INDY BITS

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: With runners at the corners and two outs in the bottom of the ninth, Gilberto Celestino rocketed the eighth pitch of his at-bat into the right-center gap for a double to score Canaan Smith-Njigba and Jake Lamb, giving the Indianapolis Indians a thrilling 4-3 win over the Columbus Clippers on Saturday night at Victory Field. Lamb gave the Indians the early lead with a two-run single off Xzavion Curry in the opening frame, but the right-hander silenced Indy's bats over the next six innings. Columbus rallied behind its starter, recording a run in three consecutive innings. After collecting just three hits through the first eight innings, Indianapolis came alive in the ninth for its third walk-off win of the season. Smith-Njigba worked a leadoff walk and took second on a single by Liover Peguero. Lamb then blooped a fly ball into shallow left, but Peguero was forced out at second on the play for the first out. Following a Gorski infield popout, Celestino fouled off two 3-2 pitches before winning the battle against Anthony Gose.

WALK IT OFF: The Indians recorded their third walk-off victory behind a comeback effort from the top half of the order. With two outs, a full count and runners at the corners, Gilberto Celestino roped a double into the right-center gap. Lamb was off with the pitch and slid into home safely as the game-winning run. The Indians first two walk-off wins came via a Carter Bins RBI single in a scoreless game on April 17 vs. St. Paul to score Celestino and a Yasmani Grandal RBI single in the 11th inning on April 30 to defeat Buffalo. Celestino's walk-off double last night was the Indians' first since Erich Weiss plated a pair with a ninth-inning two-bagger on May 3, 2018, vs. Gwinnett.

TIME TO CELLY: Gilberto Celestino continued his hot streak as of late, following up a go-ahead solo home run in the bottom of the fifth inning on Friday with a walk-off double to give the Indians the win last night. He went 2-for-4 for his second multi-hit game in as many days and his third with an RBI in four June games. Since May 19, he is hitting .333 (15-for-45) with eight runs, two doubles, two home runs, seven RBI, seven walks and a .934 OPS. He paired his home run on Friday with a stellar double play, snagging a fly ball near the left-field line and throwing across his body in the Indianapolis bullpen to nab Myles Straw at first base. It was his fourth outfield assist, third from left field and first to turn a double play.

LAMB CHOPS: Jake Lamb got the Indians offense started last night, roping a two-run single after back-to-back leadoff walks in the bottom of the first inning. He also helped cap the winning effort, hustling around to score the game-winning run from first base on Celestino's two-run, walk-off double. He went 2-for-4. logging his second multi-hit and multi-RBI performance in a row this week. Lamb has reached base in 45 of 49 games with a .320 batting average (57-for-178), the fifth-best mark in the International League this season. He has now hit safely in his last four games (6-for-16) after not reaching base safely in consecutive games vs. Omaha for the first time this season.

THE PEN PERFORMED: Isaac Mattson, Ryder Ryan and Connor Sadzeck combined for a stellar performance from the Indians bullpen last night, tossing 5.0 innings of shutout ball in relief of starter Drake Fellows. Mattson led the charge with four strikeouts, while Sadzeck finished the game off and stranded two runners on in the top of the ninth inning to earn the win. The latter has been an effective reliever for the Indians this homestand, allowing just one run in 8.0 innings across his last five appearances.

PEGUERO RETURNS: Liover Peguero returned to the Indians starting lineup last night after being optioned by Pittsburgh on Friday. In his first contest back in Triple-A, he went 1-for-3 with his lone hit extending the Indians ninth-inning comeback effort after Canaan Smith-Njigba reached safely via walk. Peguero began the season with Indianapolis and has hit .273 (53-for-194) with 32 runs, 12 doubles, two triples, two home runs and 34 RBI in 52 games

TEAM STATS: As a team, the Indians lead the International League with a .268 batting average (529-for-1972) and 30 sacrifice flies. They also rank among top-10 team leaders in triples (2nd, 16), hits (6th), doubles (8th, 110), on-base percentage (9th, .351), OPS (T-10th, .775).

TODAY: The Indians continue their 13-game homestand with the finale of a six-game set vs. the Columbus Clippers, Triple-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians, today at 1:35 PM ET at Victory Field. The Indians went 1-6 against the Omaha Storm Chasers to begin the homestand, and are looking to finish with a series split against the worst record in the International League. Closing out the series today in a rematch of Tuesday's opener for Indianapolis is LHP Michael Plassmeyer (1-5, 9.00), who took the loss on Tuesday after giving up four runs in the first inning. Countering for the Clippers is RHP Gavin Williams (0-0, 10.80), making his third start of a rehab assignment.

THIS DATE IN 1941: The Indians hosted the Boston Red Sox in an exhibition game at Perry Stadium and were handed a 23-14 defeat. The Red Sox starting lineup featured four Hall of Famers, LF Ted Williams, who hit .406 that season, went 1-for-2 with one RBI, SS Joe Cronin went 0-for-1 with a run scored. 1B Jimmie Foxx went 0-for-2. 2B Bobby Doerr was the star of the game, going 3-for-4 with a home run, five RBI and three runs scored.

Michael Plassmeyer: The southpaw Plassmeyer will make his 10th start of the season and sixth at Victory Field today vs. Columbus.

Last Outing: Plassmeyer took the loss against Columbus and surrendered four runs in his shortest outing of the year, pitching 1.0 inning.

Against the Clippers: Plassmeyer has only faced Columbus once

Walk It Off: Of his 14 starts last season with Lehigh Valley, four ended in walk-off fashion — three in favor of the IronPigs. In those three team wins, two of which were come-from-behind victories, Plassmeyer was backed by 27 runs of support.
