including 2024 All-Star Game starting pitcher Paul Skenes (LSU, 2023), former Cleveland Guardian and Lake County Captain Adam Plutko (UCLA, 2013) current Athletics manager Mark Kotsay as a two-way (Cal State Fullerton, 1995), and Baseball Hall-of-Famer Dave Winfield as a two-way (Minnesota, 1973).

**HOTTY TODDY:** In 2022 at Ole Miss, DeLucia was named a 3<sup>rd</sup> Team All-American by Baseball America, starting 12 of 21 games in Oxford, MS. The Port Orange, FL native ranked 2<sup>nd</sup> in the SEC in innings pitched (95.1), 2<sup>nd</sup> in strikeouts looking (33), 4<sup>th</sup> in strikeouts (105), and 12<sup>th</sup> in ERA (3.68). In the Coral Gables Regional on June 4, he fanned a career-high 12 batters in a 7-4 win against Arizona. **College Major: Multi-Disciplinary Studies.**

**JUCO BANDIT:** After spending the 2019 fall season at the College of Charleston, DeLucia pitched 2 seasons at Northwest Florida State College in Niceville, FL from 2020-21, where he was 1<sup>st</sup> Team All-Conference and 2<sup>nd</sup> Team All-State. In 23 career appearances and 18 starts, he was 15-2 with a 1.91 ERA, 163 strikeouts and 32 walks across 127 innings. In 2021, he led NJCAA Region 8 with 119 strikeouts and 9 wins. 2 notable NWF alumni are 11-year MLB pitcher and 2005 Lake County Captain Tony Sipp and 11-year MLB outfielder and former Cleveland Indian Jason Michaels.

**LHP Doug Nikhazy:** On Saturday, April 26, LHP **Doug Nikhazy** was promoted to the Cleveland Guardians as the 27<sup>th</sup> man for a home doubleheader versus the Boston Red Sox. The left-hander started Game 2 of the twin bill, suffering the loss in a 7-3 defeat.
