LAST OUTING: Fernandez last got an out in the seventh inning on June 14 vs. Gwinnett. He retired Gwinnett's Joshua Fuentes via flyout to end the inning.

LAST START: Fernandez took the loss on May 30 at Charlotte, giving up all 4 of the Knights' four runs in 5.2 innings. He walked four for the third time this season while giving up a season-high eight hits in the loss.

AGAINST OPPONENT: This is Fernandez's third appearance and first start against Gwinnett in his career. Both of his previous outings came in relief this season. He earned the win on May 9 in 4.0 two-run innings before getting the final out of the seventh on Tuesday's game.

· Was the first arm out of the bullpen on Opening Day, holding Louisville scoreless through the middle innings.
