YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels tied a franchise record with their seventh straight win, beating the Harrisburg Senators, 4-1, at FNB Field. Frankie Tostado brought home the game's first run in the first inning with an RBI groundout. Andres Angulo hit an RBI double in the fourth inning and Shane Matheny added an RBI single in the sixth to open the lead to $3-0$. Starter Sean Hjelle
did not allow a run in his first five innings before Jackson Cluff got Harrisburg on the board with a solo homer in the bottom of the sixth. The Flying Squirrels added a run in the top of the ninth when Kyle Mottice scored after a throwing error. Reliever Luis Amaya, Frank Rubio, Raffi Vizcaino and Norwith Gudino combined for 3.2 scoreless innings to finish the game.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels continue the first road series of 2021, facing off against the Harrisburg Senators, Dou-ble-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals, at FNB Field on City Island in the third of six games. This series marks the Flying Squirrels' Ione trip to Pennsylvania's capital city this season. The Senators come to Richmond for a six-game series from June
8-13. The Flying Squirrels enter the series riding a five-game winning streak.

GOING STREAKING: The Flying Squirrels have won seven straight games, tying the franchise record for the longest winning streak. The team previously won seven consecutive games from April 27-May 3, 2010 and June 20-26, 2014. In the franchise's 2014, the Flying Squirrels had their seven-game win streak snapped with an $8-3$ loss to the Trenton Thunder on June 3 , but followed with another five-game win streak to total 12 wins in 13 games from May 27-June 8 . The Flying Squirrels' seven-game win streak is tied for the second-longest in the minors with Down East of the Low-A East, trailing only the eight-game win streak for Lynchburg, also of the Low-A East
STRONG START: The Flying Squirrels' $7-1$ record through the first eight games of the season is the best start in the franchise's history. The previous best start through eight games was a $5-3$ record, which was set during the 2018 and 2019 seasons. The history. Flying Squirrels' best record in team history through nine games is $6-3$, which was also set during the 2018 and 2019 seasons.

BEST OF THE BEST: At 7-1, the Flying Squirrels hold the third-best record in all of the minors. Two teams, Lynchburg (Low-A East) and Down East (Low-A East) are still unbeaten. There are four other teams in the minors with one loss. Akron of the Dou-ble-A Northeast is 6-1. Reno, Round Rock and Sugar Land, all of the Triple-A West, are 5-1.
THE FLYING SQUIRRELS sit in first place in the Double-A Northeast Southwest Division, a half-game ahead of Akron. The Fly ing Squirrels finished the 2019 season with a 55-84 record, the worst in the franchise's history, and finished in last place in the Eastern League's Western Division for the second consecutive year. Seven players from the 2019 team are back in Richmond to start the 2021 season, including Jacob Heyward, Sean Hjelle, Ryan Howard, Peter Maris, Heliot Ramos, Frank Rubio and Outfielder Vince Fernandez played in the Eastern League with Hartford in 2019.

THE SENATORS have lost five consecutive games entering play tonight by a combined score of 27-11. Harrisburg's five-game losing streak is tied for the longest active losing slide in the minors. The Senators are batting .131 as a team, which is the sec-ond-worst team average of the 120 teams in the minors. The Harrisburg roster includes 10 players who appeared in a game for the team prior to this season. There are six of Baseball America's top-30 Nationals prospects on the Senators' roster, including LHP Tim Cate (8), INF Drew Mendoza (11), INF Jackson Cluff (12), C Jakson Reetz (25), OF Nick Banks (29) and RHP Sterling Sharpe (29). In 2019, the Senators went 76-63, finishing in second place in the Eastern League Western Division, before falling

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Matt Frisbee makes his second Double-A start. In his debut last Saturday in the first game of a double-header against Hartford, Frisbee threw 5.0 scoreless innings in a combined shutout with Patrick Ruotolo. Dating back to August 25, 2019 with High-A San Jose of the California League, Frisbee has not allowed a run in 14.2 consecutive innings. He
spent most of the 2019 season with San Jose, going $9-8$ with a 3.17 ERA in 22 outings ( 20 starts). He went $4-2$ with a 1.91 ERA in his last 10 appearances ( 56.2 IP ) of the season while picking up 60 strikeouts. Following the season, Frisbee was named a Giants Organizational All-Star by MiLB.com. He was drafted by the Giants in the 15th round in 2018 out of UNC Greensboro. For more on Frisbee, see page two
FOR HARRISBURG: Right-hander Sterling Sharp makes his second start of the season. In his first start of the season last Friday at Somerset, Sharp allowed eight runs (three earned) over 2.2 innings in a loss. This season is Sharp's third pitching with the Senators dating back to 2018. Sharp was selected by the Marlins in the Rule 5 Draft in 2019 and debuted in the majors with surgery in the offseason before returning to throwing this spring. Sharp missed three months in 2019 an oblique injury, limiting him to nine starts with Harrisburg, in which he went 5-3 with a 3.99 ERA. In 2018, Sharp made joined the Senators for the second half of the season and went 6-3 with a 4.33 ERA in 13 starts. Sharp was selected by the Nationals in the 22nd round of the 2016 MLB Draft out of NCAA Division II Drury in Missouri.
PLAY THE HITS: The Flying Squirrels are batting . 292 as a team, which is first in the Double-A Northeast and second overall in Double-A. The team is also ranked third in runs (45) in the Double-A Northeast, second in hits (75), third in total bases (116), fourth in doubles (16), fourth in RBIs (39), fourth in stolon bases (8) fourth in SLG (451) and fourth in OPS (802)

RIGHT OFF THE BAT: 2019 Eastern League All-Star Jacob Heyward made his season debut on Tuesday night at Harrisburg In his first plate appearance of the season in the first inning, he launched a solo home run. He added an RBI double that hit the left-field wall on the fly in his second plate appearance. On Wednesday, he entered as a pinch-hitter and went 1-for-2. In 2019,
Heyward set the Flying Squirrels' single-season record for walks with 80, which surpassed the previous record of 62 set by Mark Minicozzi during the 2013 season.
RAMOS RAKING: Heliot Ramos has picked up a hit in all seven games he has played this year. Dating back to August 28, 2019, Ramos is currently on a 13 -game hitting streak, during which he is batting . 373 (19-for- 51 ) with five doubles, one triple, three home runs and nine RBIs. Ramos is also on a 15 -game on-base streak with the Flying Squirrels dating back to August 26, 2019. third in SLG (.800), fourth in OPS (1.300), tied for third in hits (10), tied for third in doubles (4), tied for first in extra-base hits (6) fourth in total bases (20), tied for first in runs scored (9) and tied for first in stolen bases (3).

POWER SURGE: David Villar has homered three times in the first eight games of the 2021 season, which is tied for third in the league. He hit 13 home runs in 2018 in short-season with Salem-Keizer and clubbed 13 home runs again in 2019 with A-Adv. San Jose. Viliar is also ranked tied for fourth in the league in RBls (8), tied for third in extra-base hits (5) and tied for sixth in total bases (18).
WELCOME BACK, AUGGIE: José Alguacil returns to manage the Flying Squirrels after leading the team to a 72-68 record in 2015, the most recent season the team has posted a winning record. Alguacil is in his 15th overall season with the Giants orymation and worked at the Alternate Training Site in 2020. He previously served as the first base coach and oversaw major league staff.

ALL OVER THE MAP: The Flying Squirrels roster contains 18 players from 11 different states across the United States: California (4), Georgia (4), Florida (2) and one player from North Carolina, Minnesota, Illinois, Massachusetts, New York, Missouri, Washing ton and Ohio. Nine players grew up in four countries and territories outside of the 50 states, including the Dominican Republic (4), Puerto Rico (2) Venezuela (2) and Colombia (1)

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have three players included in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects: Heliot Ramos (3), Tristan Beck (12) and Sean Hjelle (13). Ramos is also rated by Baseball Ame
