HOMER HAPPY SHUCKERS

The Shuckers enter today with 17 home runs, the 2nd-most in the Southern League and the 6th-most in Double-A... The 16 home runs are the most through 13 games in franchise history (since 2015) and tied for the 8th-most in the Southern League in the Digital Stats Era (since 2005).

- The Shuckers have recorded a home run in 10 of 13 games to begin the season and have hit at least one in 6 of 7 road games.
- 23 of the Shuckers 73 runs (32%) this season have come off home runs.
- The current home run streak of 4 consecutive games is tied for the longest by the Shuckers this season... The franchise record is 17 consecutive games, set between July 7 and July 24, 2018.

WALKING ON SUNSHINE

The Shuckers enter today with 95 walks through 13 games, the most in Double-A... The Shuckers set a season-high on Wednesday with 13, the most in a game since May 6, 2021, at Birmingham, when they set the single-game franchise record with 16.

- The Shuckers 95 walks mark the most by a Double-A team through 13 games since 2005... The next closest Southern League team is the 2026 Knoxville Smokies and the 2018 Tennessee Smokies, with 77.

LIVING LIFE IN THE FAST LANE

SS/2B JESUS MADE recorded his league-leading 3rd triple of the season on Friday... Made is the 5th Double-A player since 2021 to record at least 3 triples through a team's first 13 games... Made is the first Shuckers player to achieve the feat since OF COREY RAY in 2018.

IT'S HARD BEING RIGHT (LITERALLY)

Entering today, the Shuckers bullpen has limited right-handed batters to a .138 average (22-for-159) with a 30% strikeout rate... The .138 average represents the lowest mark in Double-A, and the 2nd-lowest in Minor League Baseball... Standouts include RHP TANNER GILLIS (1-for-25, 10K), LHP MARK MANFREDI SR. (1-for-15, 10K), LHP ANTHONY FLORES (1-for-12, 4k), and RHP STIVEN CRUZ (2-for-22, 6k).

SAVE TONIGHT

RHP SAM GARCIA earned his 2nd save of the season on Tuesday with a perfect 9th inning... Prior to 2026, Garcia recorded 2 career saves between his college and pro career, coming on May 8, 2025, at Kannapolis with Single-A Carolina and March 4, 2022, at the College of Charleston with High Point University.

- Garcia is tied for the Southern League lead with 2 saves and is 1 of 10 Double-A pitchers with at least 2 this season.

MAKING A MARK

LHP MARK MANFREDI SR. struck out 3 in the 8th inning on Thursday, extending his shutout streak to 6.0 consecutive innings, dating back to Friday, April 3... Across 5 appearances, Manfredi has 13 strikeouts in 6.0 innings.

- Entering today, Manfredi's 62% strikeout rate is tied for the highest mark in Double-A (min. 20 PA).

CALLING THE KIDS!

SS/2B JESUS MADE and RHP MANUEL RODRIGUEZ enter 2026 as 2 of the 3 youngest players in the Southern League per *Baseball America*.

- 7 of the 25 youngest Southern League players are on the Shuckers roster, including Made and Rodriguez.

PROSPECT-PALOOZA

The Shuckers have 4 Top 30 prospects on their roster, including 2 Top-100 prospects and 2 Top-10 prospects.

- The 4 are: SS/2B JESUS MADE (No. 1, No. 3 overall), RHP BISHOP LETSON (No. 7, No. 96 overall), RHP TYSON HARDIN (No. 13) and 1B BLAKE BURKE (No. 18).

MADE FOR THE BIG STAGE

SS/2B JESUS MADE enters the 2026 season as the top-ranked Brewers prospect and the 4th-ranked overall prospect by *Baseball America*.

- Made will become baseball's top prospect once Konnor Griffin (45 AB), Kevin McGonigle (71 AB) and JJ Wetherholt (69 AB) all reach 130 AB.

BACK IN THE SADDLE

MANAGER MIKE GUERRERO returns to the Shuckers dugout for 2026 after 2 seasons as a Roving Infield Instructor with the Brewers organization.

- After reaching 1,400 career wins during the 2023 season, Guerrero needs 49 wins to reach 1,500... His 1,451 wins are the sixth-most among active managers in Minor League Baseball.

RHP JARON DEBERRY (1-1, 1.80) makes his 3rd start of the season... Through 2 starts, DeBerry has limited right-handed batters to a .143 average (3-for-21) with 6 strikeouts... DeBerry allowed 2 runs in 11.0 innings with 13 strikeouts against the Clingstones in 2025.
