RANCHO CUCAMONGA QUAKES (15-19, 56-44)

Fresno Grizzlies (20-14, 49-51)

TODAY'S GAME: The Quakes continue a six-game road trip with game five of a six-game set at Chukchansi Park, taking on the Fresno Grizzlies (COL). The Quakes will return home on Tuesday, August 5, as they host the Lake Elsinore Storm as part of a six-game set. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE GRIZZLIES: Today's game is the five of 12 meetings in 2025 and the fifth of six in Fresno. Last year, Rancho went 7-5 against the Grizzlies, 3-3 here at Chukchansi Park in Fresno.

LAST GAME: Jaron Elkins rescued the Quakes on Friday night, as his two-out, three-run homer sent Rancho to a 5-3 win over the Fresno Grizzlies at Chukchansi Park. Leading 3-2 in the ninth, Grizzlies' reliever Nathan Blasick retired the first two hitters before walking back-to-back hitters to bring Elkins to the plate. With the count 1-2, Elkins delivered a no-doubter to left-center for his ninth of the year, putting the Quakes up 5-3. Ryan Brown (2-3), who struck out all three batters he faced in the eighth, fanned the first two before getting a grounder to end the game and earn the win, Rancho's second straight victory over the Grizzlies. Oswaldo Osorio also went deep for Rancho, his second of the year. Elkins finished with two hits and three RBIs, while Emil Morales joined him with two hits.

END OF JULY: Thursday night's game was not only the final game of July, but the Cal League's 99th game, exactly three-quarters of the 2025 season. Rancho's July was under .500 at 11-13, with a batting average of .261 (second in the league) and 18 homers in 24 games. Their team ERA was 5.11 (seventh).

CLEAN SWEEP OF WEEKLY AWARDS: The Quakes pulled off their second weekly award sweep of the season. as on Monday, Jaron Elkins (second time) was named Cal League Player of the Week, while Sterling Patick (second time) was named the Cal League Pitcher of the Week. Elkins went 10-for-28 with a grand slam and ten RBIs over six games. He also stole three bases and had an OPS of 1.043. Patick fired six no-hit innings, striking out seven in a win over Visalia. The Quakes have no taken home a total of nine Cal League Weekly Awards in 2025, with Elkins, Patick and Eduardo Quintero all winning two each.

TRADE DEADLINE RECAP: Rancho made it through the deadline without any active players getting traded, but a pair of former Quakes minor leaguers were on the move on Thursday. An hour before the deadline, the Dodgers traded a couple of current High-A Great Lakes pitchers, with RHP Sean Paul Linan and RHP Eriq Swan to the Washington Nationals for OF Alex Call. The Dodgers also brought back former Quake Brock Stewart in a trade with Minnesota. **QUINTERO MOVES ON:** OF Eduardo Quintero is this year's likely Cal League MVP. After being promoted last week to High-A Great Lakes, he leaves Rancho second in the league in hitting (.306) and walks (65), first in homers (14), fourth in hits (97) and OBP (.426), first in slugging (.533) and OPS (.959) and third in stolen bases. MLB Pipeline rates him as the Dodgers' fourth-best prospect. Great Lakes, at least for the moment, now has five outfielders on their current roster who are in MLB Pipeline's Top 11 Dodgers' prospects: Josue De Paula (#1), Zyhir Hope (#2), Quintero (#4), Mike Sirota (#5) and Kendall George (#11).

LOGAN TABELING: 23-year-old right-hander Logan Tabeling makes his 21st overall appearance and 11th start, his first against the Grizzlies. In his last outing overall, he allowed four runs (one earned) on six hits over four innings in a loss vs Visalia on July 27. The undrafted free agent out of Illinois signed with the Dodgers in July of 2024.

MANUEL OLIVARES: 23-year-old right-hander Manuel Olivares makes his Fresno debut for the Grizzlies, after being called up this week from the Arizona Complex League. For the ACL Rockies this year, he's made 15 appearances (four starts), going 4-3 with a 4.31 ERA over 48 IP. Olivares signed with Colorado in July of 2018 out of Venezuela. **BROADCAST HOME:** Catch all the 2025 action with the "Voice of the Quakes" Mike Lindskog from the ease of your phone, smart device or computer.
