BATS COME ALIVE LATE BUT FISHER CATS FALL: The Fisher Cats sparked a brave rally in the bottom of the ninth but left the tying and winning runs on base, as the Sea Dogs took game two of the series. With the score 3-1 in the bottom of the final frame, Chris Bec singled in LJ Talley, but the Fisher Cats were unable to plate what would have been the tying run from third. The Sea Dogs improve to 7-1 against the Fisher Cats on the back of their 3-2 win.

YOU OTTO KNOW BETTER: Otto López hit a double in the first inning to extend his hitting streak to a Double-A Northeast-leading twelve games. His .390 batting average is good for fifth in the league, and he also leads the league in hits (23) and doubles (9).

TALLEY IT UP: Just one day after LJ Talley recorded his first Double-A hit, the Georgia native *looked* to have hit his first Double-A home run in the bottom of the ninth off the foul pole in left – but the umpiring crew convened and after a lengthy conversation decided to award a double instead. Talley would wind up scoring later in the inning.

EARLY STREAKS: Otto López's twelve-game hit streak isn't the only Fisher Cats streak. Gabriel Moreno, who was recently added to *Baseball America's* Top 100 Prospects list, also carries a 10-game hitting streak into tonight's contest. Moreno got the night off for Tuesday's contest, and his .415 average is second in the league to Binghamton's Yoel Romero (.448).

COMING UP: The Fisher Cats welcome the Portland Sea Dogs (Red Sox Double-A affiliate) to Delta Dental Stadium this week. It will be the first of three trips to New Hampshire for the Sea Dogs, who are wrapping up a series in Hartford today. New Hampshire lost five of six at Hadlock Field to open the season. Next week, the Fisher Cats will head to New Jersey to wrap up the season series with the Somerset Patriots (New York Yankees Double-A affiliate).

BOB LIPMAN'S THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS HISTORY: May 20, 2011 - The Fisher Cats opened a series in New Britain with a 7-2 win over the Rock Cats. New Hampshire had six doubles in the game, including a pair in the top of the first by Adeiny Hechavarria and Mike McDade for the game's first run. Henderson Alvarez allowed one run in six innings in his Double-A debut to earn the win. It was the first of what would be 10 quality starts among 14 he made that year for the Fisher Cats. Only once did he yield more than three runs in an outing, finishing 8-4, 2.86 ERA.

FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: The Blue Jays fell in game two of their series with the Red Sox, dropping a 7-3 decision after the Sox put up five in the first inning. The Buffalo/Trenton Bisons improved to 10-4 with a 4-1 win over Worcester courtesy of a 10-strikeout performance from Alek Manoah. Dunedin improved to 4-10 with a 5-1 road win over Clearwater. The Vancouver Canadians defeated their current neighbors, the Hillsboro Hops, 6-1 after holding the Hops to just two hits over the final 8 frames.

ON THE HILL: RHP Maximo Castillo will look to pick up his second consecutive win of the season after tossing five innings of one-run ball last time out against Somerset. Opposite Castillo will be Kutter Crawford, the Florida Gulf Coast product who has allowed just one run in eight innings pitched this year.
