#### FROM THE CROWS NEST

ROSTER MOVES: On Wednesday, the Pittsburgh Pirates announced the promotion of INF Ewry Espinal from the FCL Pirates to Single-A Bradenton. Espinal is scheduled to make his Marauders' debut on Thursday night in Tampa. The 21-year-old was signed as a non-drafted free agent on July 2, 2019 and had played for Manager Jim Horner last season when he was a member of the FCL Pirates.

**THE TURTLE GUY:** After tossing 1.1 scoreless frames on Tuesday to pick up his second save of the season, Magdiel Cotto extended his scoreless innings streak to 10.0 innings. Over his last five appearances, Cotto has allowed just four hits while striking out seven batters. The southpaw also leads the Pirates organization with a 61.5 GB% among pitchers who have recorded at least 20.0 innings this season.

AWARDS SEASON: On Monday, Major League Baseball announced that C Omar Alfonzo was named the FSL Player of the Week, becoming the first Marauder this season to garner a weekly award. In six games last week against St. Lucie, Alfonzo went 9-for-18 with two doubles, one home run, six RBIs, five walks, two intentional walks, and five runs scored. The 20-year-old wrapped up his week reaching base five times on Sunday, going 3-for-4 at the plate with a double and two RBIs.

ILIKE TURTLES: Saturday night at LECOM Park was anything but ordinary when a turtle appeared in left-centerfield in the top of the second inning to halt play. LHP Magdiel Cotto swooped in to save the day by carrying the turtle back to the bullpen before being released in a pond just beyond the outfield wall. The video has been shared by several outlets, including The Athletic, SportsCenter, Pardon My Take, Jomboy, and Sports Illustrated.

WE CALL THAT A WINNING STREAK: The Marauders' franchise-record 11-game winning streak came to an end on Wednesday night in Tampa, as they fell 5-0. At the time, it was tied with the Jersey Shore BlueClaws (PHI, A+) for the longest streak in the Minors this year. The Marauders had won won nine straight three times before, back in 2022 and 2011. They also won five straight from 5/25/21 - 6/3/21 en route to capturing the 2021 Low-A East Championship. Bradenton had three streaks of six-plus wins last season with their longest streak lasting from April 4 - April 21 at seven games.

KING OF THE HILLS: Since April 17, the Bradenton Marauders pitching staff holds the fourth-best ERA in Minor League Baseball at 2.80 with the Daytona Tortugas leading the way with a 2.72 ERA

**THE OFFENSE HAS ARRIVED:** During the Marauders' 11-game winning streak, the offense scored 66 runs for an average 6.6 per game. Overall, the team slashed .271/.365/.432 while ranking first in the FSL in slugging percentage and fourth in average. Bradenton's team batting average on the season had been raised from .176 to .207 over those 11 games. Bradenton also stole 21 bases in 26 attempts during the streak, the most in the FSL and fifth-most in all of Single-A. The win streak started and ended with their two lone shutouts of the season.

**GOT EM!:Hunter Furtado** picked off Kevin Villavicencio in the eighth inning on Friday night for the Marauders 11th pickoff of the season. As of Thursday, the Marauders are currently tied for second in MiLB, with the Salt Lake Bees (Triple-A, LAA) leading the way with 12. Bradenton had 23 last season, which ranked the second-most in the FSL and 11th-most in MiLB.

HEATING UP: Esmerlyn Valdez worked walk on Wednesday to extend his on-base streak to 16 games. During the streak, Valdez is hitting .259/.394/.500 with four doubles, three home runs. 14 RBIs, seven walks, and 10 runs scored. Jesus Castillo previously owned the longest on-base streak by a Marauder this year when

he reached base safely in his first 15 games of the season. It's currently the second-longest active streak in the FSL, only trailing Tarpons C Tomas Frick (16 games).

Walked Marco Vargas to begin the game and advanced to third on a pair of wild pitches thrown. Reed punched out the next two batters before a Boston Baro singled plated the first run.
