TODAY'S GAME / OPPOSING STARTER: The Curve play their second and final series of the season with the Portland Sea Dogs. Altoona is 5-6 against the Dogs this season.

Jack Anderson takes the ball today for Portland. Anderson was a minor league rule V pick out of Detroit's system this past off-season. Anderson had not pitched at Double-A before this season, though he did make a handful of appearances at Triple-A Toledo last year. Anderson throws from a three-quarters arm slot. High leg kick. Relies primarily on an 89-92 mph fastball and an 80-84 mph slider. Will also mix in a split changeup in the low-to-mid 80s sparingly. Throws strikes but gives up a lot of hard contact.

EZZY: Outfielder Esmerlyn Valdez has put together back-to-back strong performances to start Altoona's series at Portland. After recording a multi-RBI game in the series opener, Valdez picked up 3 hits in Altoona's 6-2 win over the Sea Dogs on July 30th. In his last 7 games, he is 8-for-26 with 4 RBI and 3 walks (.802 OPS).

MY VALENTIN: Righty Valentin Linarez has turned in one of the best seasons of his professional career in 2025. In addition to holding opponents to a career-low .196 BAA this season and a 1.18 WHIP, since June 10 he's allowed just 3 runs in 18.1 IP (1.45 ERA) and a 0.86 WHIP with 20 strikeouts.

JUSTIN'S MEIS: Since recording a 4.91 ERA in the month of May, Justin Meis has gone 2-2 with a 1.93 ERA with two saves in 15 games for the Curve. In that time he's recorded a 0.86 WHIP and walked just 4 batters in 23.1 innings with 26 strikeouts.

WHERE ARE THE BATS: Altoona holds a .195 team batting average in the Second Half (Since June 23) the lowest among 120 full-season clubs, the team also ranks 117th in OPS (.586).

Pitching has been the team's savior of late. Altoona pitchers rank 5th among 120 minor league clubs in WHIP (1.13).

KELLY K'S: Righty Antwone Kelly struck out a career-high 9 batters in 4.2 innings on July 10 at Binghamton. The 21-year-old has struck out 28 batters in 25.1 innings to start July, <u>he holds a 0.99 WHIP which ranks T-7th among qualified minor league pitchers</u>. Kelly's 101 strikeouts this season are 2nd-most in the Pirates minor league system (**Bubba Chandler**, 106), tied with teammate Wilber Dotel (101).

CLOSE WINS: 16 of Altoona's last 20 wins (since June 18) have all come in a save situation for the bullpen. 49 of the team's 100 games this year (50%) have been decided by two runs or fewer.

THE NEW GUYS WHO THROW HARD: Righty Ryan Harbin had the 4th-longest scoreless streak in the minors this season end on July 9 at Binghamton. From May 13 - July 9, Harbin went 2-0 in 22.1 IP, 10 H, 13 BB, 37 K (.137 BAA), before allowing a run on July 9. <u>Harbin has struck out 25 batters in 15.2 innings with Altoona. Harbin ranks 8th in the Pirates system in strikeouts</u> (71) in 46.0 innings, every other pitcher in the top 14 in the system in strikeouts has throwin at least 60.0 IP.

Righty Brandon Bidois tossed 11.1 scoreless innings to begin his Curve career before allowing two unearned runs on July 19 against Akron. The Austrailian native has been unscored upon in 21-of-25 outings this season, going 1.0+ IP in 16 of his 25 outings, totaling 41 strikeouts in 37.1 innings this year.

CY YOUNG?: Lefty Cy Nielson has struck out 50 batters this season, 6th-most by an Eastern League reliever. Nielson has collected at least one strike out in 39-of-40 career outings with the Curve, racking up 82 in 65.1 IP.

ITALIANISSIMO: Righty Alessandro Ercolani has dialed in throughout his first trip through the Eastern League. In 11 of his 19 outings this season, he's allowed 1 run or fewer. Held under an innings count this year, Ercolani is working on the best walk rate of his career, walking only 26 in 74.2 IP. His 2.83 BB/9 innings is the best mark of his career.

WE'LL SEE THEM ALL: For the first time since the 2019 season and the creation of the six-game series, the Curve will face every team in the Eastern League this season. Altoona will face New Hampshire and Binghamton on the road only, while Hartford and Reading will only play the Curve at PNG Field.

Andy Fox is the 16th manager in Curve history. Fox's coaching ca-reer has seen him serve in several roles, including time with the Rang-ers, Mariners, Marlins, and Red Sox. He spent the last 14 years in Boston's system, serving as the team's infield coordinator and first base coach. Prior to his time in Boston, Fox served as a first base coach for the Marlins and managed the Rangers Single-A Clinton team in 2006. Fox was drafted in the 2nd round of the 1989 Draft by the Yankees and won two World Series in his nineyear Major League career with New York (1996) and the Florida Marlins (2003) as an infielder.

Matt Ford Pitching Coach 1st season/12th overall

Ford joins the Curve in 2025 after serving as the Pitching Coach for Low-A Bradenton in 2024. This is his 12th season serving as an in-structor in the Pirates system, pre-viously serving in the FCL (2022), Greensboro (2021), as the team's Rehab Pitching Coordinator (2019-20), Bradenton (2017-18), both West Virginia clubs (2015-2016) as well as with Bristol (2014). 
