TONIGHT'S GAME

The Round Rock Express and El Paso Chihuahuas (San Diego Padres affiliate) are set for the final game of their six-game series on Sunday night. Round Rock overcame a four-run deficit with six unanswered runs, defeating El Paso, 7-5, on Saturday night. The Express struck first in the opening inning when CF Cameron Cauley scored on a base hit from CF Gilberto Celestino. El Paso answered with five runs in the third. The Express began to chip away in the fourth when 1B Nick Pratto tripled home C Cooper Johnson. Pratto added a solo homer in the sixth to make it a 5-3 game. In the eighth, 2B Diego Castillo scored on an RBI single from Johnson. After Johnson stole second and advanced to third on a throwing error, he came home to cut the deficit to one. In the ninth, Celestino worked a bases-loaded walk to force in the tying run. Castillo then lined a two-run single into left field, scoring two for a 7-5 lead. RHP Emiliano Teodo faced the minimum in the ninth to secure the 7-5 victory.

WHERE WE STAND

The Express snapped a three-series losing streak with their win on Saturday... have secured at least a tie and are seeking their third series win this season...are 2-6-0 in series play...2-6 in series finales...took four of six from the Chihuahuas from April 14-19 at Dell Diamond.

CAM ON A MISSION

Batting .419 (13-31) with 6 XBH, 8 RBI, 12 R and 6 SB in his last 7 G... his 109.6 mph groundout on Friday was the second-hardest hit ball by an Express player this year... 3rd in the PCL in stolen bases (16). He is on-pace to steal 48 bases which would shatter his 2022 career-high (38) and would be one shy OF Bubba Thompson (2022) for the most in the Triple-A era for the Express.

PRATTO POP

Finished a double shy of the cycle in Saturday's win...owns a 12-game on-base streak with hits in 9 of his last 10...home runs in back-to-back games and in 3 of his last 6 and 4 of his last 10...during his 12-game on-base streak, slashing .341/.420/.682/1.102 with 4 HR, 3B, 2B, 10 RBI, 8 R, 5 BB and 10 SO...started the month of May hitting just .091 (2-22) through 6 G.

BULLPEN BRILLIANCE

Express relievers LHP Robby Ahlstrom, RHP Michel Otañez, RHP Gavin Collyer, RHP Mason Thompson and RHP Emiliano Teodo combined for 6.1 scoreless frames with just 1 H, 1 BB and 7 SO on Saturday night...marks Round Rock's 9th scoreless effort from the bullpen this season and 4th against El Paso...are 6-3 in those contests and 4-0 vs. the Chihuahuas.

COMEBACK KIDS

Saturday marked the first road comeback win of the season and ties their largest deficit to come back from (also 4 runs on 5/13 vs SAC)... the Express improved to 2-25 when trailing after 7 and 2-23 when trailing after 8. They trailed 5-1 going to the fourth and scored six unanswered to run away with it.

THIS DAY IN NOLAN RYAN HISTORY - FRIDAY, MAY 24, 1985

The 38-year-old Nolan Ryan tossed the 200th complete game of his career as he went the distance, allowing two earned runs on seven hits with three walks and seven strikeouts to improve to 4-2 on the year. The Astros won 6-2 to improve to 22-18 while Chicago dropped to 23-15. Dick Rutven took the loss for Chicago after allowing four earned runs on nine hits over 7.0 innings with two walks and no strikeouts. Ryan raised his strikeout total to 3,942 and improved his career record to 12-3 against Chicago. When his career was all said and done, Ryan won more games against Chicago (16) than against any other team, while his 2.40 ERA against the North Siders was the second-lowest he posted against any major league club. After the game, Ryan was informed that it was the 200th complete game of his career. His response? "That's not on my reading list. The biggest thing that I've got going for me is that I'm a Texan. How many Texans are 38 and still playing?" The lone runs for the Cubs came in the fourth and sixth on a Thad Bosley double that scored Ryne Sandberg and a Sandberg solo homer in the sixth. The Astros scored in the first on a Denny Walling RBI single, then added two more in the fourth on a Craig Reynolds sacrifice fly and a Bill Doran RBI single. With Houston leading 3-2 in the seventh, Terry Puhl delivered an RBI single before tripling home another run in the ninth. Walling later added a sacrifice fly to make it 6-2. In an effort to improve attendance, the Cubs experimented with 21 games starting at 3:05 p.m. A crowd of 35,473 was on hand, so the tactic certainly worked. But the shadows proved difficult for hitters. "I'm sure it's pretty tough to see out there," said Ryan. "But I wasn't even thinking about it until I couldn't see a ground ball (in the eighth inning) until it was right on top of me."

- In his 13th year in professional baseball, second with the Rangers after initially joining the club on a minor league contract, 3/5/25. Resigned with TEX on 11/18/25 and received an invite to Major League Spring Training.
- Seeking his MLB debut. Was recalled by Milwaukee August 31, 2020 but did not pitch and was optioned following the game. Was designated for assignment September 14.
- Opened 2025 with Double-A Frisco before he was assigned to Round Rock on July 18, spending remainder of season with the Express.... Posted a 3-2 record and a 3.54 ERA (21 ER/53.1 IP) in his final 11 starts with the E-Train... Was named PCL Pitcher of the Month for Aug., posting a league-best 1.71 ERA (5 ER/26.1 IP) and 0.99 WHIP in 5 GS for RR during the month.
- Traded to the Milwaukee Brewers with minor league outfielder Keon Broxton for infielder Jason Rogers, December 17, 2015.
- Selected by Pittsburgh in Competitive Balance Round B of the First-Year Player Draft in 2014 (73rd overall).
- Helped La Grange High School win the 3A 2013 UIL Texas State Baseball Championship...3A was played at Disch-Falk Field...Supak was named to the All-Tournament team.
- Was the first player drafted from La Grange since pitcher Homer Bailey by Cincinnati in 2004.
