## HIGHLIGHTS

**PATRIOTS PITCHING:** Entering today, the Somerset Patriots have won 11 of their last 14 games, including 5/6 at home last week against Binghamton. During the series, the Patriots outscored the Rumble Ponies 35-14 and the pitching staff posted a 2.00 ERA with 63 K in 54 IP. From the 8th inning Wednesday through the 5th inning Saturday, Somerset did not allow a run over a Double-A franchise record 24.2 IP.

**SOMERSET SLUGGING:** Offensively, the Patriots hit a season-high 10 HR over their six-game home stand vs. Binghamton, including 3 HR in each of the final two games of the series on Saturday and Sunday. T.J. Rumfield homered in three straight games to start the series and entering today, Austin Wells has homered in three straight games. In Sunday's 11-2 win, the Patriots tied a season-high in hits with 13, while every player in the lineup had a hit.

WELLSCOME BACK: Since returing off the injured list last Tuesday 5/2, Austin Wells has hit safely in all five games he's played sicne returning, going 5-for-19 with 7 RBI, 4 R and 3 HR. Wells has homered in each of Somerset's last three games.

**MARTIAN MAN:** Jasson Dominguez enters today on a season-high four-game hit streak. Across the streak, Dominguez is 5-for-15 with 5 RBI, 3 R, 3 BB and his third home run of the season in the first inning on Saturday. In spite of hitting .169, Dominguez enters today with a .381 OBP, which is above his career average.

**OH MYATT:** The Patriots' bullpen carries a 2.90 ERA into this week, which ranks third in the Eastern League. Last week vs. Binghamton, Somerset's bullpen allowed 2 ER in 22.1 IP, a 0.80 ERA. Reliever Tanner Myatt earned his team-leading third save of the season when he closed out Friday night's 2-0 win. Myatt now boasts a 0.79 ERA over nine appearances, with 15 K in 11.1 IP.

## 2023

Castano earned his first Double-A win in his second start of the season on 4/23 vs. New Hampshire, allowing 3 ER over 5 IP with 6 K.

### 2022

Castano began 2022 in the starting rotation for High-A Hudson Valley, making 15 starts over 16 appearances and going 3-7 with a 3.62 ERA and 74 K compared 26 BB over 79.2 IP. His 79.2 IP led the Renegades at the time of his promotion to Somerset on 8/4/22. Castano started one game for the Patriots, before returning to Hudson Valley for the remainder of the season.

### 2021

Spent most of 2021 in Single-A Tampa, after beginning the season with a brief stint in the FCL. Combined, Castano went 6-2 with a 4.17 ERA over 45.1 IP.

## 2019

After three starts in the DSL to begin 2019, when Castano posted a 1.84 ERA over 14.2 IP, he moved to the United States and joined the GCL Yankees West rotation. Castano started 7/11 appearances in the GCL, going 2-5 with a 4.67 ERA.

### 2018

Castano spent his pro debut season with the DSL Yankees, going 1-5 over 11 appearances that included seven starts with a 5.40 ERA.

### **RAUL DOMINGUEZ:** Manager (1st year)

Dominguez begins his 1st season as manager for the Somerset Patriots, 9th overall as a manager and 17th overall coaching in the Yankees organization. He spent the past two seasons (2021-2022) as a defensive coach for Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre and was assigned to the same post for 2020, before the minor league season was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Dominguez becomes the 5th manager in Patriots franchise history and the 3rd since becoming the Yankees Double-A affiliate. He succeeds 2022 Eastern League Manager of the Year Dan Fiorito. Dominguez also previously served as the defensive coach for Trinton (2018-2019) and Tampa (2017). The Panama City, Panama native has managerial experience with the GCL Yankees East (2016), DSL Yankees 1 (2011-15) and DSL Yankees 2 (2009-10). From 2012-2015, his teams finished at least 10 games over .500, including reaching the DSL semifinals in 2012 and 2015. An outfielder during his playing days, Dominguez signed with the Yankees as an undrafted free agent in 2001 and spread four minor league seasons for New York between the DSL and the GCL. He then began his coaching career in 2008 with the DSL Yankees 2, after spending 2007 as the Yankees' tryout scout in the Dominican Republic. >> > Assistant coach bios on next page. >> >

Rosario was ranked by Baseball America as the "Best Defensive Outfielder" in the Red Sox system. 2017 - 2019: Rosario spent the first three seasons (2017-19) of his career with the Padres organization. In 2018 and 2019, he was ranked by Baseball America as the "Best Athlete" in Padres farm system.




