ABOUT LAST NIGHT... 11 runs in the first four innings wasn't enough for the Vancouver Canadians Friday night as the C's fell 15-11 to the Spokane Indians (Rockies) after the pitching staff failed to protect an early lead for the third time this week.

The decisive blow came in the bottom of the sixth. With the C's leading 11-9, Will McAffee (L, 0-3) gave up a lead-off double before consecutive walks loaded the bases. Up stepped Daniel Cope, who hit an opposite field grand slam to give Spokane its first lead of the night. He would surrender another home run two batters later to make it 14-11 Indians. It was the third slam the C's have surrendered in the last week after Jake Anchia of Everett hit one last Friday. All told Spokane hit five home runs on the night, the most Vancouver's staff has been tagged for in one game this year.

Cope's slam was the second of the evening for the Rockies affiliate. Vancouver scored four runs in the first on five hits - including RBI knocks from Will Robertson and Rafael Lantigua plus a Davis Schneider sacrifice fly - to lead 4-0 before #3 Rockies prospect Michael Toglia stepped to the plate with the sacks full and no outs in the bottom of the frame. The High-A West home run and RBI leader slugged his 17th homer of the year to not only tie the game at four, but also win a lucky fan in attendance \$10,000 as part of "Grand Slam Weekend" at Avista Stadium.

Vancouver bounced back with five runs in the second stanza to retake the lead. DJ Neal doubled to start the inning before consecutive walks loaded the bases. Lantigua then doubled home a pair and Schneider slugged his fourth home run of the year - a three-run blast - to put the Canadians ahead 9-4.

Spokane scored a run in the second and three in the third to pull within one, but the C's added two in the fourth on a Ronny Brito two-run homer to go up 11-8. The Indians added a tally in the fifth to set up their dramatic sixth inning.

THE TRIBE HAS SPOKANE: The C's are back at Avista Stadium this week for their second and final trip to Eastern Washington this year. When they were last here in June, Vancouver won four games and outscored the Indians 41-31. These two teams last went head-to-head three weeks ago in Hillsboro, when they split a six-game set and the Canadians scored 28 runs to the Tribe's 23. All told, the C's lead the season series 12 games to six.

HOME AWAY FROM HOME: Due to pandemic-related border closures, Ron Tonkin Field in Hillsboro will serve as Vancouver's home ballpark this year. 78 of 120 C's game will take place in the Tualatin Valley over the course of the season (60 home games, 18 as the visitors).

ON THIS DATE IN CANADIANS BASEBALL HISTORY: July 31, 2016 - The Canadians fell behind 1-0 in the first, scored two in the third and held on to beat Boise 2-1 at Memorial Stadium. Gunnar Heidt double to set up a game-tying single from Ryan Metzler before a throwing error later in the inning brought in the eventual winning run. Miguel Castro - who would later be traded to Colorado in the Troy Tulowitzki deal - earned the win with five innings of one-run ball before Mark Biggs, Andrew Case and Brett Barber combined on the final four innings to secure the victory to help the C's improve to ten games over .500.

HOMER HAPPY: Last night's seven total home runs between the two teams were the most in a C's game this year. 26 of Vancouver's 53 homers have come with runners on base (16 two-run shots, nine three-run bombs and one Tanner Kirwer grand slam) after Davis Schneider plated three on one swing and Ronny Brito went deep with a man on base. The C's pitching staff established a new single-game mark by surrendering five big flies; their previous high was three.

FREAKY FRIDAY: Vancouver has coughed up three grand slams in their last two Friday games. Michael Toglia and Daniel Cope did the honors last night while Jake Anchia of Everett did it last week.

RAFA IS RAKING: Rafael Lantigua is smoldering at the plate this series. In three games, the Puerto Plata, DR native is 7-for-14 with two doubles, a home run, five runs scored and nine RBI.

ON THE SCHNEID: Davis Schneider is in the midst of his most productive stretch of the season. His 4 RBI last night matched a career high and he's 5-for-9 with a home run, five runs scored and six RBI in his last two games. Tonight is his third consecutive start, the most games he's appeared in in a row this year.

ON THE HILL: Paxton Schultz gets the call for Vancouver. In his last turn on July 25 against Everett, he took the loss after allowing seven runs - all unearned - on five hits with two walks and six strikeouts over 3.2 innings of work. Spokane handed him his first loss of the season on July 8, when they got him for five runs on five hits with three walks and two strikeouts over five and two-thirds innings of work. That day, the Orem, UT native held the Tribe scoreless through four, gave up a single run in the fifth to tie the game then was tagged for four in the sixth thanks in part to a two-out, two-run homer from Brenton Doyle. He last pitched in this park on June 13 when he allowed six earned runs - all in the fourth - five hits, walked four and K'd three but got a no decision after the C's rallied to win 12-6.

Right-hander Noah Davis makes his Rockies debut for Spokane tonight. The 24-year-old was acquired from Cincinnati on July 28 in the deal that sent big league reliever Mychal Givens to the Reds. Davis, 24, was pitching for Advanced-A Dayton prior to the deal and went 3-6 with a 3.60 ERA in 13 starts across 65 innings and limited High-A Central hitters to a .193 average. A native of Huntington Beach, CA, Davis was an eleventh round pick (319th overall) in the 2018 draft out of UC Santa Barbara. As a Gaucha, he posted a 15-9 record with a 4.58 ERA, 139 strike outs and 58 walks in three seasons. He was a high school teammate of Vancouver's Hagen Danner at Huntington Beach High.
