YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the Rumble Ponies, 11-0. Binghamton scored single runs in the second, third and fourth innings before three runs in the fifth, one in the sixth and four in the eighth. Diego Velasquez had two hits for the Flying Squirrels. Will Bednar pitched a scoreless seventh inning and struck out two.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the fourth of a six-game series against the Binghamton Rumble Ponies, Double-A affiliate of the New York Mets. This is the last series between these two teams this year. Richmond went 1-5 in Binghamton from May 20-25.

PACKING THE HOUSE: Last year, the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A teams in average (6,595) and total (435,295) attendance. Among the 120 MiLB teams, the Flying Squirrels were 10th in average attendance. It was the third straight year the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A clubs in average and total attendance, which had not been done prior to 2022. Last year's total attendance is the highest since 2013 (434,769) and the fourth-highest average in team history. April 4 marked the 15th consecutive Opening Night sellout, marking every home opener in franchise history to date. This year, the Flying Squirrels are averaging 6,786 fans per home game, which ranks third among all 120 MiLB clubs. Their average of 7,290 in the season's first month was the highest April attendance in franchise history.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS are 6-16 in their last 22 games but have gone 3-2 in their last five games since Friday. They lost four-of-six on the road last week in Erie and in their last home series against the Senators. Of Richmond's 41 losses this season, 22 of them have been by two runs or less (14 by one, eight by two). The Richmond offense is 11th in the Eastern League in runs scored (194). Richmond's pitching staff has a league-high 4.78 ERA.

THE RUMBLE PONIES are in first place in the Northeast Division, 8.5 games ahead of second-place Hartford with 10 games remaining in the first half. Since May 17, Binghamton is 19-3 in its last 22 games, including a 12-game win streak from May 24-June 5. Two of the three losses in that stretch are against Richmond. Binghamton's roster features six players ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Mets prospects list, including SS **Jett Williams** (No. 1), RHP **Jonah Tong** (No. 3), 1B **Ryan Clifford** (No. 9), OF **Nick Morabito** (No. 12), RHP **Jonathan Pintaro** (No. 25) and RHP **Jack Wenninger** (No. 26). MLB.com's top-30 Mets prospects list features six Binghamton players, including Williams (No. 1), Tong (No. 4), Clifford (No. 5), Morabito (No. 17), Pintaro (No. 23), and Wenninger (No. 28).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **Seth Lonsway** makes his 12th start of the season and the fourth of his career against the Rumble Ponies. He last pitched on Saturday at Erie and allowed three runs over five innings with six strikeouts in a loss. Earlier this season, he made a start in Binghamton on May 20 and threw 5.2 scoreless innings, striking out six. He also started the finale of that road trip in Binghamton on May 25 and allowed four runs over 5.1 innings in a loss. For the season, Lonsway is ranked sixth in the Eastern League in innings pitched (55.1) and 10th in ERA (3.42). Since joining the team last summer, Lonsway has not allowed an earned run nine-of-17 Double-A outings, including four-of-11 starts in 2025. Lonsway was selected by the Giants in the sixth round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Ohio State. **For more on Lonsway, see page two.**

FOR BINGHAMTON: Right-hander Jonathan Pintaro makes his 10th start of the season and his second against the Flying Squirrels. In his last start on Saturday against the Patriots, he threw four scoreless innings with five strikeouts. His previous start was against the Flying Squirrels in Binghamton on May 21 and allowed two runs over five innings with five strikeouts. He pitched five seasons at NCAA DII Shorter before signing with the independent Glacier Range Riders of the Pioneer League in Montana. Pintaro pitched for the Scottsdale Scorpions of the Arizona Fall League last year under manager **Dennis Pelfrey**.

DON'T RUN ON RICHMOND: The Flying Squirrels' catching unit of **Adrián Sugastey** and **Zach Morgan** have combined to catch 31 stolen base attempts this season, which is second among the 30 Double-A teams and leads the Eastern League. Sugastey is second among Double-A catchers with 19 runners caught stealing, which is tied for first in the EL. Morgan, now with Triple-A Sacramento, is fourth in the Eastern League with 12.

BERI'S BACK: Outfielder/first baseman **Victor Bericoto** returned to the Richmond roster on June 3. He was placed on the injured list with Triple-A Sacramento on May 9 and played six games with the ACL Giants on a rehab assignment before returning to the Flying Squirrels. Bericoto opened the season with Richmond and hits .319 with three homers, four doubles and eight RBIs in 13 games before being promoted to the River Cats on April 20. In his Richmond career dating back to 2023, Bericoto has homered 25 times, which is tied with **Frankie Tostado** for the eighth-most in franchise history, two behind a four-way tie for fourth place.

TAKING THE JAIRO: **Jairo Pomares** has picked up at least one hit in eight-of-his-last-10 games dating back to May 29, batting .368 (14-for-38) with two homers, two doubles, six RBIs and three walks, raising his season batting average from .185 to .220. That stretch includes five multi-hit games. He hit a solo homer last Wednesday, his first since May 2, snapping a 25-game homerless streak. He went deep again on Sunday, one of three hits in the game, and drove in three.

YO ADRIAN: **Adrian Sugastey** has picked up seven RBIs over his last four games dating back to Sunday. In the series finale at Erie on Sunday afternoon, he went 3-for-5 with a homer, two doubles and a career-best five RBIs. On Tuesday, he drove in the Flying Squirrels' only run with a single. In Wednesday's win, he belted his sixth homer of the year, a solo shot in the fourth, to set a new single-season career high.

NIGHT AT THE ROXBY: Reliever **Braxton Roxby** closed his second save of the season on Wednesday night, recording two outs in the eighth to strand two inherited baserunners before a 1-2-3 ninth. Dating back to April 29, Roxby has pitched 11 consecutive games without allowing an earned run, spanning 15 innings with 18 strikeouts and four walks. The only two runs he has surrendered in that stretch were a pair of unearned runs in the 10th inning on May 27 against the Senators. He has also held opponents hitless in his last two outings since June 6, spanning 4.2 innings.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, **Diego Velasquez** is tied for fifth in hits (57) and ranks 10th in OBP (.368). **Seth Lonsway** is sixth in innings pitched (55.1) and 10th in ERA (3.42). **Jack Choate** is fifth in strikeouts (65) and 10th in BAA (.236). **Joe Whitman** is ninth in strikeouts (56). **John Michael Bertrand** is fourth in innings pitched (60.2).

TOP SKIPPER: Flying Squirrels manager **Dennis Pelfrey** has led the team to 221 wins in his career, which is a new franchise record all-time wins record for a manager. He passed the record with Richmond's 6-1 win at Binghamton on May 23. From 2011-2013, **Dave Machemer** won 216 games as Richmond's manager, leading the team to the Eastern League postseason for in 2011. Pelfrey, who has been with Richmond since the 2022 season, led the team to back-to-back postseason appearances for the first time in franchise history in 2022 and 2023. He also managed the 2021 Eugene Emeralds to the High-A West championship.

PROSPECT WATCH: Richmond's roster features five players are ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including **Joe Whitman** (No. 5), **Diego Velasquez** (No. 10), **Sabin Ceballos** (No. 21) and **Jack Choate** (No. 26). **John Michael Bertrand** is rated as having the best control in the Giants system. **Adrian Sugastey** is ranked as the top defensive catcher. **Aeverso Arteaga** is rated as the best defensive infielder and best infield arm. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features five Richmond players, including Whitman (No. 7), Velasquez (No. 15), Arteaga (No. 16), Ceballos (No. 23) and Choate (No. 27).

THIS DATE IN RICHMOND BASEBALL HISTORY

1967: The Richmond Braves beat the Columbus Jets, 5-0, at Parker Field. Ron Reed threw a seven-hit shutout, his third shutout of the season. He was in his third professional season and had made a brief appearance in the majors the previous year, starting a 19-year major league career with the Braves, Phillies, White Sox and Cardinals. He was a National League All-Star in 1968. Tommie Aaron drove in four of the five Richmond runs. **1969:** The Atlanta Braves assigned 19-year-old Dusty Baker to Richmond. He had been called up to the majors 10 days before from Double-A Shreveport after an injury sideline Felipe Alou and he had gone 0-for-7 over four games. Baker had previously been in Richmond with Atlanta as part of an exhibition game on June 5 at Parker Field, when he went 3-for-4. When Baker arrived for his assignment to the R-Braves, he was supposed to start as the R-Braves' center fielder, but was sent back to the hotel with a 102-degree fever. He finally joined the team in uniform after three days of bedrest. He made his R-Braves debut on June 17 and went 2-for-4 in the first game of a doubleheader against Louisville, starting in center field before moving in to play third base for the first time in his career. **1994:** The Richmond Braves beat the Toledo Mud Hens, 7-3, at The Diamond. Brad Wood-all pitched a complete game and did not allow an earned run. It was his second consecutive nine-inning complete game and he improved his record to 8-3. Luis Lopez Jose Oliva both homered and drove in two runs. Mike Mordecai had two hits and an RBI. **2003:** The Richmond Braves beat the Buffalo Bisons, 6-5, at The Diamond. Adam LaRoche, playing his second Triple-A game, hit a two-run homer in the first inning and scored the winning run in the eighth on a two-out single by Wilson Betemit. **2012:** The Flying Squirrels beat the New Hampshire Fisher Cats, 6-5, at The Diamond in 11 innings. Trailing entering the eighth, Ryan Cavan tied the score with a two-run homer and Tommy Joseph gave Richmond a 3-2 lead with an RBI single. The Fisher Cats tied the game in the ninth to force extras and took a 5-3 lead in the top of the 11th. In the bottom of the 11th, Ehire Adrianza and Gary Brown brought in runs to tie the game and Juan Ciriaco hit a walk-off single.
