SUNDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost the series finale to the Akron RubberDucks, 4-3, at Canal Park. Akron took a 2-0 lead with no outs in the first inning on a two-run double by George Valera. The Flying Squirrels tied the score, 2-2, in the second with an RBI double by **Brandon Martorano** and an RBI single by **Jacob Heyward**. The 'Ducks took a 3-2 lead in the bottom of the second with an RBI single by Victor Nova and added a fourth run with an RBI double by Daniel Schneemann in the fourth. **Brett Auerbach** brought Richmond back within a run in the fifth with an RBI single. Relievers **Gray Fenter** and **R.J. Dabovich** each pitched a scoreless inning out of the bullpen.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the opener of a six-game series against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. This is the second series between the two teams this year. From April 20-24, the Flying Squirrels dropped four-of-six at UPMC Park in Erie. The two teams will meet again for a six-game series at The Diamond from September 13-18 to close the regular season.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have won five-of-seven games after losing nine of their previous 12. Last week, they won four-of-six on the road at Akron, knocking the RubberDucks out of first place. The Flying Squirrels have won five series, lost three and split one this year. Richmond hitters lead the league with 557 strikeouts. Richmond pitchers lead the league with 218 walks issued. The Richmond bullpen has posted a 0.55 ERA (1 ER/16.1 IP) over the last six games since May 31.

THE SEAWOLVES have gone 13-4 since May 19 and lead the Southwest Division by one game over Akron and two over third-place Richmond. Erie has won each of its last three series against New Hampshire, at Bowie and at home against Harrisburg. On the year, the Erie pitching staff has a 3.52 ERA, which is second in the EL. Erie's roster includes seven of MLB.com's top-30 Tigers prospects, including Dillon Dingler (3), Gage Workman (10), Wilmer Flores (14), Reese Olson (16), Parker Meadows (18), Andre Lipcius (24) and Austin Bergner (28).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Kai-Wei Teng** makes his team-leading 11th start of the season and his second against Erie. In his last start, Teng allowed two runs (one earned) in five innings at Akron on Thursday, working around four walks with one strikeout. He faced the SeaWolves on April 21 in Erie and allowed three runs (two earned) over 4.1 innings in a no-decision with six strikeouts and a season-high five walks. Teng spent the entire 2021 season with the High-A Eugene Emeralds, going 5-6 with a 4.33 ERA in 21 starts. For the season, Teng led the High-A West with 142 strikeouts, ranked tied for second with 21 games started, tied for first with one complete game and sixth with 95.2 innings pitched. He also ranked fourth in the Giants system in strikeouts. Teng was originally signed by the Minnesota Twins out of Taiwan in 2017. During his second season in 2018, he was traded to the Giants along with outfielder Jaylin Davis in exchange for right-handed pitcher Sam Dyson. **For more on Teng, see page two.**

FOR ERIE: Right-hander Reese Olson makes his 10th start and 11th overall appearance this year. He last pitched on Wednesday against the Senators and allowed two runs over five innings in a no-decision. He has made one start against Richmond this year, allowing three runs over five innings with nine strikeouts on April 21 at UPMC Park. He was the Opening Day starter for the SeaWolves on April 8 against Akron and threw four scoreless innings with seven strikeouts. Olson was drafted by the Brewers in the 13th round in 2018 out of North Hall High School in Georgia. He was traded to the Tigers on July 30, 2021 for LHP Daniel Norris. He was promoted to Erie last August and made his Double-A debut at The Diamond on August 20, allowing one run in four innings. He also pitched against Richmond in Erie on September 17 and allowed one run, a solo homer by Shane Matheny, with eight strikeouts over six innings in his final outing of the year. Olson is rated by MLB.com as the Tigers' No. 16 prospect.

LOPSIDED: On the year, the Flying Squirrels have the worst run differential in the Southwest Division at -16 runs. In their last 16 losses dating back to April 27, the Flying Squirrels have fallen by an average of 5.9 runs. Of those 16 losses, four have been by 10-or-more runs, including a 10-0 shutout to the Baysox on April 27, a 12-1 loss at Harrisburg on May 15, a 12-2 loss at Altoona on May 17 and a 19-8 loss on May 22 at Altoona, which tied the franchise record for runs allowed in a game. Richmond has scored two-or-less runs in seven of their last 16 losses.

PACKING THE HOUSE: This season, the Richmond Flying Squirrels are leading all of Double-A in average attendance (6,040) and rank second in total attendance (144,959). Richmond is 10th of the 120 MiLB teams in average attendance. The 9,810 fans at The Diamond on Opening Night is the largest crowd in all of Double-A this year and the largest of all non-Triple-A teams this season.

POWER SURGE: The Richmond offense has hit 64 home runs this season, which is second in the Eastern League behind Somerset (74). **Sean Roby** is third in the league with 13 homers on the season, with 10 coming at The Diamond. Last year, the Flying Squirrels set a franchise record with 127 homers, surpassing the previous record of 109 from 2013. This year, the Flying Squirrels are on pace to hit 173 home runs.

FITZ ON FIRE: After opening the season hit .162 through May 26, **Tyler Fitzgerald** is batting .393 (11-for-28) with three homers, five doubles and seven RBIs over his last eight games since May 27. Last Sunday, Fitzgerald homered twice and tied a single-game franchise record with five hits. He also set new single-game franchise records with five runs scored and 13 total bases. He hit his seventh home runs of the season in the second game of Friday's doubleheader.

SHANE TRAIN: In the month of May, **Shane Matheny** is batting .329 (23-for-70) with five homers, four doubles, a triple and 15 RBIs. He has picked up a pair of two-homer games, one on May 1 at The Diamond against Bowie and another on May 12 at Harrisburg. They were the second and third multi-homer games of his professional career and his first since 2019. Matheny is currently riding a 10-game hitting streak dating back to May 14, during which he is batting .394 (13-for-33).

ARMANI ARRIVES: **Armani Smith** hit .429 (6-for-14) with a triple and two walks in his four games played in last week's series at Akron. After going hitless in his Double-A debut on May 15, Smith has picked up at least one hit in nine-of-his-last-11 games played. During that 11-game span since May 17, Smith is batting .357 (15-for-42) with two doubles, a triple, three RBIs, six runs scored and four walks.

MARTY PARTY: Over his last 19 games played since May 11, **Brandon Martorano** has hit .333 (23-for-69) with five homers, four doubles, three triples and 15 RBIs. On May 11 at Harrisburg, he clubbed the second grand slam of his career. He returned to the lineup two days later and lifted the Flying Squirrels to a 6-5 win in extras with a sac fly in the 10th inning. On May 14 at Harrisburg, he homered twice for the first time in his career, knocking a go-ahead, three-run homer in the sixth and a solo shot for an insurance run in the ninth inning. Martorano hit a go-ahead, solo homer last Tuesday at Akron in a 3-2 win and drove in the go-ahead run in Thursday's 8-4 win over the 'Ducks.

TOASTY: **Frankie Tostado** is batting .338 (48-for-142) with seven homers, eight doubles, a triple and 25 RBIs over his last 37 games since April 22. From April 22-May 4, he posted a 10-game hitting streak, which was tied for the longest in the league this year at the time. On May 11, he tied a career high with four hits against the Senators. On the year, he has picked up at least one hit in 39 of his 47 games played. In the Eastern League, Tostado is ranked second in batting average (.322), second in hits (58) and third in total bases (92).

ROBUST: With his three-run homer on Friday in Game 2 of the doubleheader in Akron, **Sean Roby** held his spot in third in the league with 13 home runs this season. With two homers on Sunday against Hartford, he set a new Flying Squirrels record with his third multi-homer game of the season. He has hit 10 homers at The Diamond this season, which is tied for the most at home for a Flying Squirrels player in franchise history with **Adam Duvall** (2013). Roby hit eight homers over a 15-game stretch from April 10-29. He had hit just one homer over a 16-game stretch from April 30-May 25 prior to knocking four in his last nine games since May 26.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: **Frankie Tostado** is ranked second in batting average (.322), second in hits (58) and third in total bases (92). **Sean Roby** is third in home runs (13). **Brandon Martorano** is seventh in SLG (.522). **Ryan Walker** is first in wins (6). **Chris Wright** is tied for third in saves (6). **Jake Dahlberg** is eighth in ERA (3.55) and tied for first in winning percentage (.750).

WHERE THE SEAWOLVES RANK: In the Eastern League, Kerry Carpenter is first in batting average (.326), first in homers (19), first in RBIs (41), first in SLG (.703), first in OPS (1.090), tied for third in hits (56), first in extra-base hits (27), first in total bases (121) and second in runs scored (37). Quincy Nieporte is fourth in homers (12), fifth in SLG (.553) and ninth in OPS (.890). Gage Workman is tied for third in doubles (14) and fifth in stolen bases (15). Andre Lipcius is fourth in walks (34).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have four players ranked in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects, including **Kyle Harrison** (2), **Will Wilson** (16), **R.J. Dabovich** (17) and **Chris Wright** (27). **Franklin Labour** is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Outfield Arm." **Simon Whiteman** is listed as the system's "Fastest Baserunner." Harrison is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Slider" in the organization. MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Harrison (2), Dabovich (16), Wilson (21), **Brett Auerbach** (27) and **Kai-Wei Teng** (30). Harrison is *Baseball America's* No. 64 overall prospect and MLB.com's No. 45 overall prospect.
