LAST APPEARANCE: 8/4 @ SA...pitched 6.0 shutout innings allowing seven hits while walking two and striking out three...did not receive a decision in a 4-3, 10 inning Wind Surge victory.

APPEARANCE PRIOR: 7/29 vs. NWA...pitched 5.0 innings allowing three runs (one earned) on seven hits, giving up one home run while striking out eight...received the loss in a 3-2 Naturals victory.

TRANSFER WINDOW: On August 9, Louie Varland was transferred from Double-A Wichita to Triple-A St. Paul. While with the Wind Surge Varland was second in ERA (3.34) and strikeouts (119), third in win percentage (.636), innings pitched (105.0), and lowest opponents batting average against (.251), slugging (.387), and OPS (.705), fifth in on base percentage (.318), tied for fifth in wins (7), and games started (19), and seventh in WHIP (1.34).

WHO SAYS YOU CAN'T GO HOME: With the transfer from Double-A to Triple-A, Varland returns home. He becomes the first player from St. Paul to play for the Saints since the team became a Triple-A franchise. Some of the players from the Independent days that were from St. Paul that played for the Saints include Jack Morris, Ryan Schlosser, Tim Thomas (1995), Chris Schwab, Steve Butler, Adam Larson, Brian Whinnery, Zach Peterson, Reid Mahon, Matt Schuld, Joe Bonfe, Jack Goihl, and Jake Esch.

HULKAMANIA: While in high school at North St. Paul High School, Varland was on the wrestling team. He was a two-time MSHSL State Tournament wrestler, two-time MVP, Most Improved, Rookie of the Year, two-time section runner up and four-time captain of

GET ON THE BUS, GUS: Louie's brother, Gus, is 13 months older than him. They played together at North St. Paul High School and Concordia, St. Paul. Gus was selected in the 14th round by the Oakland Athletics in 2018 out of Concordia, St. Paul. Gus was then traded to the Dodgers along with 3B Sheldon Neuse in exchange for LHP Adam Kolarek and RF Cody Thomas on February 12, 2021.

NOT MY BROTHERS KEEPER: - Louie faced off against his brother Gus in 2022 as the Wind Surge took on the Tulsa Drillers on May 6, 2022 in Wichita. It's the first time brothers started against each other in the Minors since at least the 2000s. Louie went 5.0 IP allowed two runs on four hits while walking two and striking out six. His brother went 3.0 IP allowing six runs on eight hits while walking two and striking out two in a 7-2 Wichita victory in game one of a doubleheader.

BROTHERLY LOVE: On June 15, the Wind Surge and Drillers met again in a doubleheader in Wilchita. This time, the brothers pitched opposite ends of the doubleheader and each got a victory. Louie won Game I allowing two runs across 6.0 innings while walking one and striking out four in a 7-4 Wind Surge win. In the second game, Gus pitched 2.0 shutout innings of relief allowing one hit and striking out four in a 4-3 Drillers victory.

NOTHING TO RANT(Z) ABOUT: In 2021, Louie was named the Jim Rantz Minnesota Twins Minor League Pitcher of the Year after going 10-4 with a 2.10 ERA in 20 games (18 starts) between Low-A Fort Myers and High-A Cedar Rapids. In 103.0 innings pitched he fanned 142 while opponents hit .214 against him.

RUNS IN THE FAMILY: While Louie has more than made a name for himself, he might not even be the most athletic person in his family. His Aunt's Denise and Sue were legendary softball pitchers at North St. Paul High School.
