MOLLER, WALCOTT HOMER, RIDERS EDGED BY HOOKS:

The Frisco RoughRiders fell short to the Corpus Christi Hooks 6-4 on Saturday night from Riders Field. Corpus Christi (12-26) struck first when Austin Deming lined an RBI double in the top of the second. Then in the top of the third, Pascanel Ferreras homered and Ryan Wrobleksi singled in Bryan Lavastida, propelling the Hooks to a 3-0 lead. Riders (22-16) starter **Mitch Bratt** then retired his final six batters to finish with two earned runs allowed and eight strikeouts across five innings. Frisco cut the lead in the top of the fifth when **Ian Moller** bashed a two-run home run, putting the Riders down 3-2. Then in the bottom of the sixth, **Sebastian Walcott** hammered a go-ahead, two-run blast in the bottom of the sixth to grab a 4-3 lead. In the top of the seventh Corpus Christi's Zach Cole ripped an RBI double to tie the game at four. The Hooks then took the lead in the top of the eighth when John Garcia rolled a two-run single to capture a 6-4 advantage. In the bottom of the ninth, the RoughRiders put runners on first and second for **Abimelec Ortiz**, who had hit two home runs in the ninth inning this week. Hooks reliever Wilmy Sanchez (1-1) then induced an Ortiz flyout and fanned Walcott to earn the victory. Riders reliever **Gavin Collyer** (3-2) picked up the loss, allowing Garcia's go-ahead single.

HISTORIC OFFENSIVE DAYS:

When the RoughRiders fell to the Hooks 20-14 on Tuesday, they allowed 20 or more runs for the fourth time in franchise history and the first time since 5/1/18 vs. San Antonio (20-4 loss). In that game, **Fernando Tatis Jr.**, **Josh Naylor** and **Ty France** all homered for the Missions. The 34 runs were the most combined runs in franchise history and their second time losing while scoring 14 or more runs. It was their first time since 5/16/15 versus Corpus Christi (15-14 loss). The first two games of the series combined for 55 runs.

ABIM-ELECTRIC ORTIZ:

Abimelec Ortiz has been on fire at the plate for the Riders. While having reached in his last nine games, Ortiz is hitting .444 (16-for-36)/.535/.806/1.341 with four doubles, three home runs and 13 RBIs. On Wednesday, he clubbed the first walk-off grand slam in franchise history while driving in six runs. His six RBIs were the most in a game since 2022 (**Josh Stowers**). On Friday, he hammered a game-tying home run in the bottom of the ninth before the Riders eventually won 6-5 in 11 innings on a **Josh Hatcher** RBI single. He is fifth in the Texas League in May average (.353), second in RBIs (16), tied for second in home runs (four) and third in OPS (1.108). For his efforts and three home runs, Ortiz was named Texas League Player of the Week.

MAY FLOWERS AND HOMERS:

The RoughRiders have both hit and given up their fair share of long balls this month. They have hit 14 this month, which is seventh in the league and have allowed 19, which is the most. Corpus Christi has both hit the most (20) and allowed the second-most (18) in the Texas League this month.

NO-HITTER NOTES:

The RoughRiders completed their sixth no-hitter in franchise history on Wednesday. It was the third nine-inning no-hitter in franchise history, the first no-hitter since **Joe Wieland** no-hit San Antonio on July 29th, 2011 at Wolff Stadium and the fourth no-hitter against San Antonio in franchise history. It was also the third combined no-hitter in franchise history and first since **Neftali Feliz** and **Trey Hodges** no-hit San Antonio in six innings on August 19th, 2008 at Wolff Stadium.

DOUBLE-A DOUBL-A RON:

Aaron Zavala has been on fire at the plate for the Riders. After a dreadful start, batting just .077 (2-for-26) through 10 games, he is hitting .318 (21-for-66)/.465/.545/1.010 over his last 20 games. He leads the Texas League in walks (32) and is second in OBP (.438) while leading the league in walk rate (25.0 percent), a mark which also ranks fourth in Minor League Baseball (min. 100 PA). He is currently on an 12-game on-base streak, batting .381 (16-for-42)/.527/.595/1.122 with 15 runs scored, a double, a triple, two home runs, 10 RBIs and 13 walks. During the streak, he has reached multiple times in nine of the 12 games. In May, he is hitting .348/.492/.543/1.035, ranking eighth in average and seventh in OPS in the Texas League.

HOUND HUNTING:

The Riders struggled against the Midland RockHounds a season ago. On top of being knocked out the postseason by Midland last year, they went just 6-12 during the regular season against the A's affiliate. Frisco was held to a .219/.291/.305/.596 slashline against the RockHounds.

BRATT SUMMER IS BACK:

Mitch Bratt has been one of the stronger arms for Frisco to start the year. Through his first seven starts, his 2.21 ERA is second in the Texas League. His 4.1 percent walk rate is the best in the Texas League while 7.83 K/BB is also first.

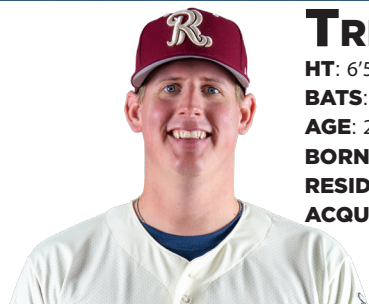

ABOUT TREY

-Pronounced SHOE-pock. Full name is Treyson Thomas Supak. Was named Treyson because he was the third child and "trey" stood for "three".

-Born in Bryan, Texas, but grew up in La Grange, Texas (La Grange didn't have a hospital). At La Grange High School, he starred in football, basketball and baseball and became the first player drafted from LGHS since **Homer Bailey** in 2004.

-Committed to University of Houston before signing with Pittsburgh. His uncle Jody was an All-American at Houston and was drafted by Detroit in 1987.

-Was drafted by the Pirates in the CB-B round of 2014.

2025 SEASON

-Allowed just three run through first three 5.0-inning starts.

-Made spot start with Triple-A Round Rock on May 3rd, allowing just two runs over five innings while striking out four and walking one.

2024 SEASON

-Spent time between Double-A Tennessee and Triple-A Iowa.

2023 SEASON

-Split time between Double-A Midland and Triple-A Las Vegas. Against Frisco in 2023, he made three appearances out of the bullpen (3.1 IP, 5 H, 4 R, 2 ER, 3 BB, 3 K), allowing a home run to Dustin Harris.

2021-2022 SEASON

-After electing free agency in Nov. of 2020, signed with the A's organization 18 days later.

-Missed the entire season and most of 2022 with "Tommy John" Surgery. Returned to make three starts with Midland that season.

2020 SEASON

-Was called up from the Taxi Squad to the MLB roster in 2020 for three days and was sent back down without making an appearance.

2019 SEASON

-Finished the season as the No. 11 prospect in the Brewers organization by MLB.com.

-When he made his Triple-A debut with San Antonio, it was 1.5 hours from hometown, so he had 40-50 friends and family there. "I have never had a feeling like that heading out to the mound."

-With Double-A Biloxi, won Southern League Most Outstanding Pitcher after leading the league in ERA (2.20), opponent batting average (.192) and tying for the lead in wins (11).

2014-2018 SEASON

-In December of 2015, he was traded to Milwaukee from Pittsburgh along with Keon Broxton in exchange for Jason Rogers.
