THIS DATE IN HISTORY

On this day in 2008, Vinny Rottino hit safety in his 24th straight game in game one of a doubleheader at Iowa. He would go 0-for-2 in game two of the twin bill. The streak was the longest by any player in the Pacific Coast League that season.

Tonight's Game: The Nashville Sounds and Gwinnett Strippers transform into their Copa de la Diversión identities, the Vihuelas de Nashville and Xolos de Gwinnett, for tonight's game. Nashville won their third-straight over Gwinnett with a 5-3 triumph last night. Pedro Fernandez starts for the Vihuelas, going against Gwinnett's Michael Soroka.

Pedro Fernandez: 29-year-old Pedro Fernandez starts for Nashville tonight. The right-hander is 2-3 with a 3.83 ERA (44.2 IP/19 ER) in 14 outings (7 starts) this year. He last pitched in game one of the series on June 14 vs. Gwinnett, getting an out to end the seventh inning. Fernandez's last start came on May 30 at Charlotte, taking the loss in 5.2 innings worked (8 H, 4 R, 4 ER, 4 BB, 2 K). After holding a 1.50 ERA through seven appearances in April, Fernandez is 2-2 with a 5.40 ERA over his next seven outings. The Dominican Republic native boasts a 2.63 ERA and 1.21 WHIP at First Horizon Park this season (24.0 IP, 7 R, 7 ER, 9 BB, 14 K).

Michael Soroka: 25-year-old Michael Soroka makes his 10th start with Gwinnett this season. The right-hander is 2-2 with a 3.92 ERA (41.1 IP/18 ER) with the Strippers. He's made two starts with Atlanta, going 0-2 with an 8.38 ERA. Soroka earned the win in a quality start on June 10 vs. Charlotte. He held the Knights to a run on three hits with six strikeouts in 6.0 innings. It was his third quality start of the season. Soroka was optioned to Gwinnett on June 5 after a rough start at Arizona the day before for the Braves (3.2 IP, 7 H, 5 R, 5 ER, 4 BB, 2 K). Tonight will be his second start at First Horizon Park this season after taking the loss on May 11 (4.0 IP, 4 H, 3 R, 3 ER, 2 BB, 3 K). He gave up a three-run homer to Keston Hiura in the first inning of that contest.

Brice Bombs Are Back: Brice Turang has homered in back-to-back games, adding a go-ahead two-run shot in the fourth inning last night. It is the first time Turang has homered in consecutive games since April 28-29, 2022 at St. Paul. Since being optioned from Milwaukee on June 7, Turang is 4-for-20 with two homers, seven RBI and three runs scored.

Eighth Inning Magic: Cam Devanney played hero for the Sounds last night with a go-ahead two-run shot that broke the 3-3 deadlock in the eighth inning. The Sounds have outscored their opponents 55-26 in the eighth. Nashville's .324 average, 55 runs, 77 hits, 12 homers and 51 RBI are the best marks for any team in the eighth inning in the league.

A-Jax Stays Hot: Alex Jackson has hit safely in 10 of his last 11 contests with a single last night. Since May 19, Jackson is batting .447 (17-for-38) with five home runs, 11 RBI and 16 runs.

Finally Caught You: Alex Jackson threw out Forrest Wall attempting to swipe second base in the first inning of last night's contest. It was the first time Wall had been caught stealing this season after going 39-for-39 in stolen base attempts to begin 2023. As a staff, the Sounds lead the league with 30 caught stealing on the season, four more than the second-best mark held by Charlotte.

Pitchers Pacing the Pack: The Sounds pitching staff has the lowest ERA in the International League (4.19), ahead of Norfolk (4.37). Nashville pitchers also lead the circuit in fewest walks allowed (253), WHIP (1.36) and opponent average (.243). They're second in the league in fewest runs allowed (301) and hits allowed (512).

Rehab Updates: Rehabbing Milwaukee outfielder Jesse Winker went 1-for-4 last night. Winker is now hitting .350 (7-for-20) with three homers, three RBI and more walks (6) than strikeouts (3). Rehabbing right-handed reliever Matt Bush tossed 0.2 scoreless innings last night. The 37-year-old has struck out four in 3.1 innings over four rehab outings.

The Future Brew Crew: Nashville currently has four players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Outfielder Sal Frelick is the No. 2 prospect, left-handed pitcher Robert Gasser is the No. 7 prospect, right-handed pitcher Abner Uribe is the No. 9 prospect and left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 11 prospect.

How Sweet It Is: Sounds manager Rick Sweet is in his fourth season overall and third consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. The reigning International League Manager of the Year, Sweet led the Sounds to a 91-58 record in 2022, 70-58 record in 2021 and a 77-67 record in 2014. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season and has compiled a 634-549 record during an eight-season span.

LAST OUTING: Fernandez last got an out in the seventh inning on June 14 vs. Gwinnett. He retired Gwinnett's Joshua Fuentes via flyout to end the inning.

LAST START: Fernandez took the loss on May 30 at Charlotte, giving up all of the Knights' four runs in 5.2 innings. He walked four for the third time this season while giving up a season-high eight hits in the loss.

AGAINST OPPONENT: This is Fernandez's third appearance and first start against Gwinnett in his career. Both of his previous outings came in relief this season. He earned the win on May 9 in 4.0 two-run innings before getting the final out of the seventh on Tuesday's game.

2023 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Was the first arm out of the bullpen on Opening Day, holding Louisville scoreless through the middle innings.
- Made three straight starts from April 8 through April 16, going 0-1 with a 3.38 ERA (8.0 IP/3 ER) over the stretch.
